SUBJECT: Educational Expenses

TO: Osaka Educational Authorities

1. Much criticism has been made of P.T.A. contributions. Before I can form an opinion on this question I need to know the actual cost of educating a student in a public school.

2. I need to know the answer to these questions:

- a. How much does it cost to educate an elementary school child for one year? Or, if more convenient, for one month.
- b. How much money is raised per elementary school student per year (or month) from prefecture taxes?
- c. How much money is raised per elementary school student per year (or month) from municipal taxes?
- d. How much must be contributed by P.T.A.s to meet the basic educational expenses (teachers' salary, building costs, school administration) of an elementary school child for one year (or one month)?
