I served in Kaijima Tanko K.K. (Kaijima Mining Co., Ltd.), which has no connection with Nissan Line, for twenty three years from Nov. 1919 to Apr. 10, 1941. But I retired from the said company on account of my illness and took a rest for about one year. On July, 1942, I assumed office of director of Manshu Yushi K.K. (Manchurian Fat & Oil Co., Ltd.) in response to a recommendation of Mr. Sojiro Yasuda, who was a co-worker while I was in office of Kaijima Tanko K.K.

But after one year since I entered to this company, I retired from the said company because of my illness again. So I returned to Japan and gave myself to rest. While this time I was requested to enter Nissan Yuso Hikoki K.K. (Nissan Transportation Airplane Co., Ltd.) aiming at manufacture of wooden glider, which was planning to establish in Tottori Pref., from Mr. Jisaburo Fukuda, president of the said company. In response to his request, I participated in this enterprise for about half a year. But this enterprise was not completed, so there was no room for active service. After that, when Mr. Yoshihiro Sasaki, who was a senior to me in my native country and also was in office of director and a Chief of Accounting Section of Nippon Yushi K.K. (Japan Fat & Oil Co., Ltd.), changed his post to a Chief of Inspection Section of the said company, there was no properly-qualified successor for the post in the company. At the time, I received the request for entrance into the said company as a person in charge of accounting business.

Then, I assumed office of director & a Chief of Accounting Section of the said company in Oct., 1944.

Therefore, my assumption of office of director of Nippon Yushi K.K. (Japan Fat & Oil Co., Ltd.) absolutely depend upon my private relation with Mr. Yoshihiko Sasaki, so NISSAN ZAIBATSU has no connection with my ~~assumpti~~ assumption of office.

Note: I assumed office of director of Nippon Yushi K.K. (Japan Fat & Oil Co., Ltd.), predecessor of Nissan Chemical Industrial Co., Ltd. (Nissan Kagaku Kogyo K.K.) on Oct. 31, 1944.

But Nippon Yushi K.K. took over all the business belonging to Chemical Section of Nippon Kogyo K.K. (Japan Mining Co., Ltd.) and changed its name as Nissan Kagaku Kogyo K.K. (Nissan Chemical Industrial Co., Ltd.) on Apr. 1, 1945. And then I assumed office of director of the said company consecutively.

1. That the Zaibatsu company wherein the subject person held, prior to Sept. 2, 1945, the position of official, had not been, during the period when he served as such, subject to the control of the Zaibatsu of the one and same lineage or of any Zaibatsu company designated as belonging to such Zaibatsu

Nippon Yushi K.K. (Japan Fat & Oil Co., Ltd.), predecessor of present Nissan Kagaku Kogyo K.K. (Nissan Chemical Industrial Co., Ltd.) was placed under the control of Nippon Sangyo K.K. (Japan Industrial Co., Ltd.) (Nissan ZAIBATSU supervised by Mr. Gisuke Ayukawa) on June, 1937. But on December 27, 1937, Nippon Sangyo K.K. dissolved and had started afresh as Manshu Jukogyo K.K. (Manchurian Heavy Industry Co., Ltd.)

On that occasion, it parted from the enterprises in Japanese island, so since then Nippon Yushi K.K. carried out its management from its own standpoint. (Refer to document evidence No.1)

Accordingly, it was quite short period that Nippon Yushi K.K. was placed under the control of NISSAN ZAIBATSU.

That is, on Oct., 1944 when I assumed office of director of Nippon Yushi K.K., Nippon Yushi K.K. was quite free from Nippon Sangyo K.K. and had been managed independently basing on the decision of directors' meeting.

Furthermore, Nippon Yushi K.K. took over all the business belonging to Chemical Section of Nippon Kogyo K.K. (Japan Mining Co., Ltd.) on April, 1945. and changed its name as Nissan Kagaku Kogyo K.K. (Nissan Chemical Industrial Co., Ltd.) Although Nippon Yushi K.K. and Nissan Kagaku Kogyo K.K. are the same person, who merely changed its name if legally considered, but significant changes took place in the character, business content, scale and managing staff of the company as if an entirely new company was established. So we may safely say that both companies are different companies. And also this fact can be considered by the following fact that in case of purge judging, both companies are considered to be the different companies.

2. That, in view of the circumstances under which the subject persons have been appointed as officials or in view of their actual activities in executing their duties and powers as officials, they would not be considered as the appointees without causing gross injustice.

