

Nevertheless interrogations were made of families in the areas close to this fictitious address. No one who would admit giving contributions to any Shin to organization or representative could be found.
- 2. The Chief of the Shrine and Temple section of the Kyoto Prefectural Government was called into this office. He stated that he was familiar with the directives on Shinto contributions, and that they had stopped asking for these contributions.
 - 3. This office recommends this case be closed.
