

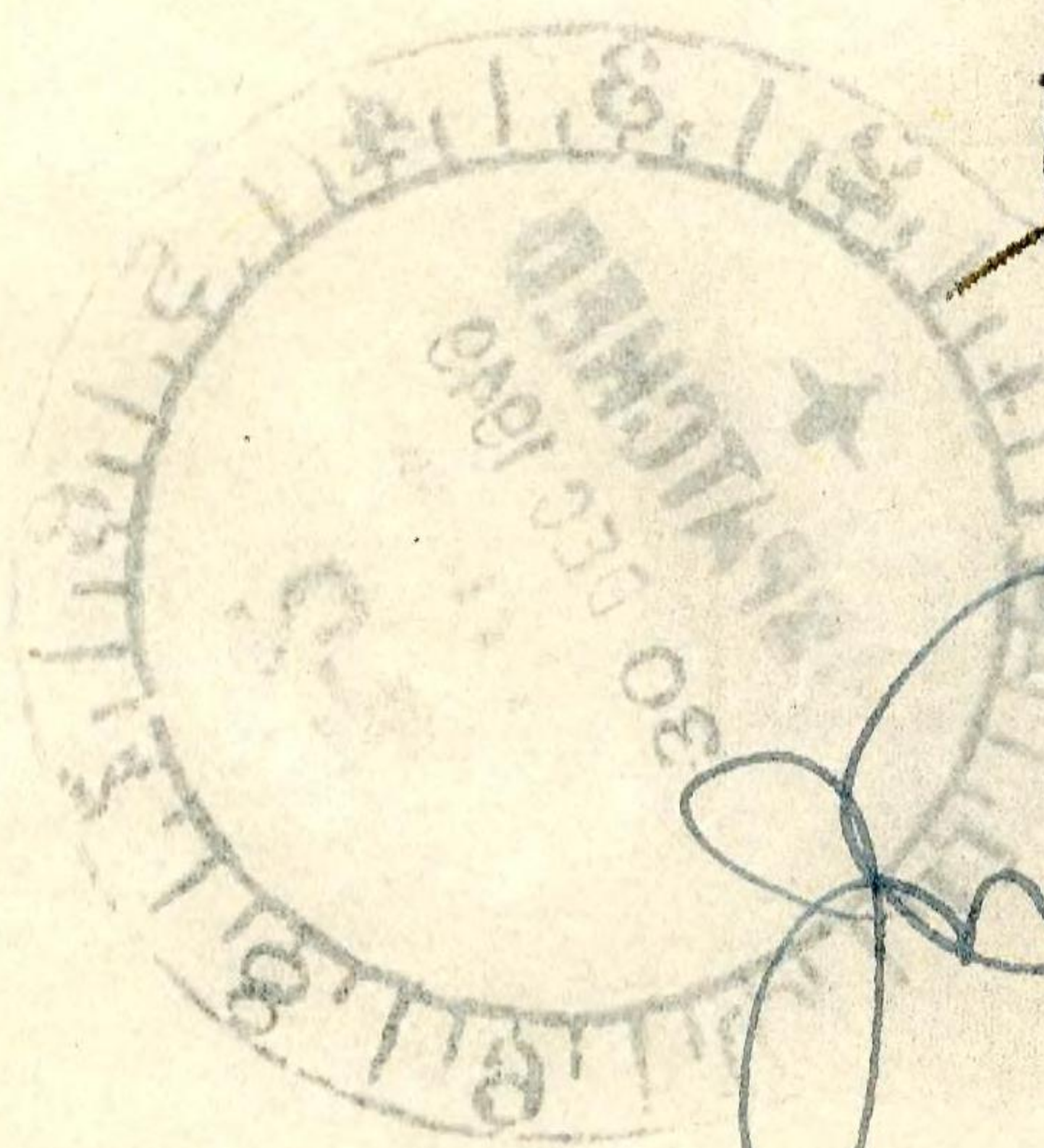

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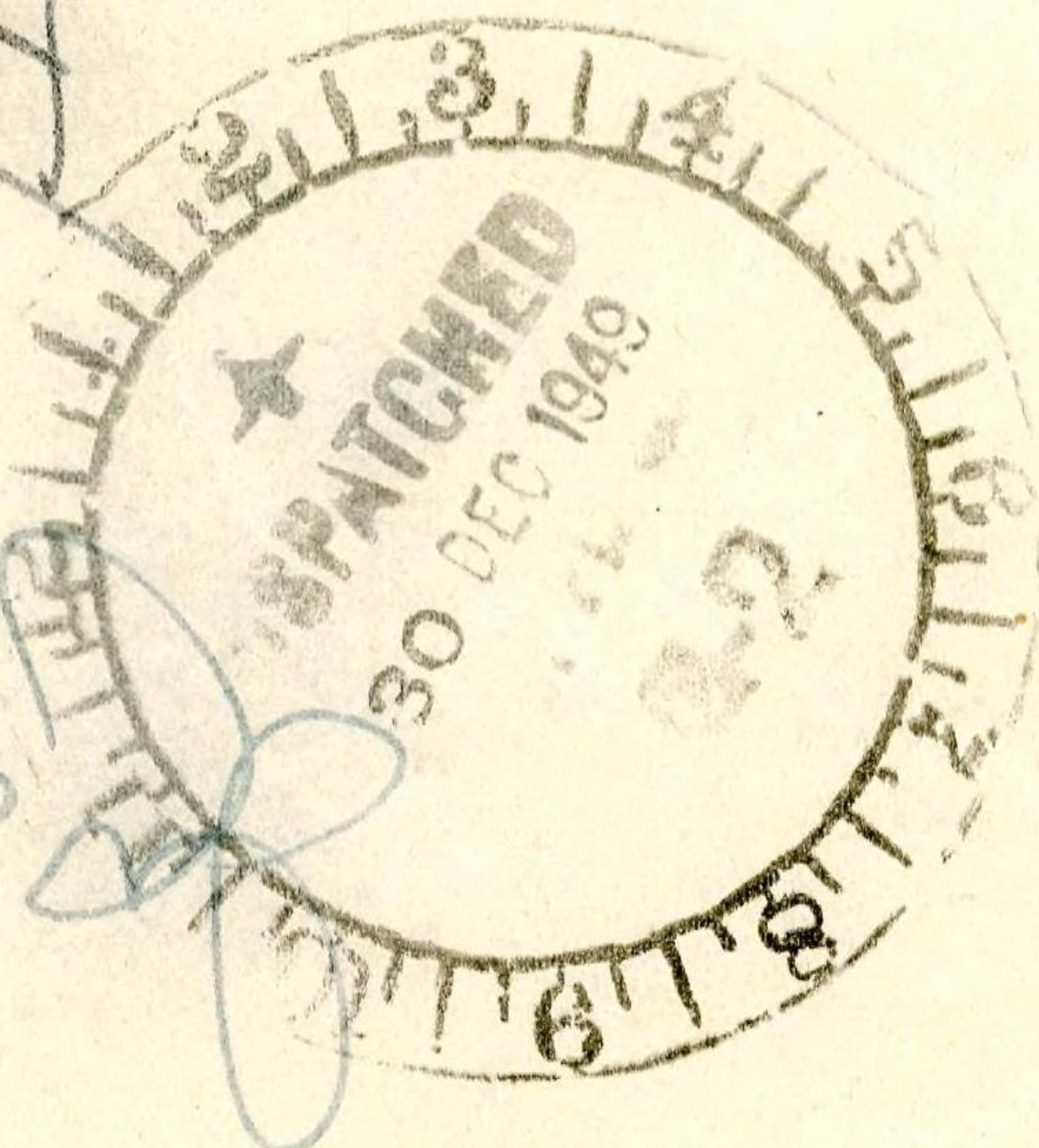

MEMO FOR RECORD:

Letter from Mr. Mayer to Gen Willoughby (2 Dec 49) enclosed account of successful tie-in arranged around showing of "Iron Curtain" in Sapporo. Mayer states that similar arrangements have worked out well in other cities, but that he is getting no cooperation in Tokyo. In interview with Lt Col Lockett, Mayer explained this statement by alleging that movie critics of Asahi, Yomiuri and Mainichi were communist sympathisers.

1. Records of the Civil Censorship Detachment show that these films were confiscated -- four on 10 June 1949 and two on 19 July 1949 -- for dissemination without submission for censorship and for showing uncensored films with a false identification number. On both occasions the responsible parties were severely admonished by the Matsuyama CCD Office.

2. Under censorship authorities the films will not be returned.
