Reference is made to letter Headquarters I Corps AG 14.1-BA, subject parades demonstrations and assemblies dated 4 April 1949. Until such time as local governments enact an ordinance regarding parades and mass public demonstrations, the procedure as outlined below will be followed in complying with paragraph 5 of referenced letter. In prefectures where tactical troops are stationed, the prefectural governors are required to notify the Military Government Team of parades and demonstrations at least 48 hours in advance of the parade or demonstration. The Military Government Team will notify the tactical commander. If the tactical commander believes the parade or demonstration will interfere with the occupation mission by interrupting necessary traffic and communication systems, said belief will be communicated to the Military Government Team who in turn will notify the governor in order that schedules, routes of march etc may be changed to eliminate objectionable features. If no agreement can be reached between the Japanese authorities and the persons sponsoring the parade or demonstration as to date, schedule, route or march or other features objectionable to the Occupation Forces, this Headquarters will be notified in detail so a decision may be obtained from higher headquarters. If no tactical troops are stationed in the prefecture the prefecture governor will notify the Military Government Team who in turn will advise this headquarters of impending events or happenings in progress which he believes may develop into a civil disturbance and events which are illegally planned or are illegally in progress. Where a local government has enacted an ordinance on parades and mass public demonstrations the responsibility for complying with paragraph 5 of the Corps letter devolves upon the public safety commission. End
