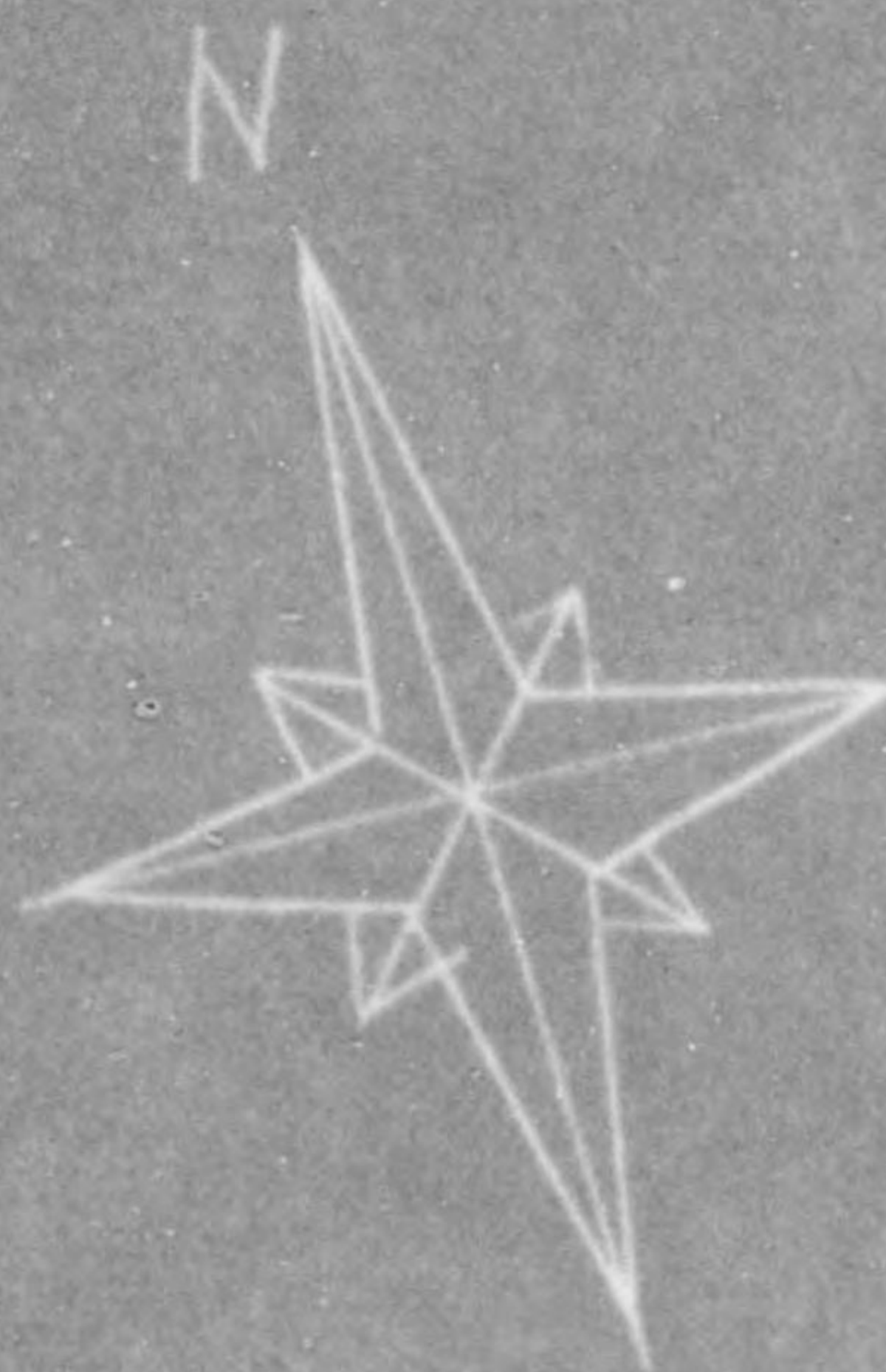

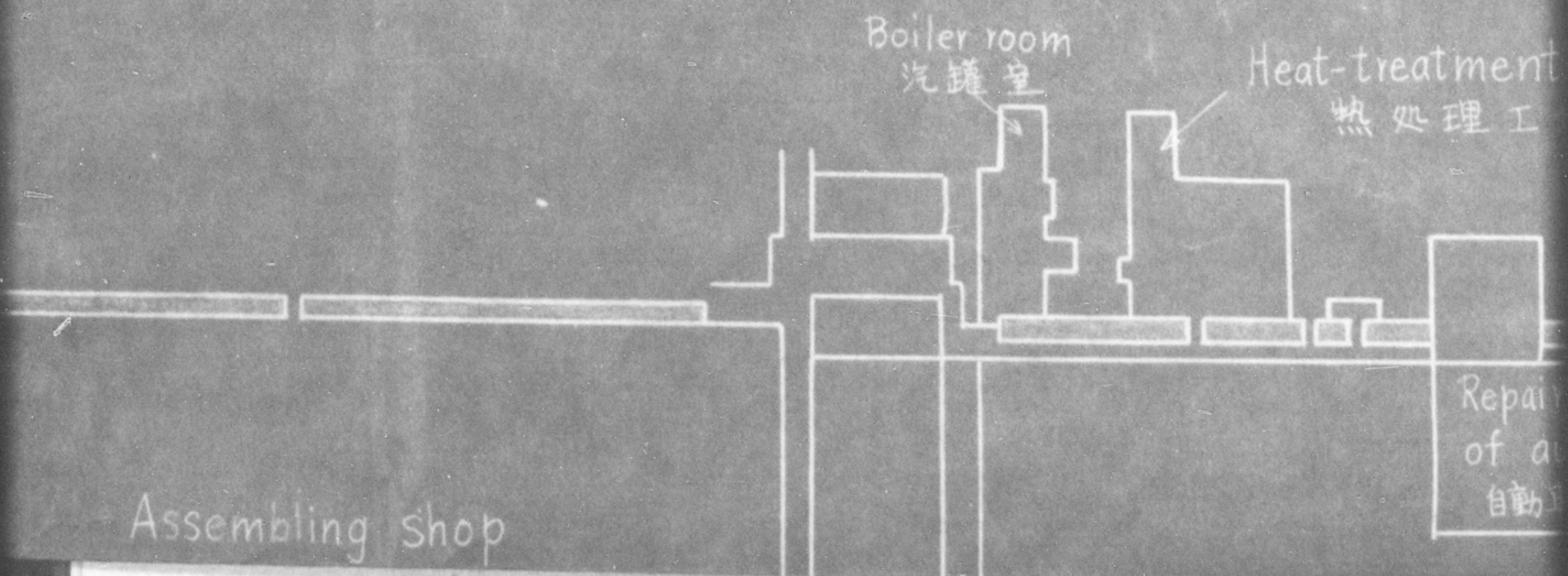
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ARRANGMENT DIAGRAM OF MACHINERY

