Instructions

FOR PLANTING DAHLIA SEEDS

Dahlia seeds should be planted in flats, which have been filled with four inches of good garden soil, mixed with sifted leaf mould. The seeds should be planted about one inch apart and not deeper than half an inch. Then place the seeds in a warm, moist place indoors and see that the soil is not permitted to become dry. Do not place outside unless you are in a frostless belt.

When the seeds are up about one inch high transplant them into three inch pots or they can be left until they are large enough to transplant into the garden.

The interesting part of growing from seeds, is always the possibility of creating a new wonder in the Dahlia world. The inventor's creations are marvelous but nature's creations exceed all. One little seed which you may plant could bring forth a Dahlia of international fame.
