Cabinet Order No. 326

Order for Immigration Surveillance Liaison Council

In accordance with the provisions of Article 5 paragraph 2 of Order concerning Immigration Surveillance (Cabinet Order No. 299 of 1949), the Cabinet establishes this Cabinet Order.

(Responsibilities)

Article 1. The Immigration Surveillance Liaison Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") shall deliberate on necessary matters for the purpose of promoting liaison and coordination among the functions of the administrative organs concerned with respect to the immigration surveillance, the prevention of illegal entry and the deportation of illegal entrants, etc.

(Organization)

Article 2. The Council shall be composed of Administrative Vice-Minister for Foreign Affairs and members not exceeding twenty in number.

- 2 The members of the Council shall be appointed by the Minister for Foreign Affairs from among the personnel of the various administrative agencies concerned.
- 3 The members shall be of part-time service.

 (Duties of Chairman)
- Article 3. Administrative Vice-Minister for Foreign Affairs shall preside over the affairs of the Council as Chairman.
- In case the Chairman is prevented from discharging his duties, a member designated in advance by the Chairman shall act for him.

 (Secretaries)

Article 4. The Council shall have secretaries not exceeding twenty in number.

- 2 The secretaries shall be appointed by the Minister for Foreign Affairs from among the personnel of the various administrative agencies concerned.
- 3 The secretaries shall assist the members of the Council in performing the functions in its charge.
- 4 The secretaries shall be of past-time service.

(Miscellaneous Affairs)

Article 5. The miscellaneous affairs of the Council shall be handled by the Immigration Service Division of the Controls Bureau of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs,

(Miscellaneous Provision)

Article 6. Other than those provided for in the preceding Articles, procedural and other necessary matters for the operation of the Council shall be determined by the Chairman.

Supplementary Provision:

This Cabinet Order shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation.

In accordance with the Ordinance concerning the Orders to be issued in consequence of the Acceptance of the Potsdam Declaration (Imperial Ordinance No. 542 of 1945) the Cabinet establishes this Cabinet Order.

The Cabinet Order concerning the Custody and Disposition, etc. of the Properties of Dissolved Organizations (Cabinet Order No. 238 of 1948) shall be partially amended as follows:

In Article 7 paragraph 3, "In case there is any one bid for purchase of any one unit of real property amounting to \(\frac{\frac{1}{2}}{200,000}\) or more or application for purchase of movable properties in a lot amounting to \(\frac{\frac{1}{2}}{50,000}\) or more" shall be amended as "In case there is any one bid for purchase of any one unit of real property amounting to \(\frac{1}{2}\)1,500, 000 or more", and "or application" shall be deleted.

In Article 14, Among the claims and liabilities submitted to the Attorney-General as provided in Article 15 of this Cabinet Order, those in amount of \(\frac{2}{2}00,000\) or more shall be submitted by the Attorney-General to the General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, Civil Property Custodian for approval. Concerning the others, the Attorney-General may decide whether to pay in whole or in part, or not, without prior approval of the Civil Property Custodian" shall be amended as "Concerning the claims and liabilities submitted to the Attorney-General may decide whether to pay in whole or in part, or not".

The following one paragraph shall be added as paragraph 4 in Article 23:

4. Insofar as the application of this Cabinet Order is concerned, GUNJIN KAIKAN, Foundational Juridical Person, shall be regarded as a Dissolved Organization defined in Article 1.

In Article 24, "the preceding Article" shall be amended as "the preceding Article paragraphs 1 to 3 inclusive".

In Article 26, "Article 23" shall be amended as "Article 23, paragraphs 1 to 3 inclusive".

Supplementary Provisions:

- 1 This Cabinet Order shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation.
- 2 Amended provisions in Article 7 paragraph 3 and in Article 14 shall also apply to cases which have taken place prior to the enforcement of this Cabinet Order. However, provisions hitherto in force shall apply to cases of which the Attorney-General or the Sales Commission of Dissolved Organization's Properties have requested the approval of the General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, Civil Property Custodian, prior to July 31, 1949.
- 3 The term prescribed in Article 4 and Article 5 paragraph 1 shall be counted from the day of enforcement of this Cabinet Order, insofar as GUNJIN KAIKAN, Foundational Juridical Person is concerned.