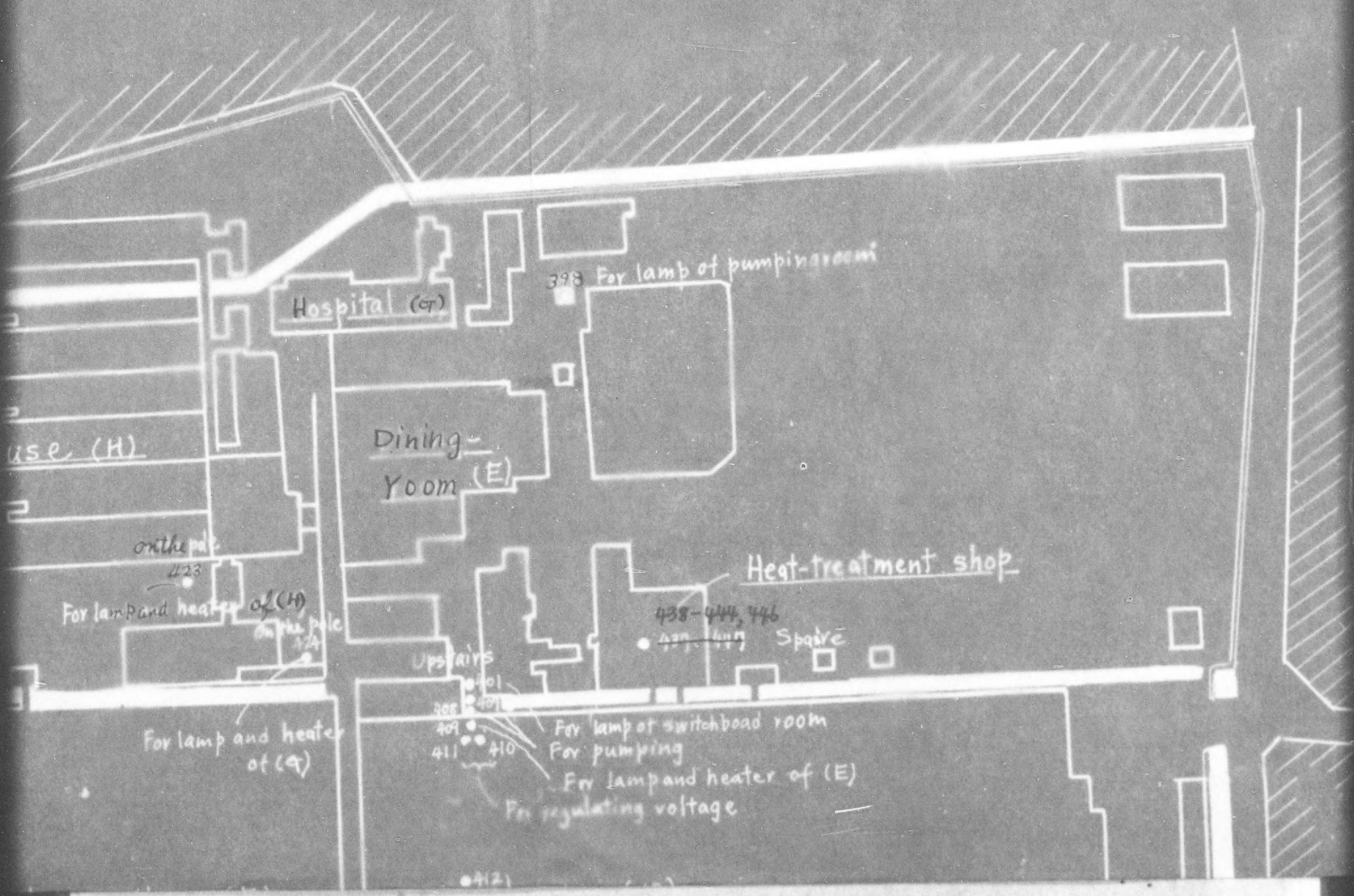
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# ARRANGEMENT DIAGRAM OF TRA



