1. Personal history statement re JOUARD, Edward Parel, DAC, is returned for correction. Item 8 must be answered. Items 19, 20, 21 and 22 must be answered "No" or "None." Under item 33 complete addresses to include street and number must be used. Account for all military service. If quartered on a military reservation list unit and station to which assigned. If quartered off a military reservation give complete address to include street and number. Item 34b must be answered. Under item 34c list social security number or if unknown or none so state. Also give a chronological review of employment. Make list continuous, showing all the periods of unemployment, non-employment while attending schools, vacations, and military service in their order. Give complete names and addresses of employers. Be sure the dates and places under employment correspond to the dates and places under residence from birth (item 33). Items 35, 36 and 37 b must be answered. Under item 40 and item 41 list three credit references and five character references, all located in the Zone of Interior or Hawaii. Both the credit and character references are to be non-military in addition to not being employers or relatives. No credit references may be used as a character reference and vice versa. Complete addresses to include street and number are needed in both cases. For credit references, if there is no credit account, use a school to which tuition has been paid, any store, gasoline station, motor car dealer, auto repair shop, hotel, life insurance company, landlord, doctor, lawyer, dentist, clubs or organizations where dues are paid, or any other business establishment where individual has paid cash for services or goods, and where there is a record of the transactions. If all these possibilities fail, give the name of a person who has loaned or would lend money should the need arise. Under item 53 list all dependents.

2. It is also requested that a fingerprint card for subject employee be submitted in accordance with the attached suggestions.
