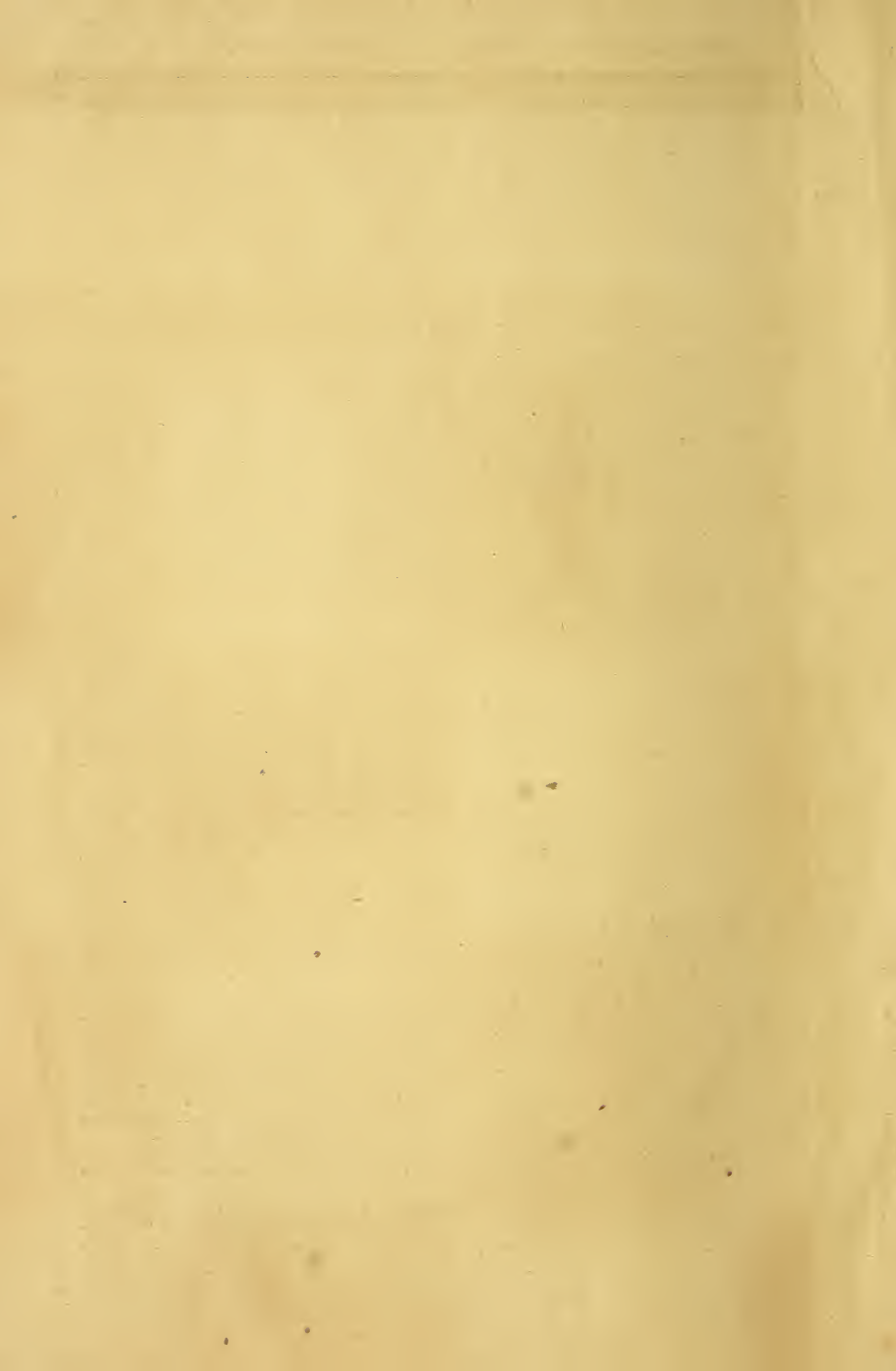

P R E F A C E .

THERE is among conscientious persons no little indiscriminating prejudice in regard to amusements that partake of the nature of Games, whether of skill or of chance. The question is an important one, Which are innocent, and which are dangerous? How shall we draw the line?

We think the true distinction is suggested by the words *Skill* and *Chance*. A game which is a contest of pure *skill* is not only harmless, if moderately indulged in, but may be of great value in exercising and resting the mind, for recreation does not consist so much in doing nothing, as in change of employment; hence, any thing not injurious in its tendency, that contributes to recreate, and at the same time to employ the mind, is of benefit, and as such, is desirable.

A game of *Hazard* or *Chance* involves one of the main elements of gambling, and should not be encouraged, especially among the young.

