Operating with torpedo bombers of VC-93, the three divisions of VC-87 fighters bombed and strafed various targets in the small harbor of TOJUKI, MOTOBU Peninsula, on the west coast of OKINAWA ISLAND. The area, which was reported to be an operating base for motor torpedo and amphibious craft, included concrete piers which were bombed with minor damage. One large building and twelve small buildings were destroyed, and a nearby barracks was damaged. A sixty-foot craft, identified as possibly a motor torpedo boat which was beached, was destroyed by bombing.