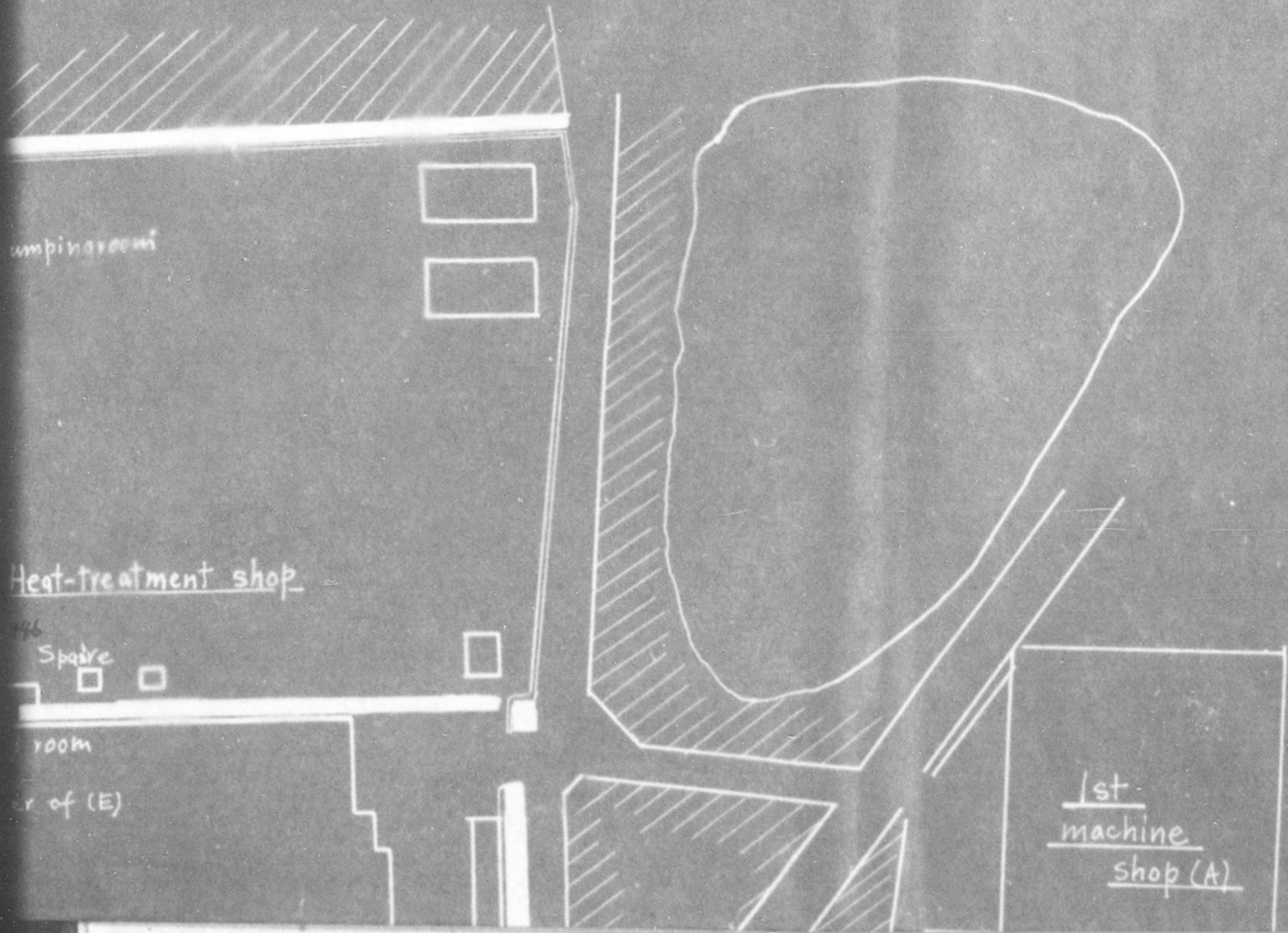
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DIAGRAM OF TRANSFORMERS 变压器配置图

