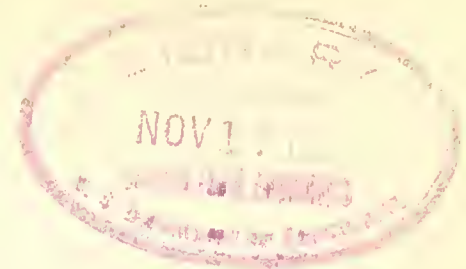

STOCKS OF LEAF TOBACCO OWNED BY DEALERS AND MANUFACTURERS

OCTOBER 1, 1938

Stocks of leaf tobacco owned by dealers and manufacturers in the United States and Puerto Rico on October 1, 1938, amounted to 2,225,714,000 pounds compared with 2,047,133,000 pounds on October 1, 1937. Total stocks were 47,214,000 pounds higher than on July 1, 1938, and 178,526,000 pounds higher than on October 1 a year ago.

Stocks of flue-cured tobacco were reported as 1,005,117,000 pounds on October 1, 1938, about 192 million pounds higher than on July 1, 1938, and about 90 million pounds higher than the October 1, 1937, stocks. The stocks of Type 11 on October 1, 1938, were reported as 346,436,000 pounds; Type 12 as 332,655,000 pounds; Type 13 as 227,795,000 pounds; and Type 14 as 98,231,000 pounds.

Stocks of fire-cured tobacco of all types were reported as 158,035,000 pounds on October 1, 1938, compared with 160,643,000 pounds on October 1, 1937. Total fire-cured stocks were about 21 million pounds lower than on July 1, 1938. Virginia fire-cured, Type 21, stocks were reported as 25,012,000 pounds; Type 22 as 101,733,000 pounds; Type 23 as 30,296,000 pounds; and Type 24 as 994,000 pounds on October 1, 1938.

Burley stocks were reported as 565,361,000 pounds on October 1, 1938, or 76,402,000 pounds higher than a year ago. The decrease in Burley stocks during the third quarter amounted to 75,335,000 pounds. Maryland tobacco, Type 32 stocks were reported as 39,966,000 pounds on October 1.

One Sucker stocks on October 1, 1938, were 30,043,000 pounds compared with 21,198,000 pounds a year ago. Green River stocks reported as 20,714,000 pounds were slightly higher than a year ago. Stocks of other types on October 1, 1938, were as follows: Virginia sun-cured, 2,516,000 pounds; Eastern Ohio, 253,000 pounds; Perique, 359,000 pounds; Other Miscellaneous Domestic, 363,000 pounds; and Foreign-grown cigarette tobacco (Turkish and other), 70,223,000 pounds.

OCTOBER 1 CIGAR LEAF TOBACCO STOCKS

Stocks of American-grown cigar-filler types amounted to 185,173,000 pounds on October 1, 1938, compared with 187,184,000 pounds on October 1, 1937. Pennsylvania Seedleaf, Gebhardt, and Zimmer are slightly lower than a year ago, and Dutch, Georgia and Florida sun-grown, and Puerto Rican are higher than a year ago. Type 41, Pennsylvania Seedleaf stocks were reported as 92,775,000 pounds on October 1, 1938; Type 42, Gebhardt, 12,304,000 pounds; Type 43, Zimmer, 16,849,000 pounds; Type 44, Dutch, 12,651,000 pounds; Type 45, Georgia and Florida sun-grown, 2,748,000 pounds; and Type 46, Puerto Rican, 47,846,000 pounds. The detailed report by groups of grades shows that of the total filler type stocks reported 2,142,000 are of binder quality; 133,292,000 pounds are in the C group as strictly filler grade; 31,597,000 pounds in the X group as stemming grades, and 13,877,000 pounds in the Y group as ground leaves or farm fillers.

The cigar-binder stocks, some of which are used for wrappers, were only a few thousand pounds higher on October 1, 1938, than they were October a year ago. Total binder type stocks were reported as 126,232,000 pounds. Type 51, Connecticut Broadleaf stocks were reported as 32,105,000 pounds; Type 52, Connecticut Havana Seed, 23,753,000 pounds; Type 53, New York and Pennsylvania Havana Seed, 1,881,000 pounds; Type 54, Southern Wisconsin, 41,636,000 pounds; and Type 55, Northern Wisconsin, 26,857,000 pounds on October 1, 1938. The detailed report shows that of the total binder type stocks reported, 3,738,000 pounds were of wrapper quality; 53,844,000 pounds are binders; 2,097,000 pounds are fillers; 65,897,000 pounds are X group or stemming grade tobacco; and the remainder in the Y, S, and N groups.