Article 4. In case To, Do, Fu or prefecture intends to make an important change in any particular to be stated in the papers mentioned in the preceding Article, it shall notify the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry in advance.

2 In case the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry has received a notice mentioned in the preceding paragraph, he may, if he deems it necessary, instruct an alteration in the said particulars reported.

Article 5. In case To, Do, Fu or prefecture has completed a work relating to the facilities mentioned in item (7) in the annexed Table, it shall submit a demand for subsidy together with a statement of business results and a statement of settled receipts and disbursements (with three sets of copies attached) to the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry by April 5 in the following fiscai year.

Article 6. A statement of business results and a statement of settled receipts and disbursements to be submitted in accordance with the provisions of Art. 7 of the Regulations and the preceding Article shall be prepared in the Forms No. 1 and No. 2 annexed hereto respectively.

LOCAL AUTONOMY MATTERS

TOKYO METROPOLIS

Establishment of By-Law concerning the Control of Swimming Places

In Tokyo Metropolitan Office, the following By-law was established on May 19, 1949:

Tokyo Metropolitan By-law No. 55 By-law concerning the control of swimming places

Article 1. "Swimming places" in this By-law means places where they set in river, sea, etc. and let the public swim there.

Article 2. "Competent chief" in this By-law means director of Health Center in whose district the swimming place is located.

Article 3, When a person wants to open a swimming place he must submit application for approval to the Competent chief and must get his approval.

Article 4. A person who wants to operate a swimming place by charging (including charge under such name as maintenance fee, membership fee and others.) must add 1,000 yen as fee for approving swimming place business to the application provided for in the preceding Article. The same is true with a man who wants to operate swimming place. However, the fee is not collected when Tokyo-to, or ward, city, town or village opens, or operates by taking over it.

Article 5. Competent chief can set a term of validity to the approval provided for in Article 3, or he can refuse to approve if he thinks the place of setting a swimming pool is not suitable from the viewpoint of public health.

Article 6. A man who operates a swimming pool (he will be called just "operator" hereinafter) must take necessary measures as to sanitation of his swimming pool, and swimmers, public morals and prevention of danger.

Concerning the standards of the abovementioned measures, the governor decides them.

Article 7. When they violate standards provided for in paragraph 2 of the preceding Article, Competent chief can order them to stop the business for a certain period, or he can order them to repair or rebuild.

Article 8. When he thinks it necessary, the governor or Competent chief can ask an operator or other people concerned to submit report, or he can send his personnel into swimming place and its annex buildings to inspect how they are carrying out the measures provided for in paragraph 1 of Article 6.

The abovementioned personnel is called environmental sanitation inspectors, and they must keep their identification card with them when they come into an institution for inspection, and they must show it when asked by the concerned.

Article 9. Competent chief can cancel the approval of opening swimming place, when they come under any of the following:

(1) If they do not open within 30 days from the date of approval or if they close more than 30 days, without proper reason;

(2) If they violate orders provided for in Article 7. Article 10. A man who violates provisions of Article 3 shall be fined less than 10,000 yen or will be detained.

Article 11. A man who falls under one of the following shall be fined less than 5,000 yen:

(1) A man who violates the provisions of Article 6;

(2) A man who neglects a report provided for in paragraph 1 of Article 8, or makes a false report, refuses inspection by the concerning official, hinders or evades it.

Article 12. When a representative of a juridical person or a person, or an employee violates provisions of Article 10 or the preceding Article concerning the business of the juridical person or Sanitation Section, the item 2 shall be deleted. of person, not only the violator shall be punished but also the juridical person or person shall be fined as provided for in the By-law.