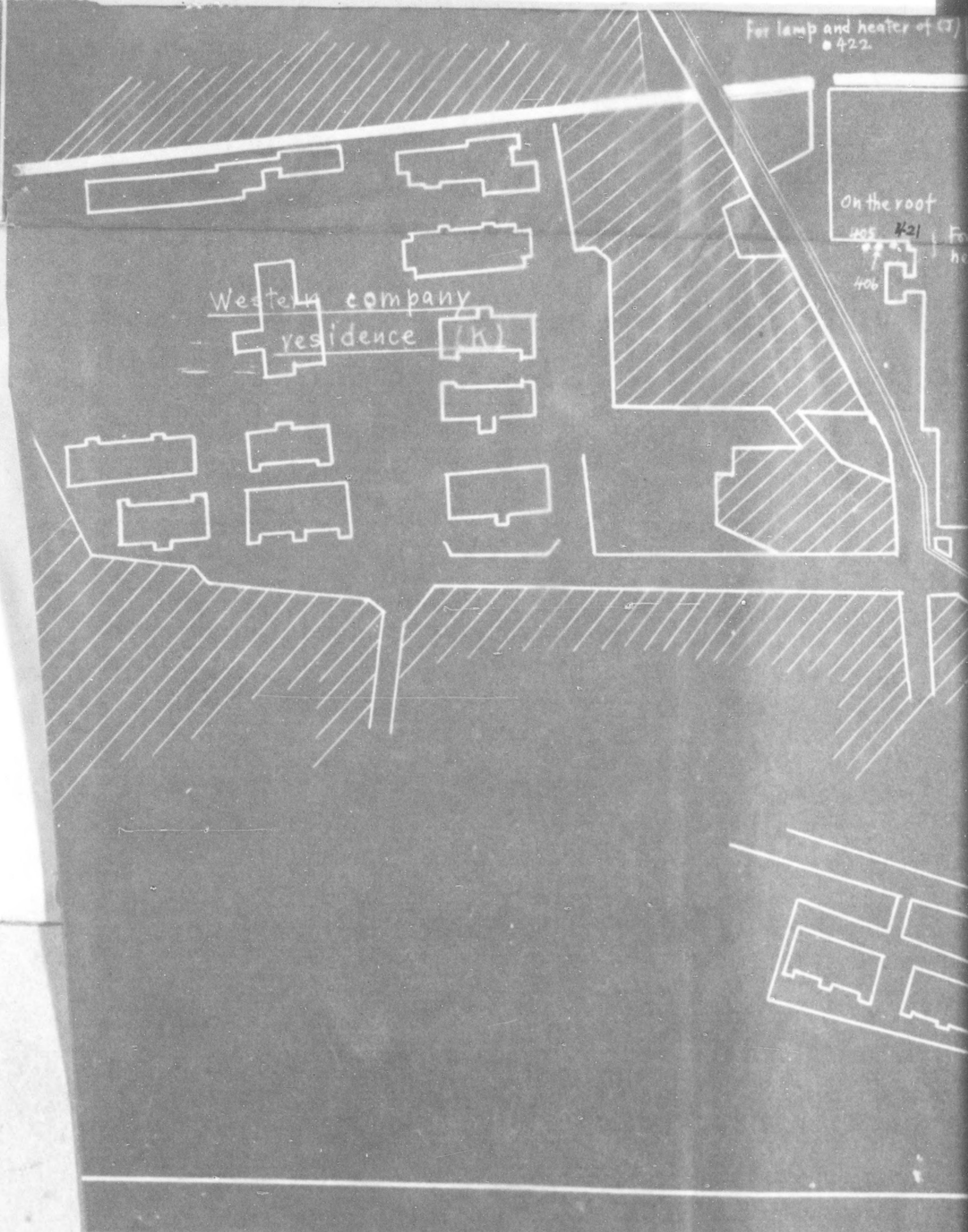


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