Change in State Department Membership of Security Advisory Board.

As you are probably aware, I am officially designated as Chairman, Security Board. However, my other duties have not permitted me to exercise this function at any time.

Mr. Einar T. Anderson has efficiently handled these duties as my designee as Acting Chairman ever since this function was placed within the Department. The attached recommendation was made by me several months ago but for reasons which I have mentioned orally to you was not approved by A-R/P.

I feel that to clear the record the recommended change of designation attached should be immediately approved by you. My recommendation in this regard is stronger than the mere placing of my initials thereon would indicate and, consequently, I felt you should have the benefit of the above background.

In conclusion, I might add that within the limits of authority permitted him, Mr. Anderson has done a very good job and I feel he can adequately execute this function without detailed supervision.

There is returned to you herewith a copy of a memorandum directed to The SWNCC Secretariat, dated May 14, 1946, a copy of a note to Mr. Lyon, dated May 14, 1946 and a copy of a memorandum to the SWNCC Secretariat, dated August 6, 1946, all dealing with the suggestion that you be named as Chairman and Robert L. Bannerman as Alternate of the SWNCC Subcommittee, known as the Security Advisory Board.

You will recall that the memorandum dated August 6, 1946 was sent through Mr. Lyon's office and on to Mr. Panuch's office on August 9, 1946. On November 8, 1946 while discussing other matters with Mr. Panuch, I produced a copy of the memorandum dated August 6, 1946, stating that I understood that the original was still being held in his office. Further, I suggested that a statement of policy as to whether this proposed change was acceptable to A-R or not would be appreciated. Mr. Panuch advised that he preferred that Mr. Lyon remain as Chairman of the Security Advisory Board with you as the Acting Chairman for the time being.

In view of this explanation of policy by A-R, I think we should consider this matter a dead issue until further notice.
