This Breeding Block has been visited by more than 1000 persons during the fall and winter. The gentleman in the dark suit beside Mr. Ferguson is Mr. E. N. Boykin, who came to see the Breeding-Block of this cotton originated by Ferguson Seed Farms, and named to honor his father, Mr. W. L. Boykin, a pioneer seedsman.