Chess and Draughts lie on one side of this line; the various games of card-playing, we suppose, on the other. Any and all amusements, of course, become injurious if carried to excess.

The design of the Editor of this work has been to supply a book of home amusement. The beauties of the game of Draughts are so little understood in common, although the game *itself* is extensively used; and for social pastime, it having so many advantages over any other game, it was believed that a work that could make plain the principles of this interesting and scientific game, would do much to supplant in the family circle the amusement furnished by games of a less elevated character.

INTRODUCTORY.

THE few works in point, on the subject of Draughts, in this country, are mostly of European origin, held at high prices, and very difficult to obtain; and, in most cases without any systematic, classified, and simple arrangement of the games. The want of a small and cheap work, not having the above objections, has long been felt; and it is the object of this work to meet the want of the public in this respect, to furnish a cheap work on the subject of Draughts, as also to give the strong openings of each game, as approved by the acknowledged authors. A good foundation to build upon is very forcibly exemplified in the game of Draughts, as it is well known that the first few moves often determine the loss of the game.

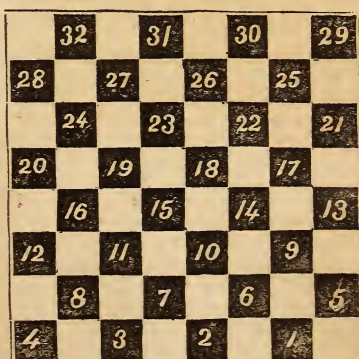
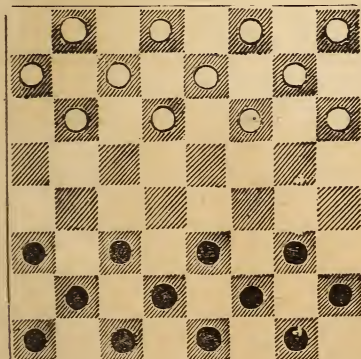
The games in this work are arranged in the following order, beginning with the lowest moves, and ascending: thus, "Edinburgh, first, as it commences 9 to 13, the "Bristol," last, as it commences 11 to 16. [The opening moves, 10, 14, and 12, 16 are not noticed in this work, as they are regarded as weak.] 11 to 15, it will be noticed, is the opening of a majority of the games. The name or peculiarity of the game is determined by the first few opening moves.

In the following pages, it will be observed that the *Games* have reference marks in figures, which refer to variations that may be made on that move, and the variations immediately follow the games in their numerical order; thus, by looking at the termination of the variations you may see if the variation be drawn or lost. All games properly played will be drawn.

As this work is not intended for professional players, we shall make our remarks and instructions as simple and concise as possible. This, it should always be remembered, is purely a game of calculation, and as such, craves wary policy.

The game is played on a board of sixty-four squares, of alternate colors, and with 24 pieces, called men, of adverse colors, red and white being preferable. It is played by two persons played opposite to each other; the one having the red or black pieces is said to be playing the *first side*, and the other, having the 12 white, to be playing the *second side*.

The following diagrams represent the board and men in their original position; and also the mode in which the squares are conveniently numbered for reference and instruction.



The men being placed, the game is begun by each of the players moving alternately one of his men across the angles of the squares—the black moving first. The *men* can only move forward, one square at a time, until they have attained the extreme opposite row, where they become *kings*, and are design-

nated by placing one checker upon the other, when they can be played either backwards or forwards diagonally, but still only one square at a time. The men capture in the direction they move by leaping over any hostile piece that may be contiguous, provided there be a vacant white square behind them to set the piece upon, and the man thus *leaped* is removed from the board.— When there are two ways of capturing, you may take your choice whether in one way you may get one man, or the other way more, and not as in Polish Draughts, where you are required to take the greater number. When, however, you reach what is termed the *King Row*, whether by a jump or otherwise, that terminates the move until your opponent shall have moved. excepting when you leap in with a piece that is already a King, when you may then leap out again, if a piece lies in the way of a capture; but a single piece finishes his move on reaching the king row, when, if there is a piece in the way of capture, you must wait to be crowned, and your opponent can then move it away, or make any other move he sees proper. A king or single piece can take any number of men, provided there are intermediate vacant single squares between each piece, in the direction the piece is moving.

When a person neglects to take a piece that is in his power to take, his opponent can make a play called *Huffing*, which consists in removing the piece from the board that should have captured; for, at Draughts you have not the option of refusing to take, as at Chess, but must always take when you can, whatever be the consequence. The party huffing, however, has the option to huff or compel the *take*, or let the piece remain. If he huffs, and takes your piece from the board, he has also a move; hence, “a huff and a move go together.” It is not uncommon for novices to take one man and overlook a second or third; in that case he is also liable to a huff.