A. Circumstances under which I have been appointed as a director:

I served in Kaijima Tanko K.K. (Kaijima Mining Co., Ltd.), which has no connection with Nissan Line, for twenty three years from Nov. 1919 to Apr., 10, 1941. But I retired from the said company on account of my illness and took a rest for about one year. On July, 1942, I assumed office of director of Manshu Yushi K.K. (Manchurian Fat & Oil Co., Ltd.) in response to a recommendation of Mr. Sejiro Yasuda, who was a co-worker while I was in office of Kaijima Tanko K.K. .

But after one year since I entered to this company, I retired from the said company because of my illness again. So I returned to Japan and gave myself to rest. While this time I was requested to enter Nissan Yuso Hikoki K.K. (Nissan Transportation Airplane Co., Ltd.) aiming at manufacture of wooden glider, which was planning to establish in Tottori Pref., from Mr. Jisaburo Fukuda, president of the said company. In response to his request, I participated in this enterprise for about half a year. But this enterprise was not completed, so there was no room for active service.

After that, when Mr. Yoshihiko Sasaki, who was a senior to me in my native country and also was in office of director and a Chief of Accounting Section of Nippon Yushi K.K. (Japan Fat & Oil Co., Ltd.), changed his post to a Chief of Inspection Section of the said company, there was no properly qualified successor for the post in the company. At the time, I received the request for entrance into the said company as a person in charge of accounting business. Then, I assumed office of director & a Chief of Accounting Section of the said company on Oct., 1944.

Therefore, my assumption of office of director of Nippon Yushi K.K. (Japan Fat & Oil Co., Ltd.) absolutely depend upon my private relation with Mr. Yoshihiko Sasaki, so NISSAN ZAIBATSU has no connection with my assumption of office.

B. Actual activities in executing my duties and powers as a director:

My assumption of an office of director of Nippon Yushi K.K. (Japan Fat & Oil Co., Ltd.) on Oct., 1944 was based on an appreciation for my capability of accounting business.

My principal business as a Chief of Accounting Section was to furnish the funds for construction of lubricating oil plant of our Amagasaki Factory. Accordingly, the fundamental policy on the management of our company was decided by president & vice-president. At that time, I ranked sixteenth among twenty directors and I almost did not participate in any matters except accounting business.

This war ended within less than one year after I assumed office of director of Nippon Yushi K.K. (During the period it was renamed as Nissan Kagaku Kogyo K.K. (Nissan Chemical Industrial Co., Ltd.)), and since then I devoted myself to adjust the company's business.

During that period, I assumed offices of Manshu Yushi K.K. (Manchurian Fat & Oil Co., Ltd.) and other small companies. But I assumed to these offices only according to our company's usage, so these assumption of offices were only nominal post attached to the office of a Chief of Accounting

Section.

When Mr. Gizo Tomabechi, president at that time, tried to enter into political circle, our company adopted four standing directors system in order to adjust our company's administration on Mar. 1946. At that time, I was selected to standing-director only because of high ranking among directors. (My rank became higher autonomically on account of retirement of many other directors on Oct. 1945).

My assumption of offices of director & vice-president on Mar. 1947 was based on the following reason that I rank first as a standing director, and also I was requested to take office as an assistant for Mr. Tomabechi, president at the time, because he was elected to a member of the Diet as a member of Democratic Party. And I assumed office of director & president on June, 1947, succeeding to Mr. Tomabechi due to his retirement, and now is still in office.

Regarding my elevation to vice-president & president, I have received an approval of General Head Quarters through Holding Company Liquidation Commission.

All my assumption of offices depended upon an autonomous management of directors' meeting, and so there is no fact of any control by Nissan Zaibatsu.

C. Circumstances under which I have been appointed as an auditor of Chosen Nissan Kagaku Kogyo K.K. (Korean Nissan Chemical Industry Co., Ltd.) & Taiwan Kagaku K.K. (Formosan Chemical Co., Ltd.)

I worked as an auditor of Chosen Nissan Kagaku Kogyo K.K. from May 25, 1945 to May 27, 1946, and also worked as an

auditor of Taiwan Kagaku K.K.

auditor of Taiwan Kagaku K.K. from May 30, 1946 to Dec. 1, 1946. But my assumption of offices of auditors of both companies was only nominal post attached to an office of a Chief of Accounting Section of Nissan Kagaku Kogyo K.K. as above stated. But I could not participate in actual business on inspection for accounting because both companies were located at far from Nissan Kagaku Kogyo K.K. So my assumption of office of auditors of both companies was quite nominal, and I did not work practically.

