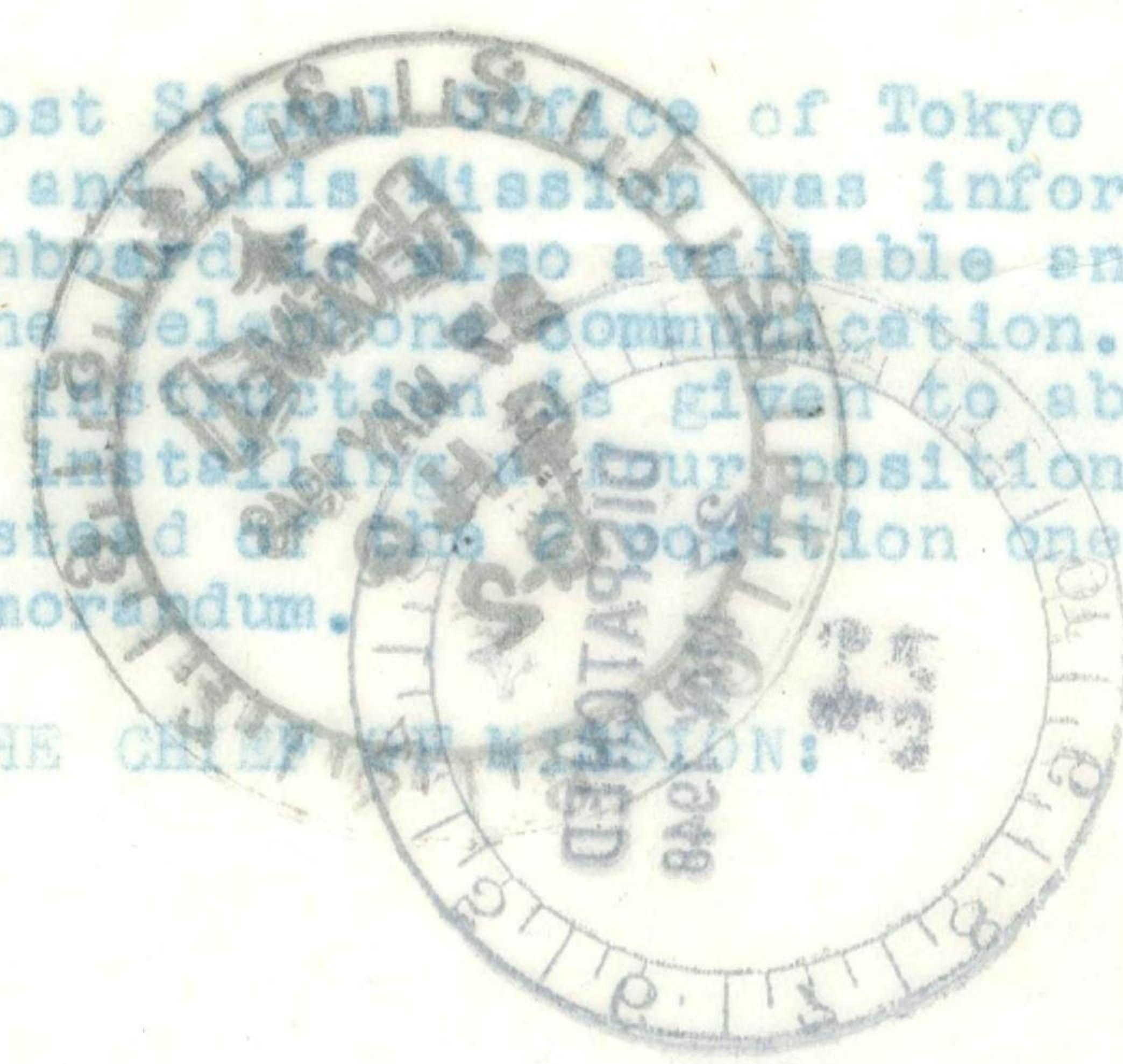
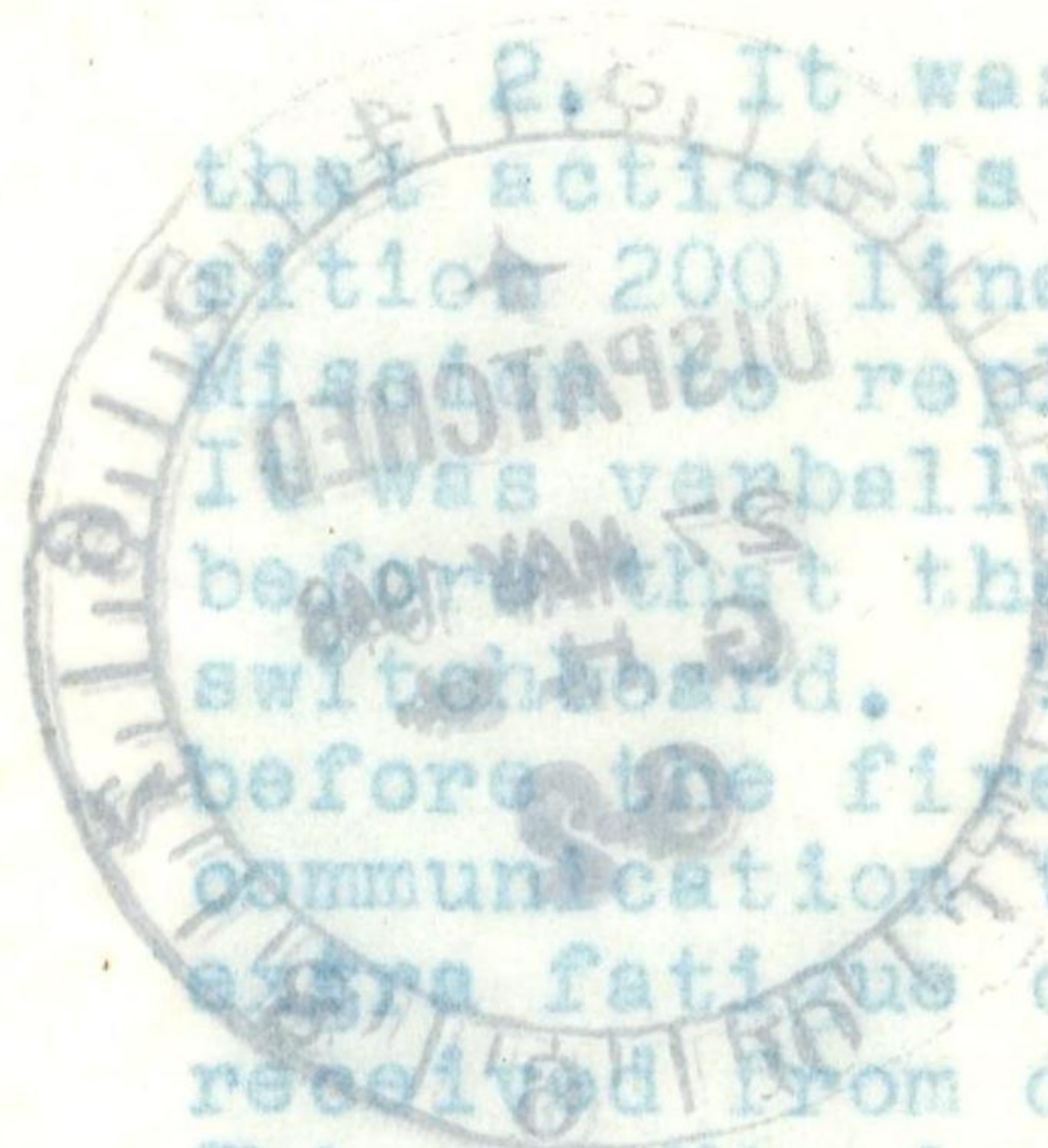
1. Reference is made to GHQ Memorandum for Chief, Chinese Mission in Japan AG 676.1 (12 Apr 48)SCMC, Subject same as above.

2. It was stated in referred memorandum that action is being taken to install a two position 200 line Japanese Switchboard for this Mission to replace the board destroyed by fire. It was verbally requested to the Post Signal Officer before that the new replacement be a four position switchboard. The two position one used by the Mission before the fire was insufficient to handle the heavy communication traffic of this Mission and created extra fatigue of its operators. Complaints have been received from different occupation sources that contact Chinese Mission by telephone always encounters difficulty.

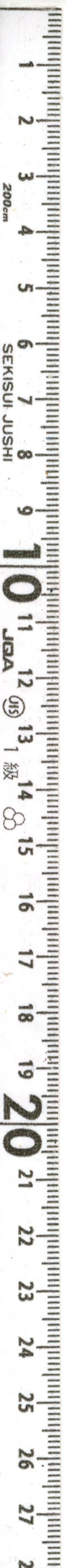
3. The Post Signal Office of Tokyo Area has been consulted and this Mission was informed that four position switchboard is also available and it will much improve the telephone communication. It will be appreciated if instruction is given to above office to go ahead in installing a four position 200 line switchboard instead of the 2 position one mentioned in referred memorandum.
