Authorizing a certain disposition of public school land situated in the parishes of Carroll and Natchitoches. Sec. 1st. Be it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the State of Louisiana...

Sec. 2d. Be it further enacted, etc. That John Milliken, J.P. Morony and Alfred Lowry be, and they are hereby appointed commissioners, the duty of whom or any two of them shall be to hold the said election on the third Monday of May...

Sec. 3d. Be it further enacted, etc. That it shall be the duty of the said trustees, or a majority of them and their successors in office, to hold an election of trustees of their term, to hold an election of successors in office, after having given notice of such election in the manner prescribed in the second section of this act...

Sec. 4th. Be it further enacted, etc. That public trustees and they are hereby authorized to lease to any person or persons, for a term not exceeding one year, any school building or school house...

Sec. 5th. Be it further enacted, etc. That the said trustees of the parishes of Carroll and Natchitoches, be and they are hereby authorized to issue bonds for the purpose of raising money to defray the expenses of the said school buildings...

Sec. 6th. Be it further enacted, etc. That it shall be the duty of the said trustees to report annually, at least once a week before the meeting of the Legislature, to the Secretary of State a detailed account of the condition of the school buildings...