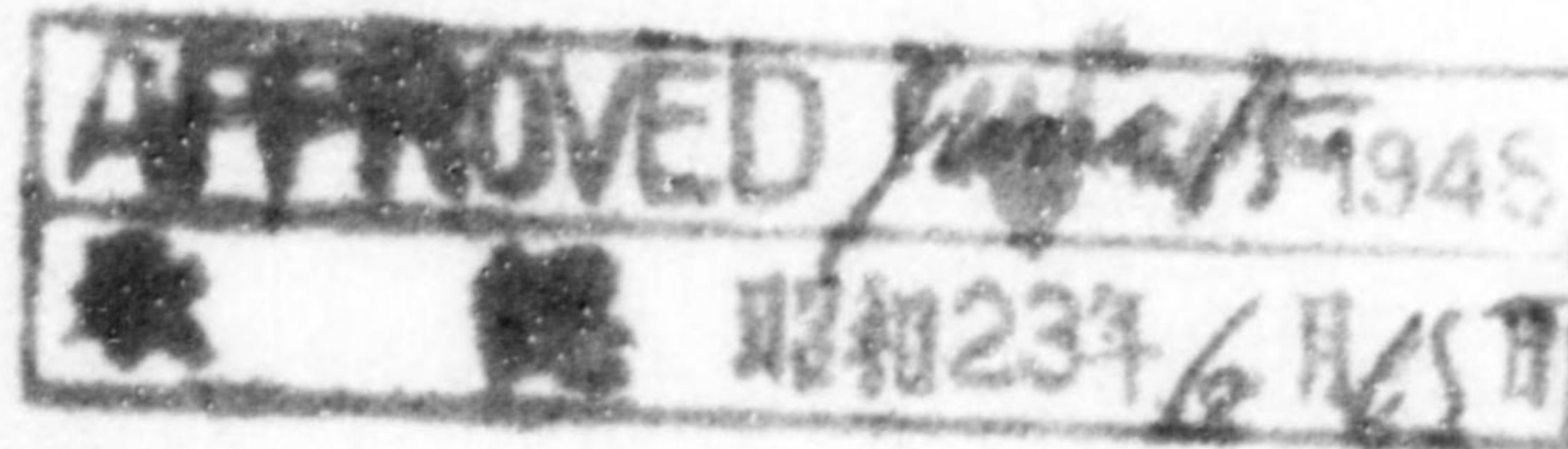

I hereby apply for your approval of my not being the "Zaibatsu appointee" for the reasons stated below in accordance with Article 7 Paragraph 1 of the Law for Termination of the Zaibatsu Family Control.

1. Legal Ground for Application

I assumed before September 2, 1945 a post of director (as from May 12, 1945 till now) of the Yuasa Storage Battery Co., Ltd. which was designated as being one of the "Zaibatsu associate company of the Mitsui Lineage" in accordance with Article 2 of the same law.

However, I believe that I am qualified to apply for your approval of my not being the "Zaibatsu appointee" in accordance with the provisions of Article 7 Paragraph 1, based upon the reason that I satisfy all the conditions prescribed in the respective items of the same article, the same paragraph, because the above-mentioned post of director in the company has not been of the highest responsible official.

2. Description of Reasons for Application

My case satisfies all the following conditions prescribed in Article 7 Paragraph 1 of the Law for Termination of the Zaibatsu Family Control.

- a. That I Am Not a Spouse, Parent, Child, Brother of Sister Including a Spouse of Such Person, of Persons Belonging to the Mitsui Zaibatsu or Their Family Members.
- b. That, With Reference to My Assumption of A Position of Director in the Yuasa Storage Battery Which I Occupied, There Has Never Existed an Agreement With the Mitsui Zaibatsu or Its Direct Affiliates that Their Previous Approval Should Be Obtained, and Moreover That I, on the Occasion of My Assumption, Did Not In Fact Obtain the Previous Approval of the Mitsui Zaibatsu or Its Direct Affiliates.
 - (1) Non-Existence of Any Agreement that Previous Approval Should Be Obtained.

With reference to personnel administration of officials of the Yuasa Storage Battery, there has never existed any agreement of such nature. (Refer to the Attached Document No. 1: Certificate by the Mitsui Honsha)

- (2) That Any Previous Approval Has, in Fact, Never Been Obtained.

