While over INO JIMA Lieutenant J. L. RICE, U.S.N.R., carrying Capt. Kyle GILLESPIE, U.S.N.C. received orders from CASCU to strafe a rocket launcher position in area 201 - A and thereby point it out to another marine observer in the area.