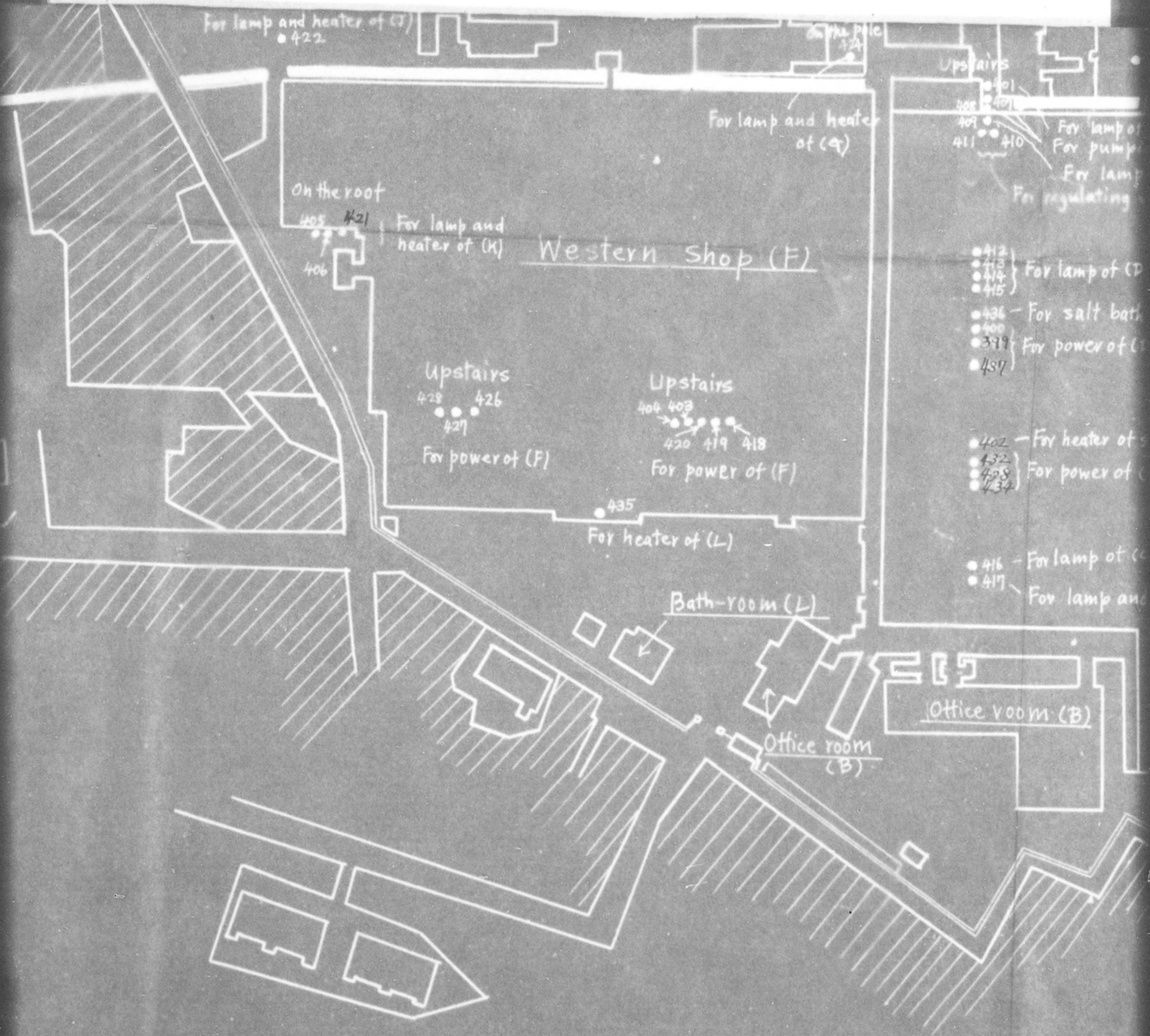