Article 13. As to items necessary for the execution of this By-law the governor shall decide them. Article 14. As to swimming pools, these By-law shall be applied correspondingly.

Supplementary Provisions:

This By-law shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation.

If a swimming place that was approved by the former Regulations and has been operated does not meer the provisions of this By-law, it can be ordered to rebuild, or stop or close, or the approval can be cancelled.

NAGASAKI PREFECTURE

Partial Amendment to the Regulations of Nagasaki Prefectural Government

The Nagasaki Prefectural Government amended the following Regulations on July 8, 1949:

In Article 7, the paragraph concerning the Local Section shall be amended as follows:

Local Section

- (1) Matters concerning the prefectural branch and local officers:
- (2) Matters concerning guidance and supervision of city, town and village offices and other public organizations;
- (3) Matters concerning city, town and village taxes and city, town and village refund taxes;
- (4) Matters concerning encouragement of savings;
- (5) Public service qualification examination (including teachers' screening), surveillance of purgees and investigation of former military and naval officers;
- (6) Matters relating to the Cabinet Crder No. 64 of 1949 (Organization, etc. Control Order) and the Cabinet Order No. 238 of 1948 (concerning the custody and disposition of properties of dissolved organizations);
- (7) Matters relating to administrative scriveners;
- (8) Fire prevention affairs;
- (9) Synthetic adjustment of the affairs in charge of the General Affairs Department;
- (10) Affairs not in charge of the other sections and departments of the Prefectural Office.

In Article 9 paragraph 2 concerning the Medical Affairs Section, the following item shall be put in next to Item (8), and the existing item (9) shall be

changed to item (10), with successive change of the item numbers:

(9) Matters concening guidance and training of .. nurses;

In Article 9 the paragraph concerning Public Supplementary Provision:

This Regulation shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation.

Amendment of Regulation

The Nagasaki Prefectural Government amended the following Regulations on July 15, 1949:

In Article 4, "Finance Sub-section" shall be added next to "Investigation Sub-section", of the Proceedings Section.

Supplementary Provision:

This Regulation shall apply as from July 1, 1949.

AICHI PREFECTURE

Establishment of By-law concerning Parades and Mass Public Demonstrations

In Aichi Prefecture the following By-law was established on July 1, 1949:

By-law concerning Parades and Mass Public Demonstrations

Article 1. In order to maintain the public safety and to protect the right of the public to use the street, park or plaza, any parade or mass public demonstration marching on or occupying any street, park or plaza shall require in advance a permit issued by the Public Safety Commission concerned.

No parmit shall be necessary in case of falling under any of the following items:

- (1) In case the number of persons is less than 500;
- (2) Events, such as funeral rites or festival;
- (3) Sports and other gymnastic events;
- (4) Events conducted by schools, government and public offices as customary performances.

Article 2. A written application for the permit provided for in preceding Article shall be made to the Public Safety Commission concerned by the sponsoring individual or the representative of the sponsoring organization (hereinunder referred to as the sponsor) not less than seventy-two hours prior to the time of such parade or mass public demonstration, in accordance with the procedure stipulated by the Public Safety Commission con-

Article 3. The application in preceding Article shall contain the following information:

- (1) Date and time of the proposed parade or mass public demonstration;
- (2) Name and address of sponsor and participating organizations;

- (3) Route and / or location of the proposed parade or mass public demonstration;
- (4) Estimated number of participants;
- (5) Purpose and nature of the proposed parade or mass public demonstration.

Article 4. The Public Safety Commission must issue a permit unless the parade or mass public demonstration would clearly provoke imminent danger to the public safety.