[Huffing is not commonly practised in this country. The custom is to call the attention of the party to the position, who is supposed to have overlooked it.]

The game is won by him who can first succeed either in capturing or blocking up all his adversary's men, so that he has nothing left to move; but when the pieces are so reduced that each player has a very small degree of force remaining, and being equal in numbers, and no choice of position, neither can make any decided impression on his antagonist, the game is relinquished as *DRAWN*. It is obvious, that were this not the case, and both parties had one or two kings, the game might be prolonged with a hopeless chance of natural termination. There is one other remark to make in these instances, previous to giving the Laws of the Game, and that is the “Theory of the Move:”

In particular situations, to have the move on your side is a decided advantage. One half of the games won by finished players is done by getting and holding the move. This a matter little understood by ordinary players, but its importance is shown by the study of the critical positions given in the diagrams on the last pages of this work. To have the move, signifies your occupying that position on the board which will eventually enable you to force your adversary into a confined situation, and which at the end of the game secures to yourself the last move, or the loss of a piece by your opponent.

There are many learned and ingenious explanations given how to calculate the move, with the reasons, but they are all too technical and mathematical for a work of this kind, we will therefore give in as plain and as few words as possible, sufficient knowledge for the purpose.

On your board there will be found four black squares on the side nearest you numbered 1, 2, 3, 4; immediately over these squares, in vertical lines, are twelve other squares, numbered 9, 17, 25—10, 18, 26—11, 19 27, and 12, 20, 28. These 16 squares are all that we take cognizance of in our present calculations. Now count all the men (of both colors,) that may be on these 16 black squares, and if the number is an *uneven* number, as one, three, or five, then whomsoever's move it is *has the move*: if the number of pieces is *even* on these squares, of course the move is against the person having to move.

Exception.—When there are two pieces of opposite colors in either of the *double corners*, the rule is reversed. When you have not the move, you must endeavor to get it by an exchange of man for man, which will generally change the move. This is exemplified in the critical positions before referred to.

LAWS OF THE GAME.

1. Each player to play alternately with the Black and White men, and Black to play first.

2. If the person whose turn it is to play touch a piece, he must move that piece if possible; and if any part of it be played over an angle of the square, the play must be completed in that direction.

3. A capturing play, as well as an ordinary one is completed whenever the hand has been withdrawn from the piece played, even although one or more pieces could have been taken.

4. When at the end of the game, a small degree of force alone remains, the player appearing the stronger, may be required by the weaker to win the game in a certain number of moves, and if he cannot do this, the game is declared drawn. *Three kings to two* is allowed forty moves; *two kings to one* is allowed twenty moves, counting the moves of both men as one move; the moves to be counted from the time such notice is given.

REMARKS.

Upon no consideration be induced to play for a wager, no matter how trifling.

Generally, it is better to keep your men in the middle of the board than to play them on the side squares, as, in the latter case, one half of their power is curtailed. When you have once gained an advantage in the number of your pieces, you increase the proportion by exchanges; but in forcing the exchanges you must take care not to damage your position. Never touch the squares with your finger, as some do, with the supposition that it assists their powers of calculation, but accustom yourself to play your move off-hand, when you have once made up your mind.

Remember, there must be a motive for every move; the perpetually recurring question should therefore be, what will be the result of this move? or that? and answer it by calculating the result of every probable move at the stage in question. After a few weeks' perseverance in this discipline, you will, if possessed of a tolerable memory, become an expert player, and the game itself will contribute to you an increased pleasure in the exercise of playing it.

We would recommend to beginners to learn thoroughly a few games first, with two or three variations, and try and force your opponent into them. The "Old Fourteenth," "Souter," "Laird and Lady," "Cross," and "Single Corner," are games much played, and it would be well to make yourself familiar with them. Of course, there are other games equally interesting to these named; but as we name but a few, these are suggested, as they are more commonly played, and your opponent will the more readily fall in with them. Try and keep the game on the variations you have examined in the book, but the moment your opponent breaks from them, exercise your judgment, and not your memory. You can afterwards examine these moves where you were defeated, and correct them at your leisure, which will avoid a repetition of them.

In the following games, the correct result of the play is given; thus, as "Drawn," or "B. wins," &c., although the game is not played down to the final close. In many instances the correct play is obvious, and in others it is more hidden, and consequently will tax the skill of players somewhat in bringing about the proper result. As he has in words the true solution, he must make his play inevitably come to that termination. As the *answer* to an arithmetical problem serves as a guide to tell when correct, but not as a key to assist in finding the true solution.

Finally, bear in mind what has been termed the "Three Golden Rules of Draughts:"—*Play* deliberately; *Win* with modesty; and *Lose* with good temper.
