Intervals are based on normal hours of operations. Adjust to compensate for abnormal operations and severe conditions. During inactive periods sufficient lubrication must be performed for adequate preservation.

Clean parts with SOLVENT, dry-cleaning, or with OIL, fuel, Diesel. Dry before lubricating.

Clean fittings before lubricating.

Lubricate points indicated by dotted arrow shafts on both sides of equipment.

A dotted circle indicates a drain below.

Relubricate after washing or fording.

Drain crankcases when hot. Fill and check level

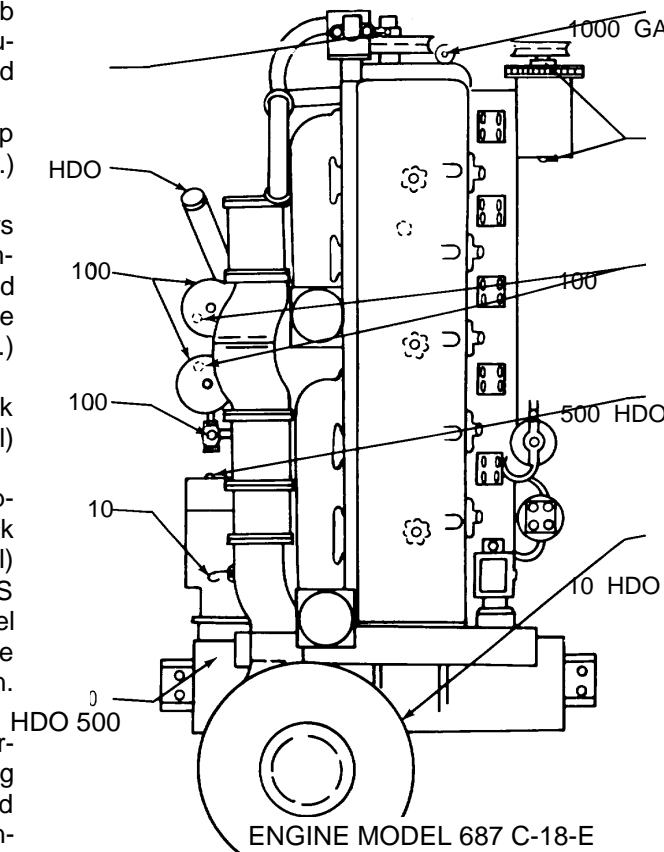

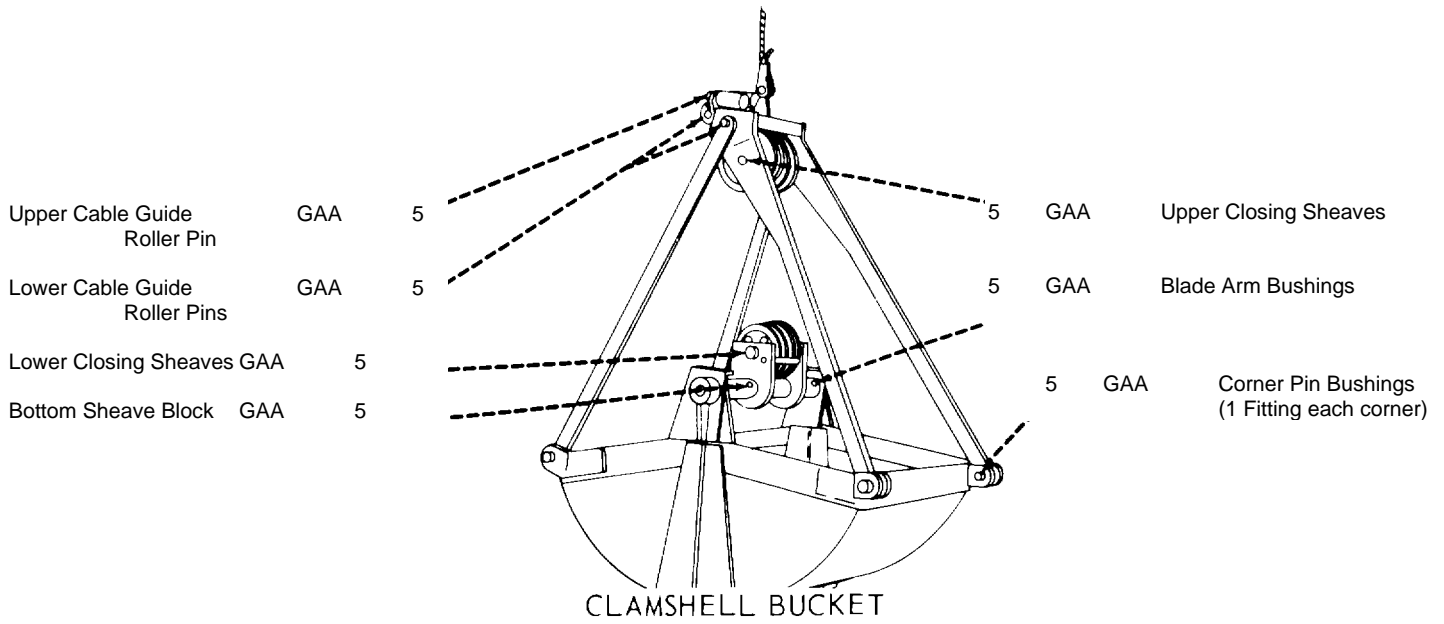

- FOR OPERATION OF EQUIPMENT IN PROTRACTED COLD TEMPERATURES BELOW 10° F.**
Remove lubricant prescribed in the key for temperature above 10° F. Relubricate with lubricants specified in the key for temperatures below 10° F.
- OIL CAN POINTS.** Every 10 service hours lubricate all linkage, pins and clevises with HDO.
- CABLES.** Keep cables clean and lubricated with HDO. **CAUTION: Do not lubricate cables coming in contact with excavated materials.**
- ENGINES OIL FILTERS.** Every 100 hours remove filter element, clean housing, install new element, fill crankcase, operate engine for five minutes, check for leaks.
