#### TWO YEARS TO-DAY

New York, May 12.—Just two years ago to-day four-year-old Jimmie Glass mysteriously disappeared from the mountain town of Greeley, Pa. Since then his father, Charles Glass, of Jersey City, an Erie railroad auditor, his mother and relatives have followed faded clues in all parts of the country.

They have looked over several hundred boys with light hair and about the right age, whose antecedents are uncertain, proving the large number of children either lost or put away, but none of them has been the long-sought Jimmie. These pursuits have taken them as far away as Georgia and Oklahoma.

Still the parents have not given up hope. Jimmie was last seen walking along a country road, and he could not have gone far on his own feet. The country about Greeley was thoroughly searched. Therefore, the parents are certain that someone—gypsy or a passing motorist, perhaps—was attracted by his pretty face and carried him away.
