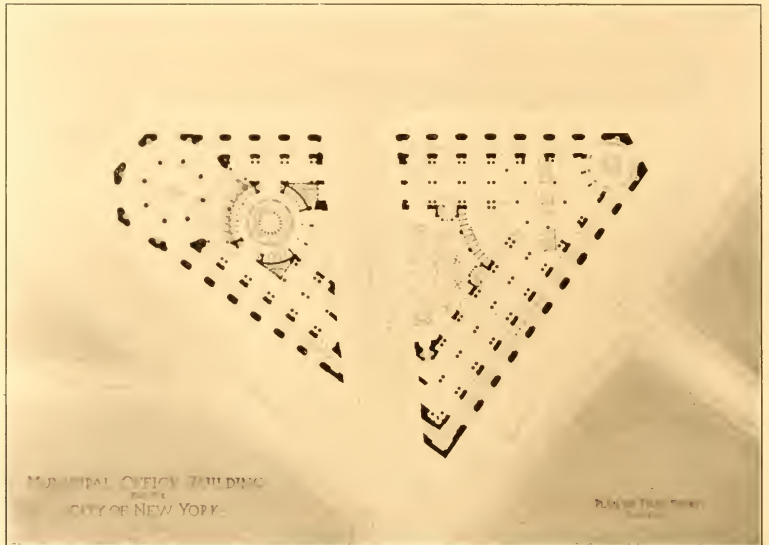
GROUND FLOOR PLAN AND TYPICAL FLOOR PLAN.

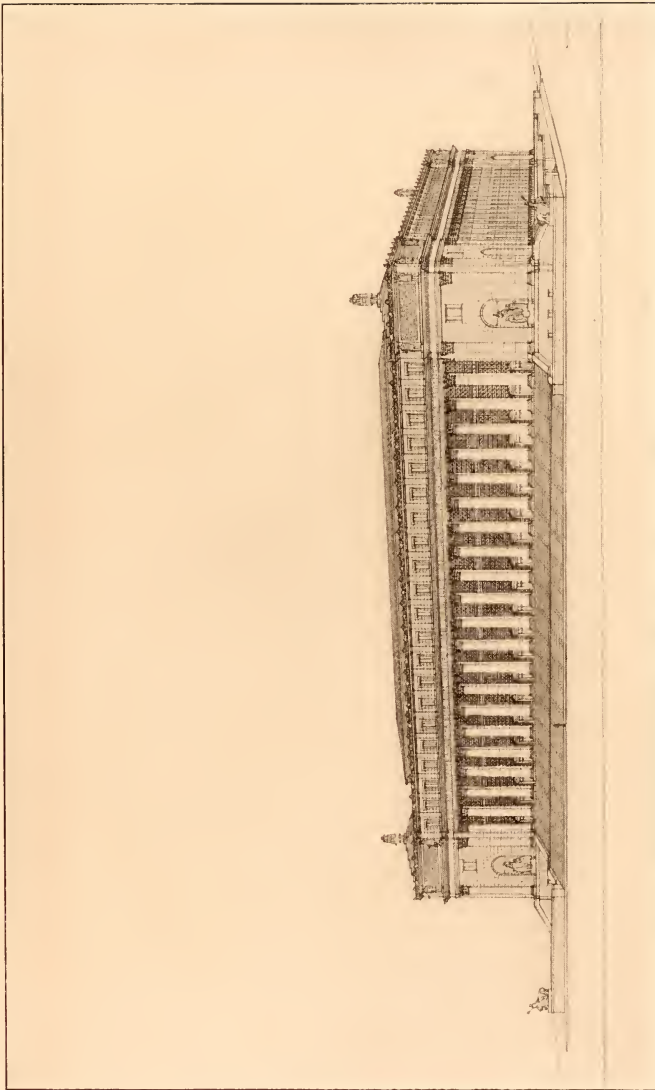