1. The Fukuno Plant of the Kureha Kogyo K.K. was taken under reparational custody and control in compliance with SCAPIN 987 dated 28 May 46, and the machinery therein inventoried under the assigned code number 42-2.
2. Although this plant was formerly a spinning mill, it underwent a complete reorganization during February 1944 and was equipped and converted for the exclusive production of sheet metal parts especially designed for incorporation in finished aircraft.
3. At the present time the Fukuno Plant is primarily engaged in repairing spinning machines and manufacturing parts thereof.
4. A previous exclusion application for the removal of the 149 machines mentioned in paragraph I (1) of the present application (see inclosure) was recently denied by higher headquarters for the reasons mentioned above in paragraph two (2).
5. This office, therefore, recommends that the machines listed in Annexes 3, 4, and 6 of inclosure should not be considered favorably for removal from reparations since it is believed that these machines were retained at the plant during the time it converted to the production of airplane parts in order to facilitate and aid in the manufacture of the said parts.
6. Since no mention is made of wood-working machinery in GD 5/4 as reparational items, this office suggests removal from reparations of the 10 wood-working machines listed in Annex 2 of inclosure.
7. A close check of the machinery listed in Annex 5 of inclosure revealed that all items with the exception of the hydraulic presses were brought to the Fukuno Plant in 1942 for storage purposes from the Fushiki Plant of the Showa Rayon Co, which was then in the process of liquidation. The machines were never used and are not in use now, with the exception of the air compressors. The hydraulic presses, which are

## I. Brief Outline of the Equipments:

- (1) 149 sets of machine (including 39 transformers): Since the period before the forced conversion from civil production, using these machines, this plant is working on collective operation of repair works of spinning & weaving machines in the 1st Machine Shop, the distinguished independent establishment. About these 149 sets of machines, inasmuch as was presented other petition for release, these are not included in the present petition.
- (2) 10 sets of Wood Work Machines: Using these machines which are in the Wood Work Shop, this Plant is working on wooden parts of agricultural equipments.
- (3) 15 sets of machine of repair use, which are equipped in the Repair and Preservations Shop: Using these machines, is working on materials needful for the preservation of the factory's structures.
- (4) 42 units of transformer ( 3 units of them are for emergency use) which are equipments of the factory's structures: Using them, supplying electric power for lighting, heating & transmitting.
- (5) 32 sets of machines which are purely for civil production and were never used until the present time, the use of which by other cotton-mills is urgent after repaired.
- (6) 16 sets of machines which are of repair use: This plant has repaired them and are using for repairing of spinning & weaving machines to meet increase orders of repairing the war-suffered, after the surrender.

## J. Name of Machine and the reason of petition for Release:

This plant was listed as a controlled plant owing to the act of this plant has wrought on sheet-metal for parts of trial wooden aeroplane, the cost of its work on trial is \$1,040,000.00, for ten months only since Oct., 1944 until Aug., 1945.

Since the commencement of spinning operation in Oct., 1921, the plant has been engaging in manufacture of cotton yarn & cloth. And, when this plant was ordered forcedly by Military to work on sheet-metal for parts of trial wooden aircraft as a sub-factory of Tachikawa Aircraft Co., this has been operating the repair & regulations works of spinning & weaving machines damaged in the cotton-mills of Kureha Industry Co., Ltd., using the 149 sets of machines centralized from those mills for the purpose of collective operation, because of the excellency of the facilities of the Repair & Preservations Section and of the big repairing capacity of this plant. But during its operation until the War ended, the plant conducted continually repair works to finish off. As above mentioned, this plant is a cotton-mill and is organized with the dependent repair and preservations shop and the wood work shop.

