MEMORANDUM FOR: THE JAPANESE GOVERNMENT

SUBJECT: Patent Applications

1. Rescissions:
 - a. AG 072(22 Sep 45)ESS/ST, SCAPIN 2010, 27 May 1949, subject: Patent Applications.
 - b. Paragraphs 2 and 3 of AG 072(22 Sep 45)ESS/ST, SCAPIN 2010/1, 11 July 1949, subject: Patent Rights and Restrictions Concerning Patent Rights.
2. There is no objection to the filing of applications of Japanese Nationals for foreign patent, design and trade mark registrations in those countries, the domestic laws of which allow Japanese Nationals to obtain and hold industrial property rights therein.
3. Foreign exchange funds required for the acquisition of such registrations shall be obtained in accordance with provisions of the Foreign Exchange and Foreign Trade Control Law and appropriate Orders and Ordinances thereunder.
4. Any payments, in whatever form, accruing to an exchange resident by virtue of sale, license or other transaction concerning the rights acquired or to be acquired shall be subject to the provisions of the Foreign Exchange and Foreign Trade Control Law and appropriate Orders and Ordinances thereunder.