It was unconceivable that I, in a capacity of ordinary director, ever exercised the authority or influence commensurate with or surpassing that of the highest responsible official, because throughout my term of office the company had always the president, one senior managing director and until October 10, 1945 one junior managing director in addition, and moreover because the powers of representation^{or} of executing daily business were all vested in the above three persons in accordance with the provisions in the company's articles of incorporation. (Refer to the Attached Document No. 3: Certificate by Yuasa Storage Battery)

- d. That I Have Never Held Concurrently Positions of Official in the Mitsui Zaibatsu Companies Exceeding Three Positions in One Time.

Certified Subjects

(1) Personnel Administration of Officials of the Yuasa Storage Battery Co.

(a) Non-Existence of Agreement Requiring Previous Approval

There was no agreement requiring previous approval of Mitsui relatives, Mitsui Gomei or Mitsui Honsha (including the former Mitsui Bussan) with reference to any appointment of official of the Yuasa Storage Battery.

(b) Previous Approval in Fact

i. Exceptional Cases in Which Previous Approval was Obtained.

Since establishment of the Yuasa Storage Battery, it had been customary for one or two employees of the Mitsui Bussan (chief or vice-chief of Machinery Department, Mitsui Bussan, or chief of Osaka Branch Office of the same company) to concurrently hold a position as part-time official (ordinary director or auditor) of the Yuasa Storage Battery. In every case of assumption of

such additional post, those Mitsui Bussan employees had in fact obtained previous approval of either the Mitsui Bussan or Mitsui Honsha.

ii. Non-existence of Previous Approval in General Cases

The Mitsui relatives, Mitsui Gomei or Mitsui Honsha (including the former Mitsui Bussan) had never intervened in the installation of officials of the Yuasa Storage Battery, other than those mentioned in the preceding paragraph.

Consequently no previous approval was ever obtained in case of appointment of the Yuasa's present directors: Messrs. Ichizo Tsuji, Minoru Kuwata and and Ryoji Yumoto, auditor Bunkichi Ishiguro, and: Messrs. Masaji Tago and Tomohisa Hemmi who were formerly in the post of auditors.

(2) Limit of Controlling Power Exercised by Mitsui Over Management of the Yuasa Storage Battery Co. in General

(a) There was no substantial control of, or interference in the management of the Yuasa Storage Battery by the Mitsui Honsha (including the former Mitsui Bussan), notwithstanding the fact that Mitsui held approximately one-half of the shares of the Yuasa Storage Battery.

(b) The position of part-time officials of the Yuasa Storage Battery held by those who were serving in Mitsui Bussan as full-time employees (Refer to (1) (b)), were all merely of an "ordinary" director or auditor, the position without

power of representation of the company nor power of execution of the daily business. And again Mitsui Bussan or Mitsui Honsha never had intentions of either controlling or interfering with the management of the Yuasa Storage Battery through these officials.

- (3) That the Officials of the Yuasa Storage Battery Have Never Served as Officials in the Companies of the Mitsui Lineage Other Than the Yuasa Storage Battery.

Early in 1918 when the Yuasa Storage Battery Manufactory was reorganized into a joint-stock company, the Mitsui Bussan K. K. decided to subscribe for a part of the shares of the former which was one of its trade correspondents during my term of office as chief of the Machinery Department of the latter. Prior to establishment of this new firm, I concluded a firm agreement with Mr. Hichizaemon Yuasa, the organizer, as follows under acknowledgment of the then representative director of the Mitsui Bussan, Mr. Giichi Iida.

I hereby certify the following subjects with regard to the authority of officers of this company.

Certified Subjects

1. Difference in Extent of Authority of the Respective Directors

Around April 13, 1918 when this company was organized, its directorate were composed of the three grades of president, managing director and ordinary directors. Since and after April 15, 1926 they came to be further classified into four grades of president, senior managing director, junior managing director and ordinary directors as it is today. Twice in the past we experienced a chairmanship system of the board of directors. As to their respective authorities, it is stipulated in the company's articles of incorporation that:

The President shall "convene meeting of the Board of Directors acting as its chairman" and shall "administer the management affairs of the company,"

The Senior Managing Director shall "assist the president and dispose of the management affairs of the company,"

The Junior Managing Director shall "assist the President and the Senior Managing Director, and dispose of such daily management affairs as specifically assigned to him,"

"When there is a vacancy in the post of the President or when he is prevented from executing his duties owing to unavoidable circumstances the Senior Managing Director shall fulfill the duties, and when the post of Senior Managing Director is also vacant together with that of the President or when he is also prevented from executing the President's duties owing to unavoidable circumstances, the Junior Managing Director shall fulfill such duties," and,

"The President, Senior Managing Director and the Junior Managing Director shall respectively represent the company."