On account of that, when the machines were designated for reparations, we have received order which was construed as that all of the machines which were in the whole plant at the surrender time should be reparations objects, we have registered all of the machines including the civil production's machines. While, we have learned that were wrong our understanding and disposal against reparations objects, with the inspectors who belong to Headquarters, the Eighth Army and to General Headquarters, SCAP and have recently visited the Kureha Plant of our company for the purpose of inspection for reservation and trimming status of reparations machines in Toyama Pref.

Describing the reasons as follows in accordance with the definitions for reparations which we learned with the suggestion and indication of the inspectors, we petition you exempt them partially from reparations list.

- (1) Name of Machines: Wood Work Machines which are in Wood Work Shop. 10 sets (the details, on Annex No.2)  
Location: In the Wood Work Shop shown on the plan, annex No.7.  
Reason : These are found since the age of cotton spinning works for the use of sawing lumber of packing cases for cotton & cloth. And these have had never hand in the manufacture of aircraft parts.
- (2) Name of Machines: Machines equipped in the Repair & Preservations Shop dependent to Cotton-Mill. 15 sets (The details, on annex No.3.)  
Location: In the Repair & Preservations Shop shown on the plan, annex No.7.  
Reason : The Repair & Preservations Shop is inevitably dependent to a cotton-mill, and is used for repair works of installed spinning & weaving machines and for working on materials necessary for preservation of factory's structures. They are found before the conversion to the manufacture of aircraft parts, and have had never hand in its operation.