Shade-grown wrapper type stocks were reported on October 1, 1938, as 10,881,000 pounds. Connecticut Shade stocks were reported as 5,630,000 pounds, and Georgia and Florida Shade stocks as 5,251,000 pounds. Of the total shade tobacco stocks reported, 9,539,000 pounds are shown in the A group as being of actual wrapper quality.

The foreign-grown cigar-leaf tobacco stocks in the United States on October 1, 1938, consisted of 6,736,000 pounds of Cuba (Havana) tobacco; 2,077,000 pounds of Sumatra and Java, and 1,646,000 pounds of Philippine Islands (Manila). The detailed report shows these stocks subdivided into wrappers, fillers, and scrap.

The figures quoted for type totals are the sums of unstemmed and stemmed leaf as reported. For information on American-grown types shown on a farm-sales-weight basis with stemmed leaf converted to unstemmed equivalent, see page 12 of this report.

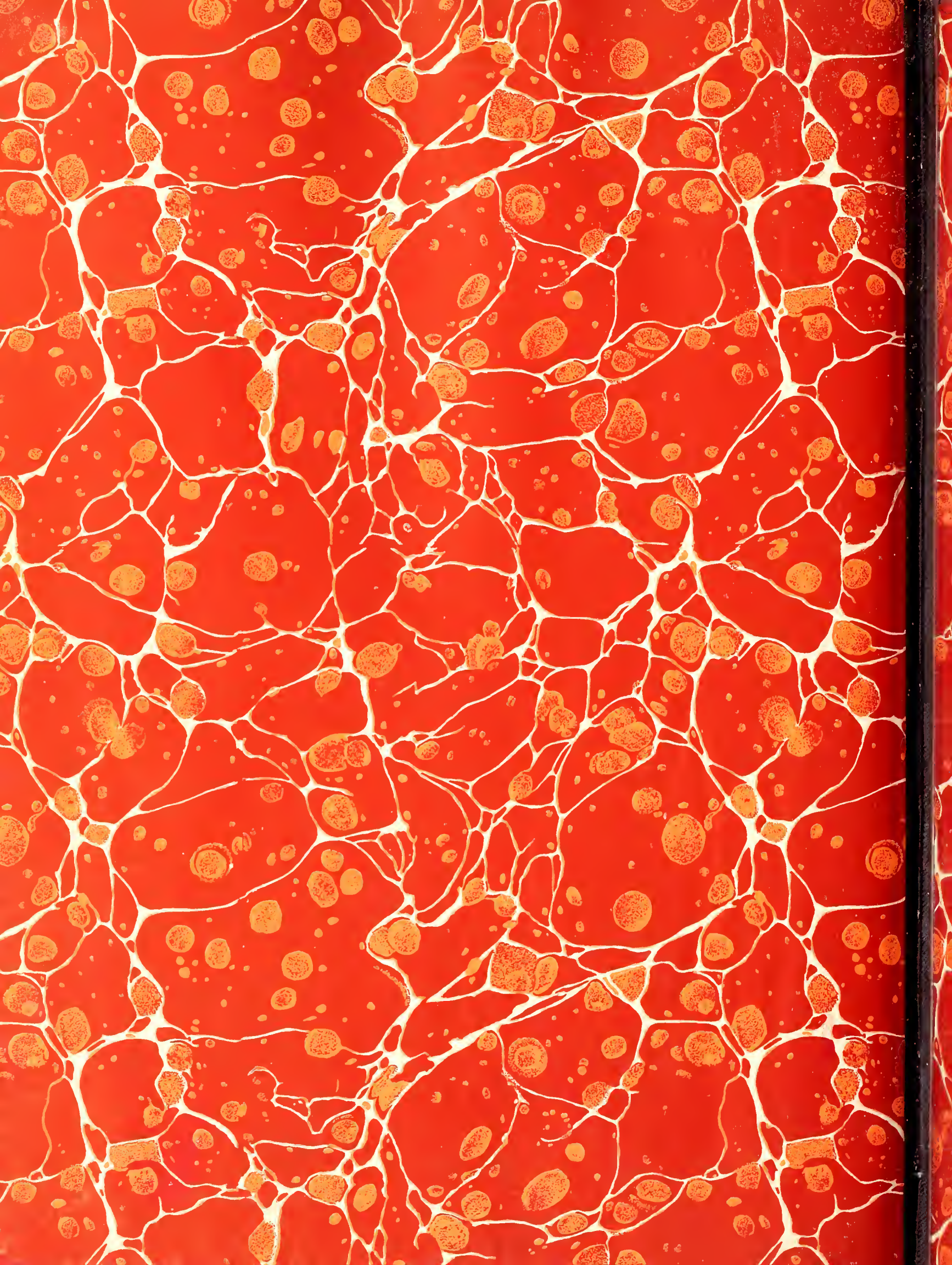
