3. Condition of crops:

The weather in general during July was of high temperature, full of sunshine, with little rain, a typical summer type weather. The growth of paddy rice is progressing smoothly and shows a good rowth. However, a part of paddy fields had insufficient water owing to less rain, and at one time they were in critical condition, but rain fall in the latter part of July restored them to the normal condition.

60% of the upland rice was in danger through want of rain by the spell of dry weather during the earlier part of July, however, they were restored to a certain extent by the rainfall in the latter part of the month.

The above may be said of sundry crops and sweet potatoes, but their growth is being restored.

The outbreak of diseases and harmful insects is nothing serious. In general there is an outbreak of rice stem borer and moreover, there was an outbreak of leaf-hoppers in the paddy rice of Miura Peninsula district, and an outbreak of black rice bugs in paddy rice of Ashigara Shimo district. The outbreak of *piricularia oryzae* CAVARA can be seen in the mountain districts of Tsukui.

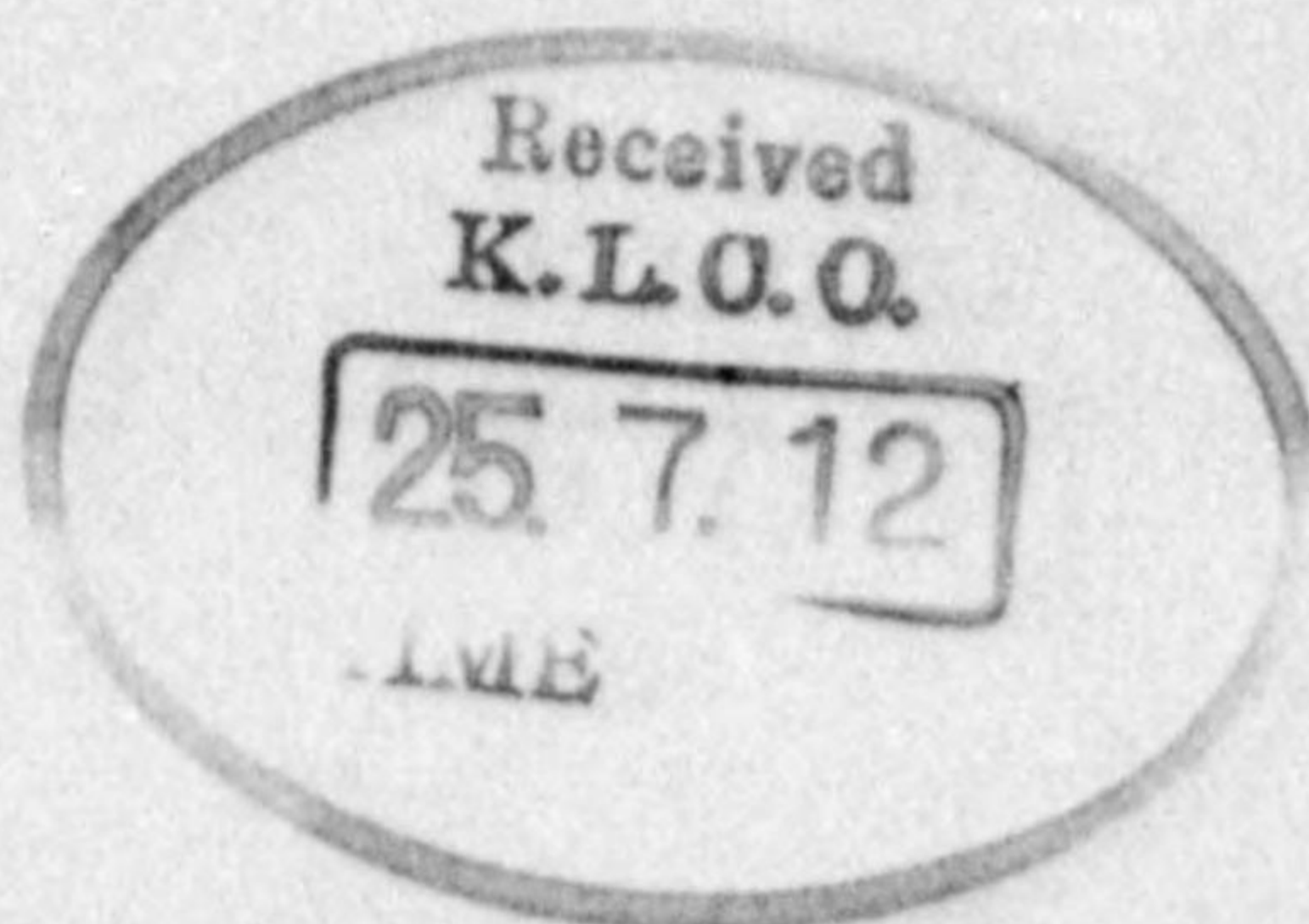

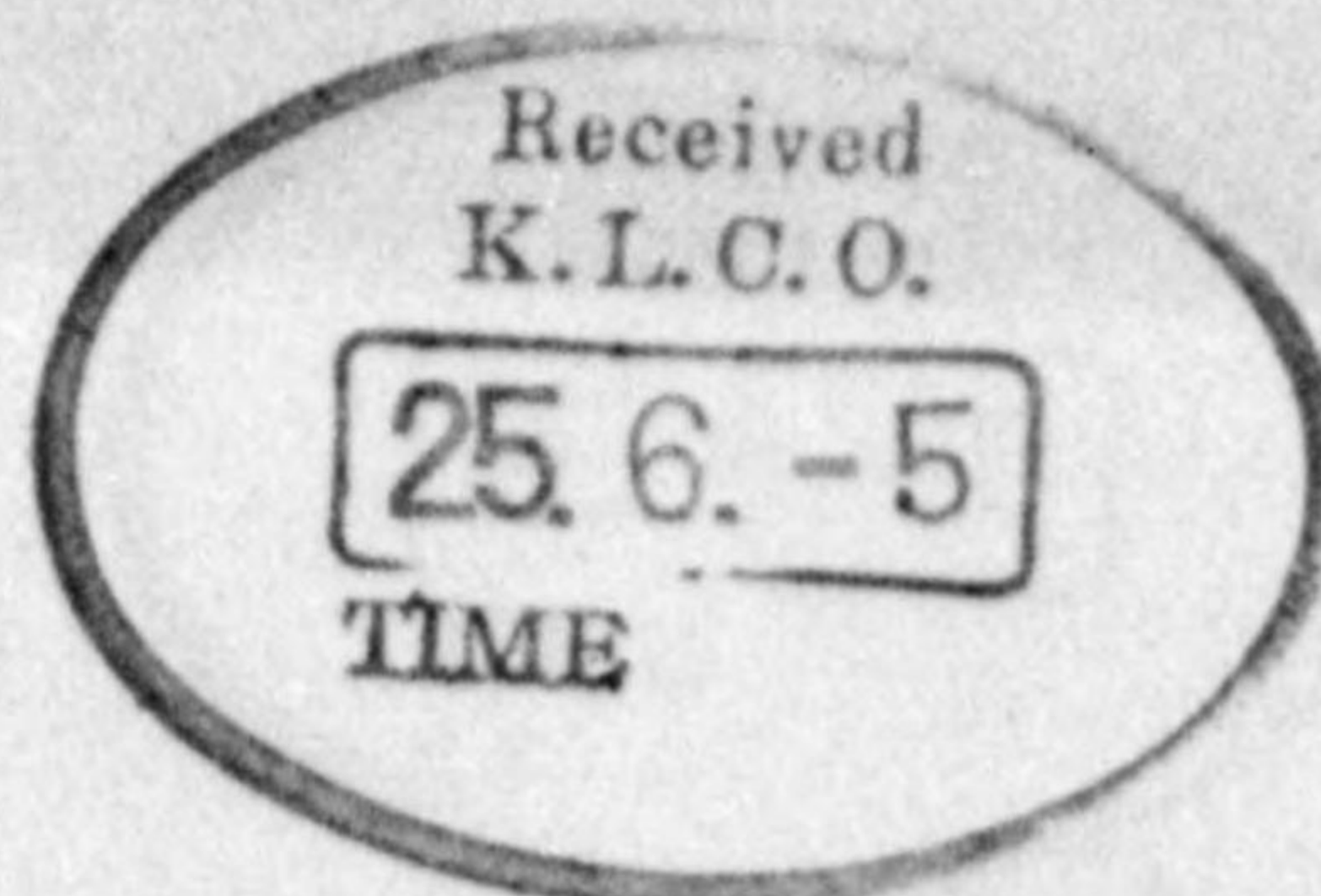

I.- Activities Condition of Agricultural
Farm Advisors:

(1) The Main Items of Diffusion and their
Enforcement Condition.

(a) Main Items: Raising of health paddy rice.

Enforcement: Concerning this matter, special impor-
tance was attached and instruction given,
so that the occurance of sickness is
comparatively small, but due to irregular
weather condition, the growth is rather
retarded.

(b) Main Items: Extermination of disease and harmful
insects of wheats and potatoes.

Enforcement: Concerning the wheats, 3,000 leaflets
were distributed, while radio and news-
car broadcastings were made on Irish
potatoes, instructing for the thorough
extermination of the both.

(c) Main Items: Diffusion of germ for the disease of
roots of bean products.

Enforcement: Concerning this matter 500 leaflets were
distributed and propagated at various
meetings, so that they were made to be
used on the Summer harvesting beans.

Exhibitions, Actual instructions:	308 times
Investigations for diffusion:	166 times