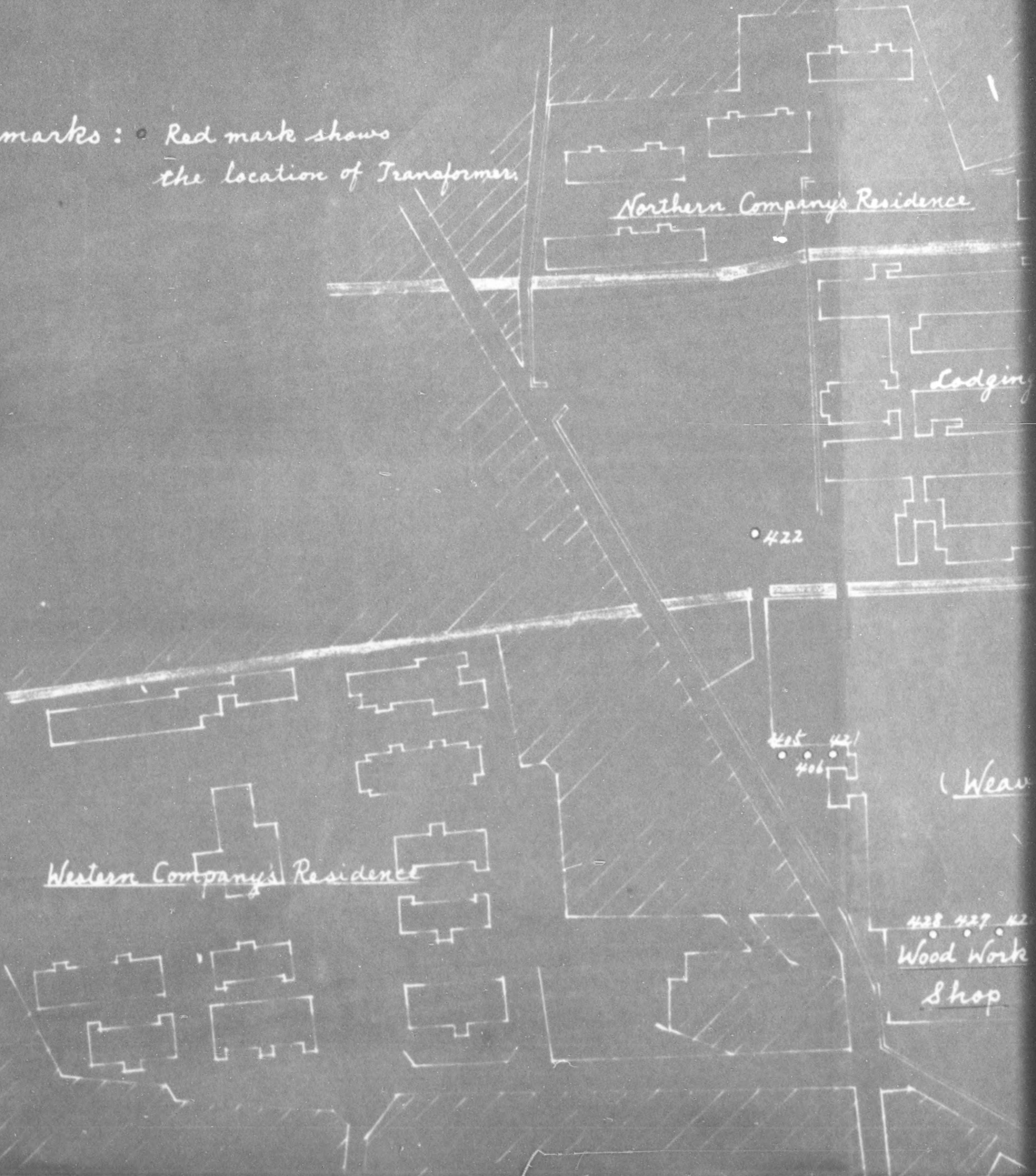

1. The Fukuno Plant of the Kureha Industrial Co. has been placed under reparational custody and control as a former aircraft factory, and has subsequently been given the code number 42-2.
2. At the present time 261 reparations machines are located in what is called the "First Machine Shop" (see area containing red oblique lines in plant layout plan to inclosure), which is outside of main plant area, and is actually separated from the main part by a road.
3. If these machines could be assembled within the main plant area, especially the "Eastern Shop", shown with blue perpendicular lines in the above plant layout plan, much better protection, maintenance and care could be given to the machines.

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

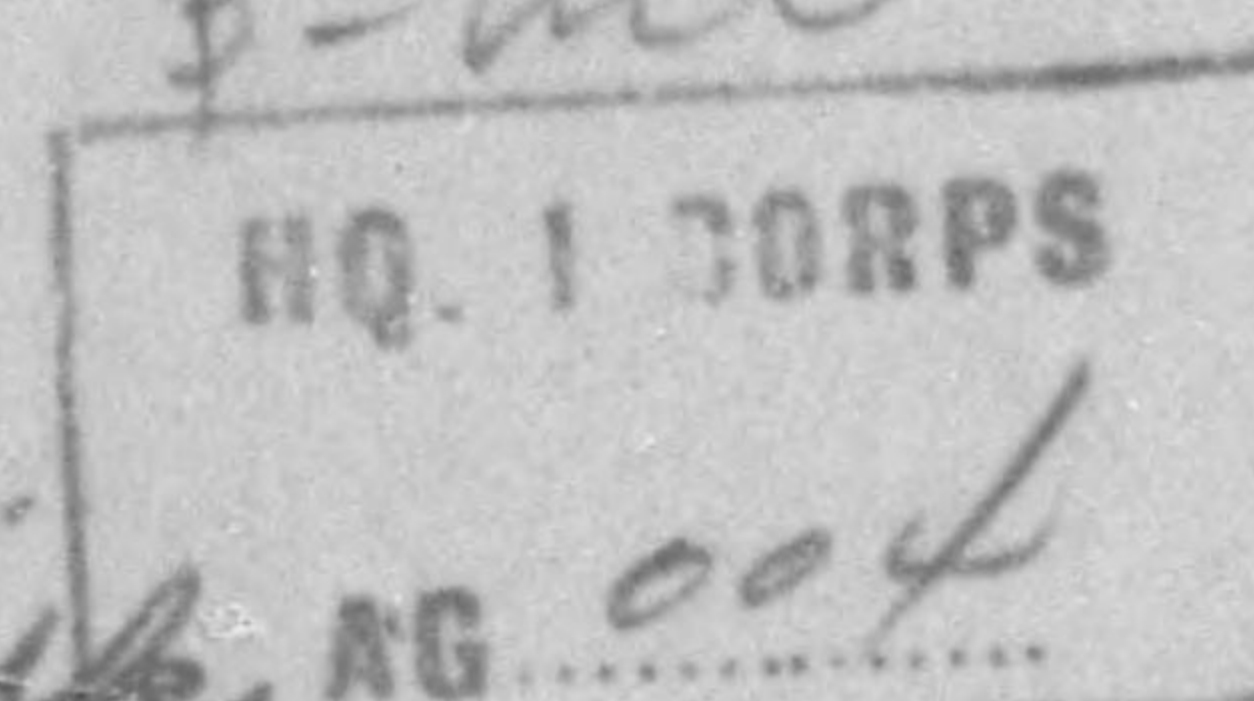
