2. It is desired that the following corrections be made:

a. The difference between the number of machines inventoried by your Headquarters, and the number of machines listed on the inclosed list of letter referred to in par 1 a, should be investigated and justified by comment in basic letter.

b. Reparation inventory should be made on regular blank forms herewith attached, as par 10, Directive referred to in par 1 c, instructed.

c. Machine numbers should be assigned consecutively to all the machinery to be inventoried within a given plant which has been given a parenthetical location code, as par III 4, Directive referred to in par 1 b, instructs.

d. Inventory sheets will be prepared in duplicate. The originals of all inventory sheets will be forwarded to the SCAP, Economic and Scientific Section, together with one copy of the plant cover sheet. Duplicate copies of the plant cover sheet and inventory sheets will be filed in the office of the prefectural government. One copy of each plant cover sheet will be forwarded to the Headquarters Eighth Army.