In order to plan the improvement on the will to increase the production of wheat, the above Competitive Exhibition is staged from the last autumn, and as the period of examination is approaching, a preliminary talk on its detail was made by gathering 34 persons of related authorities of Districts and Municipalities, at the Prefectural Agricultural Experimentation Station.

This was held at Public People's Hall of Kanazawa Bunko, Yokohama-city, to which 13 persons of this Division, including 10 persons of Home Demonstration Agents attended. An Official in charge was invited from the Agricultural & Forestry Ministry and research & study were made on the various problems of livelihood improvements.

- (3) 12 May Training Course for Cutting Sheep's Hair.

Actual training course on cutting hair was conducted at Nakatsu-mura of Aiko District, by gathering 18 persons of Demonstration agents of locality where sheep are reared in large numbers.

- (4) 19 May Home demonstration farming season countermeasures study meeting.

The entire members (10 persons) of Home Demonstration Agents and 2 persons of officials in charge were gathered at the Kohza Local Government Office of Fujisawa-city, and study on the various problems of livelihood improvement in farming season of June was conducted as its main issue.

Index Number of Industrial Production in Kanagawa.

1. Purely initiated and completed by this section mobilizing hands in Inquiry Section, K.P.G. by continuous efforts since October 1948. Reports are being submitted from more than 1,100 plants in Kanagawa to Inquiry Section, K.P.G. to make this index number every month.
2. Almost all the main industries in Kanagawa are included except medicine and alcoholic liquor plants which are to be included by K.P.G. from near future.
3. Index numbers written in black figures are calculated by simple arithmetical means, while written in red are reckoned by weighted arithmetical means (weights derive from value transacted)
4. This may perhaps be the only prefectural industrial index in Japan today. The biggest fault of this index, however, is the lack of prewar monthly average figures as standard to compare with. Calculation, hereafter (from May) will be transferred to Inquiry Section, K.P.G.
