SUBJECT: Apprehension of Suspected War Criminal

Memorandum to the Imperial Japanese Government, dated 8 November 1946, file AG 000.5 (8 Nov 46) LS-R, wherein the Imperial Japanese Government is directed to deliver one WATANABE, (FNU) Major, to the Commanding General, LIGHTH Army at Sugamo Prison (Tokyo Detention Camp), at the earliest possible date, is amended to delete said WATANABE's name for the reason that he is presently incarcerated in RANGOON, Burma. This name appears as the third name on Page No. 5 of the above mentioned Memorandum.
