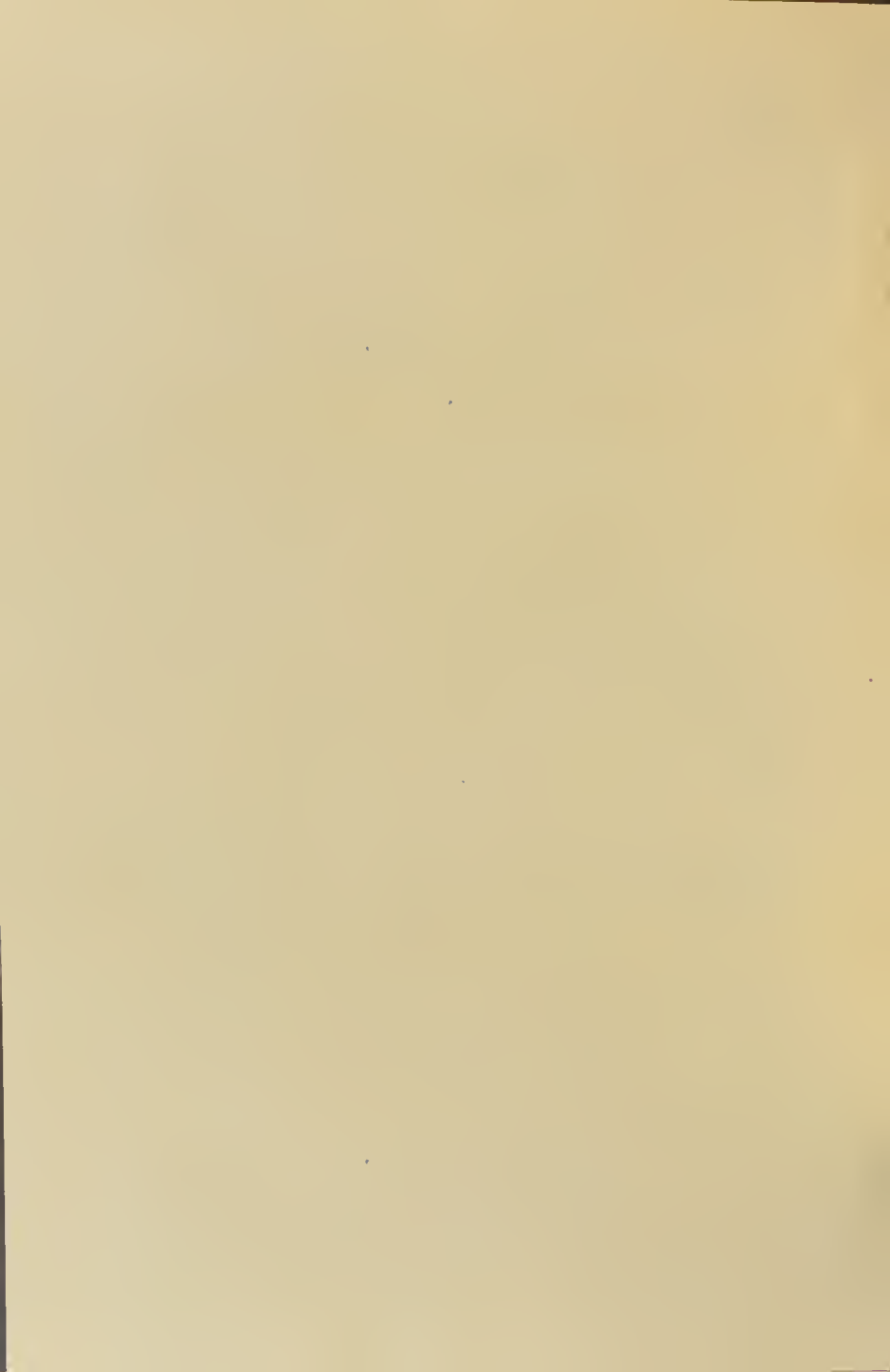
This Society having disposed of all the Prince Henry medals it has for sale, and the issue being strictly limited to three hundred impressions, it will be impossible to fill any more orders.


Gentlemen:-

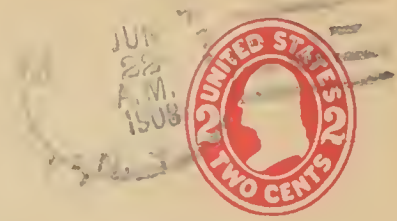
