  I ASKED TOM KOROLOGOS, DEPUTY ASSISTANT TO PRESIDENT FOR LEGIS—

  LATIVE AFFAIRS, IF HE COULD THROU LIGHT ON BAKER PROBLEM. HE SAID

  IN CONFIDENCE BAKER HAD DISCUSSED \*\*GENCY/UATERGATE MATTER WITH

  HIM AND MADE CLEAR THAT BAKER'S CENTRAL HANGUP IS THESIS ADVANCED

  BY COPERLAND AND ST. GEORGE THAT AGENCY STAGED WATERGATE IN ORDER

  TO ENTRAP PLUMBERS. KOROLOGOS INDICATED BAKER MAY HAVE BEEN

  PARTICULARLY INFLUENCED BY COPELAND ALLEGATIONS.

CONSISTENT WITH AGENCY TESTIMONYS AND RECORDS AVAILABLE TO BAKER.

MOREOVER, MARTINEZ SAID STURGIS DENIES ALLEGATIONS WHICH ST. GEORGE

ATTRIBUTES TO HIM. HOWEVER, MARTINEZ DID STATE TO BAKER THAT HE

CONSIDERED TRADECRAFT OF PLUMBERS UNBELIEVABLY FAULTY. FROM THOIS

CAPPARENTLY A NEUSLETTER--UNDERSTAND HE IS NO LONGER ASSOCIATED WITH LOS ANGELES TIMES ALTHOUGH THEY SYNDICATE HIS MATERIAL) OF LL DECEMBER ENTITLED "CAN HE BLAME IT ON CIA?" FULL TEXT, WHICH HAS NOT YET APPEARED IN ANY PUBLICATION WE KNOW OF, FOLLOWS:

COULD BE MADE SALABLE, IT MIGHT EGET RICHARD NIXON OFF THE HOOK.
CONSIDER: IF CIA ACCOMPLISHED THE BREAK-IN, THE SUBSEQUENT WHITE
HOUSE COVERUP MIGHT BE EXCUSED ON THE GROUNDS THAT THE PRESIDENT HAD
TO PROTECT EHIS SECRET INTELLIGENCE SERIVCE. AND IF THE ECOVERUP
COULD BE EXCUSED ON THAT GROUND, UNRELATED CRIMES SUCH AS ILLEGAL
CONTRIBUTIONS, FORGERIES AND ALLEGED EXTORTIONS MIGHT BE PARDONED

AS IMISTAKES OF JUDGMENT ARISING FROM EXCESSIVE POLITICAL ZEAL. THUS, "SOME SINISTER FORCE," GEN. ALEXANDER HAIG PUT IT TO JUDGE JOHN J. SIRICA THE OTHER DAY, MIGHT EVENTUALLY BE USED TO EXPLAIN ALL. THREE RECENT MAGAZINE ARTICLES--TUO PUBLISHED IN THE MATIONALBERG REVIEW BY A FORMER CIA EMPLOYEE NAMED MILES COPELAND; THE OTHER, PUBLISHED IN HARPEGRS BY ANDREW ST. GEORGE--SUGGEST THE PRESIDENT'S SEN. BAKER HAS CALLED THE ATTENTION OF ALL THREE LAST STAND. AURTICLES TO HIS COLLEAGUES ON THE ERVIN COMMITTEE. COPELAND ALLEGES THAT THE WATERGATE OPERATION WAS CIA'S RETALIATION AGAINST. THE WHITE HOUSE FOR SETTING UP THE PULLMBERS AS A RIVAL APPARAT. "MCCORD TOOK LIDDY INTO A TRAP," HE URITES, AND "AFTER ALL, THE CIA SPECIALISTS IN OPERATIONS OF THE PLUMBERS' KIND HAD A LOT TO GAIN BY PUTTING THE WHITE HOUSE CLOWNS OUT OF EBUSINESS." ST. HAS MADE YOU ITS DIRECTOR. YOU FEEL THE RESPONSIBILITY KEENLY. NOU CONSIDER WHAT HAPPENS TO YOU IN THE SUBSEDQUENT ADMINISTRACTION. FIRST, AN OLD FRIEND OF THE PRESIDENT, PATRICK GRAY, IS APPOINTED TO BE CHIEF OF YOUR MAJOR RIVAL AGENCY. ONE MONTH LATER, YOU ARE TOLD BY H-R. HALDEMAN THAT THE PHRESIDENT HAS APPOINTED ANOTHER OLD FRIEND, GEN. VERNON WALTERS, TO BE YOUR DEPUTY. AMOTHER MONTH LATER, AND JUST AFTER THE BREAK-IN, YOU AND YOUR NEW DEPUTY ARE SUMMONED TO THE WHITE HOUSE. YOU LISTEN WHILE HALDEMAN TELLS YOUR DEPUTY THAT "IT HAS BEEN DECIDED" THAT HE SHOULD GO TO GRAY AND ASK HIM NOT TO INVESTIGATE THE MONEY FOUND ON THE BURGLARS BECAUSE IT MIGHT EXPOSE YOUR OPERATIONS. FOR THE NEUXT FEW DAYS: THE WHITE HOUSE CALLS TO DISCUSS THE BREAK-IN AND TO SSUGGEST THAT YOU PAY MONEY TO THE FAMILIES OF THOSE ARRESTED. ELEVEN DAYS AFTER THE BREAK-IN AND ON THE EVE OF YOUR DEPARTURE FOR A LONG-SCHEDULED TRIP, GRAY CALLS TO CANCEL AN APPOINTMENT YOU HAD MADDE WITH HIM. WITH THIS SEQUENCE OF EVENTS IN MINID, WHAT WOULD YOU SUPPOSE? THAT PEOPLE AT THE UHITE HOUSE MIGHT BE TRYING TO BLANE THE WATERGATE ON YOU? THAT'S WHAT HELMS SUPPOSED AND SUPPOSES STILL."
