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

4. The Deputy Prime Minister and Finance Minister have endorsed the proposal.



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Our main file relating to visit of Justice Mukherjee Commission of Inquiry to Tokyo w.e.f. 12.9.02 is under submission for obtaining approval of HS/DPM/FM.

In the meantime we have received two communications from Ministry of External Affairs i.e.

> a) A revised programme of Commission in Japan involving air journey from <u>Tokyo to Miyazaki and vice -versa by Japan</u> Domestic Flight No. ANA-613 and SNA-118 on 16 and 17 September, 2002. The reason is that Mr. Yoshimi Taneyoshi, the lone witness willing to depose before the Commission has conveyed his inability to travel to Tokyo on account of his frail physical condition and desired to depose before the Commission in Miyazaki his hometown in Japan. Thus the air fare would be incurred for the team in respect of Japan Domestic Flight No. ANA-613 and SNA-118 will be in addition of the two air journeys by Air India from India to Tokyo and back as proposed in our main file.

> (b) High Commission of India in Japan has also sought financial sanction on accommodation in hotel and transport on actual basis hiring an interpreter @ Yen 70,000 per day and for other miscellaneous expenses on actuals including video recording and photography at the deposition of the witness in the Embassy premises and the interaction at Renkoji temple as requested by the Commission.

As the sufficient fund is available in the Budget Grant of the Commission, for the year 2002-2003, the entire expenditure incurred on accommodation and other miscellanous arrangement to be made available by the High Commission of India in Japan including air fare for Japan Domestic Flight No. ANA-613 and SNA-118 on 16 and 17 September for the team will be met from sanctioned Budget Grant of the Justice Mukherjee Commission of Inquiry on actual basis.

6. (i) Domestic air journey in Japan

The Commission will have to travel from Tokyo to Miyazaki and vice-versa on September 16-17,2002 to have deposition of Mr.Yoshimi Taneyoshi at his hometown namely Miyazaki. MEA has informed that due to frail physical condition, the witness can not come to Tokyo. We may have no objection.

(ii) Hotel Accommodation/ Transport:-

It has been stated that the High Commission of India has sought financial sanction for accommodation in hotel and transport on actual basis. We may have no objection if the High Commission hires accommodation and transport as per the entitlement of the Chairman, Mukherjee Commission of Inquiry and Secretary to the Commission.

(iii) Expenditure on Interpreter/ Video recording and photography

We may have no objection to the hiring of interpreter @ Yen 70,000 and actual expenditure to be incurred on video recording and photography by the High Commission of India relating to inquiry by the Commission.
