




Interior of Reception Hall, Residence of Percy R. Albright.










Residence Design in Stone and Half Timber.








Residence of William B. Grimes, Raleigh, N. C.






Residence of Will Robbins, Raleigh, N. C.






Second Floor Plan.




Winter Residence of E. M. Fulton, of New York, at Southern Pines, N. C.




Residence of Judge A. W. Graham, Oxford, N. C.


Floor Plans, Cottage Erected for R. B. Raney.






Second Floor Plan.






Episcopal Church at Louisburg, N. C.









First Floor Plan for Frame School Building.