Denial of permit required by Article 1 shall be reported promptly with full particulars and reasons to the assembly of the prefecture, city, town or village to which the Public Safety Commission

In issuing a permit in Article 1, the Public Safety Commission may attach to the permit such appropriate conditions concerning matters given in preceding Article as it deems necessary to protect the public safety or the right of the public. Article 5. Any person who organizes or participates in a parade or mass public demonstration without a permit provided for in Article 1, who wilfully makes a false statement in the application required by Article 2, or who violates any condition that may be attached to the permit in accordance with paragraph 3 of preceding Article, shall be subject to imprisonment for not more than one year or a fine not exceeding \\ \frac{4}{50,000} \text{ or both.}

Article 6. Nothing in this By-law shall be construed to prohibit or limit in any way the right to hold public assemblies other than parades or mass public demonstrations as defined in Article 1, or to authorize the supervision or censorship by the Public Safety Commission, police officials, or other officials of the prefecture, city, town or village of public meetings, political activities, placards, publications, or other printed or written matters.

Article 7. Nothing in this By-law shall be construed to contravene laws relating to the election of public officials or to require advance notice of political meetings or speeches during election campaigns.

Article 8. Respecting the member of persons provided for in item (1) of Proviso of Art. 1, and the time limit prescribed in Art. 2, the city, town or village to which the Public Safety Commission belongs may increase or decrease, or extend or shorten them by By-law when there is a special necessity.

Supplementary Provisions:

This By-law shall come into force as from the day which has passed three days after the day of its promulgation.

TOYAMA PREFECTURE

Establishment of By-law concerning Mass Movement

In Toyama Prefecture, the following By-law as established on July 12, 1949:

By-law concerning Mass Movement

(Purpose)

Article 1. This By-law aims at enacting the necessary requirements so that the mass movement may not intrude on others' just right or public security by occupying or parading the streets, plazas or parks and other public gathering places. (Scope of permission)

Article 2. Before holding the mass movement, the holder shall have to get permission from the competent Public Safety Commission. However, the following cases shall be exceptions:

(1) Customary events such as weddings, funerals and festivals;

(2) Physical training movement such as mere sports, athletic meets, etc.;

(3) Events held by Government and public offices schools, etc.;

(4) Other cases designated by the Public Safety Commission.

(Application for permission)

Article 3. Application for permission in conformity to the preceding Article shall have to be made, 72 hours prior to the holding of the mass movements, to the Public Safety Commission in the written statement from the superintending individual or representative of organizations.

(Content of written application for permission) Article 4. The following Articles shall have to be filled in the preceding application:

(1) Date of mass movement;

(2) Address, job, name of the responsible person and names of all the affiliated organizations;

(3) Place and course of parade of mass movement;

(4) Estimated participants;

(5) Purpose and method of mass movement.

2 In case the preceding items shall be changed, the holder shall, 24 hours prior to the holding of mass movement, get permission of change in a written statement. (Permission)

Article 5. The Public Safety Commission shall, except those cases where it is evident that others' just right or public safety might not be maintained by the mass movement, have to permit it.

2 The Public Safety Commission shall, in case the movement was not permitted under the preceding paragraph, have to report the effect with detailed reasons to the competent local public entity assembly.

3 The Public Safety Commission may, upon issuing the permit under the provision of paragraph 1, add terms necessary to maintenance of others' just right or public safety.

(Penal regulations)

Article 6. He who did'nt get permission under Article 2, planned or commanded the mass movement conducted in violation of paragraph 3 of the

or on the application for change, shall be subjected one o'clock in the afternoon. to penal servitude less than 1 year or fine below ¥5,000.

2 He who violated the preceding paragraph, shall be subjected to both penal servitude and fine under the preceding Article, if circumstances demand, etc. (Relation with other laws and ordinances)

Article 7. This By-law shall in no way prohibit or restrict the right to hold meetings other than mass movement under the provisions of Article 1, or in no way give the Public Safety Commission, police officials, police and other public servants, the authority to supervise meetings or political activities or to censor placards, publications and others

Article 8. This By-law shall have no bearings in any way on election laws and ordinanses, nor shall it demand advance report on political meetings or speeches during the election campaign. (By-law)

Article 9. Items necessary for the enforcement of this By-law shall be established by the Public Safety Commission.

Supplementary Provision:

This By-law shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation.
