To Foreign Minister Arita Hachirō

Concerning the sending of copies of the map annexed to the agreement for demarkation of the border in the disputed area:

I have sent to you by confidential official message No. 217 under date of 20 July, the full text of the agreement concluded on 9 June concerning the demarkation of the border in the disputed area, and a map annexed to it. The People's Commissariat for Foreign Affairs has sent to me two copies of the map in question, which I forward to you herewith. I ask you to transmit one of the copies to the Government of Manchoukuo.

The border on the enclosed maps extends on the east to a point somewhat north of Hill 1075, but it is agreed, as I have reported to you by wire, that the demarkation of the border should be carried out at this time as far as Hill 1075. This is for your information.
