INTRODUCTORY.

THE LAST YEAR has been a disastrous one for seed-growers in both this country and Europe. The almost unprecedented cold of last winter killed the biennial root crops throughout Europe, and in consequence, Turnip, Ruta-baga, Beet and some varieties of Cabbage seed are higher in price than a year ago, and prices have an upward tendency. The long continued drought, the cool summer, and the wet harvest time in the principal seed-growing sections of the United States, have materially reduced the usual supply of all kinds of vine seeds, such as Melon, Cucumber and Squash, as well as Peas and Beans; farmers in many cases estimate their crops as but half an ordinary yield.

Though the crop of many of the leading kinds of vegetable seeds may be short this year, we can speak well of the quality of the stock which we offer for sale in this brief list. Our American seeds have been grown for us by men who are the acknowledged leaders in this branch of farming in the country, and our imported seeds have been procured from the most reliable sources abroad. We have taken every pains to have the original stock pure and true; the crops have been personally inspected while growing by our representative; and every care has been taken that the seed be properly ripened, carefully dried and cleaned, and all inferior and imperfect specimens rejected.

We would advise dealers to place their orders early, as prices are likely to advance at the beginning of the selling season.

Terms of Sale :

Prices are subject to change without notice, and to the goods being unsold on receipt of order.

Accounts are payable January first and July first of each year.

Prices are quoted F. O. B. New York City.

No charge is made for packing; bags only are charged for at cost.

Orders for $\frac{1}{4}$ bushel are filled at bushel-rate, $\frac{1}{4}$ pound at pound rate, 10 pounds at 100 pound rate, and 250 pounds at 1,000 pound rate