On the other hand, the ordinary directors have never had such authority as stated above.

2. Actual Authority or Influence of Those People Having Assumed the Posts of Ordinary Director or Auditor

The following persons were appointed, before September 2, 1945, to the posts of either ordinary director or auditor of this company. There has never existed, however, an occasion of vacancy in all of the posts of the president, senior managing director and the junior managing director, or any such circumstances as would have unavoidably prevented them from executing their duties throughout these gentlemen's terms of office. Consequently, it needs no further explanation that they have never exercised, in fact, authority commensurate with that of the highest responsible officials.

役員就任の事情

私は昭和十九年六月日産化學工業株式會社の前身である日本油脂株式會社の取締役に就任しましたが、元來日本油脂株式會社の役員構成は、創立當時の役員に被合併會社の代表役員を加へて來たものであります。役員に就任しては日産財閥との間に事前了承を必要とする旨の取極は明文の上からも或は内約としても存在せず總て自律的に運営されてゐたので同財閥から何等の指示或は制肘を受けては居りませんでした。昭和十七年十月に至り永年勤続の職員を優遇し職員よりも役員に登用されることと云ふ道が開かれ私は第二回目に入り取締役に就任しました。(第一回は昭和十七年で箕浦多一氏、平川善藏氏が、第二回目は昭和十九年六月で大橋喜久三氏と私が其の選に入りました)が、之は取締役に於て決められた事であつて私が日産財閥と個人的に何等かのつながり乃至は恩恵を受けた意味はなく、又指圖を受けたのでもなく、全く會社の自主的運営による取締役會の決議に基くものであります。

11. (b) - 2 (a)

In June 1944 I was appointed to the office of director of the Nippon Yushi K.K. (Japan Fat & Oil Co., Ltd.) which was the antecedent of the present Nissan Kagaku Kogyo K.K. (Nissan Chemical Industrial Co., Ltd.)

The officers' organization of the Nippon Yushi K.K. originally consisted of the officers at the time of company's establishment and representative officers of the amalgamated companies by the former. However there were no such arrangements as to need understanding between the Nissan Zaibatsu and officers before the appointment or retirement of the directorship both in the written provisions and in the company's traditions. As such a business had been done autonomously like we above-mentioned, the officers had never had any directives nor influences from the said Zaibatsu.

In October 1942 a chance to give directorship even to the employees in long service in order to pay such people well was opened to the ordinary employees. I entered in this selection in the second time and was appointed director. (The first selection was made in 1942 to give directorship to Messrs. Taichi Minoura & Zenzo Hirakawa and the second selection in 1944 to Mr. Kikuzo Ohashi & I.) These selections were arranged by the Board of Directors and never mean that I had some personal relationship to the Nissan Zaibatsu, that I was offered a

special grace or that I received directives from them.
These were really based upon the decision of the Board of
Directors according to the independent management of
the company.

Co., Ltd.) on Apr. 1, 1945. And then I assumed

That the Zaibatsu company wherein the subject person held, prior to Sept. 2, 1945, the position of official, had not been, during the period when he served as such, subject to the control of the Zaibatsu of the one and same lineage or of any Zaibatsu company designated as belonging to such Zaibatsu.

Nippon Yushi K.K. (Japan Fat & Oil Co., Ltd.) predecessor of present Nissan Kagaku Kogyo K.K. (Nissan Chemical Industrial Co., Ltd.) was placed under the control of Nippon Sangyo K.K. (Japan Industrial Co., Ltd.) (NISSAN ZAIBATSU supervised by Mr. Gisuke Ayukawa) on June, 1937. But on December 27, 1937, Nippon Sangyo K.K. dissolved and had started afresh as Manshu Jukogyo K.K. (Manchurian Heavy Industry Co., Ltd.) On that occasion, it parted from the enterprises in Japanese island, so since then Nippon Yushi K.K. carried out its management from its own standpoint. (Refer to document evidence No. 1)

Accordingly, it was quite short period that Nippon Yushi K.K. was placed under the control of NISSAN ZAIBATSU.

That is, on Oct., 1944 when I assumed office of director of Nippon Yushi K.K., Nippon Yushi K.K. was quite free from Nippon Sangyo K.K. and had been managed independently basing on the decision of director's meeting.

Furthermore, Nippon Yushi K.K. took over all the business belonging to Chemical Section of Nippon Kogyo K.K. (Japan Mining Co., Ltd.) on April, 1945, and changed
