Allegations on DRE Penetration by GOC Authorities

FYI

1. The following is a report submitted in late June by AMCLATTER-1. Due to its lack of details, an attempt was made to get further information and/or corroboration, but to no avail. The report dated Havana, 17 April 63, came through [ ] a recent arrival from Cuba who is affiliated with the Juventud Anticomunista Revolucionaria, a part of the GARCERAN Constitutional Thesis Movement. [ ] got the information from [ ] who is still in the Uruguayan Embassy in Havana and who claims to have received it from [ ] a 06 former member of the DRE Supply Sector underground. The channel to [ ] from Cuba was said to be the Uruguayan diplomatic pouch.
2. The report states that Ricardo "Oquendo" ALFONSO Villalva (small, thin, about 22 years old, wears side burns) who lives at Zapata between 14th and 16th (3rd floor), Havana is chief of the militia post La Lisa. His wife's name is Elsa. "Oquendo" and another individual named "Mongo" destroyed the DRE underground by penetrating it for Cuban authorities.

3. JMWAVE traces on the above are as follows:

a. No record of Ricardo ALFONSO VILLALVA or his nom de guerre, "Oquendo".

b. No record of [ ]

c. "Mongo" is the nom de guerre of Jorge MEDINA Bringuier. JMWAVE CI Branch is debriefing a confessed former collaborator with Cuban authorities who has also named "Mongo" as a G-2 agent.

d. Identifying information on [ ] DDPOB 8 May 31, Pinar del Rio. Subject to currency of interest to CI Branch.

C. [redacted] is identical to [redacted] 06  
 mentioned in WAVE-9701, 14 June 63, as one of the Uruguayan  
 asylees who was denied entry into PUPRIME because of derogatory  
 information provided by Cuban exiles. A [redacted] is noted in 06  
 seven extracts from Hoy, 1946 through 1950, as holding provincial  
 and municipal committee posts in the PSP in Las Villas, Ciego de Avil,  
 Ranchuelo, San Juan and San Fernando de Camarones, Cuba. Other entries  
 under [redacted] include UFG-02521, 12 March 63, "member of NRP in  
 Corralillo," and in 201-312732, a Spanish language PRQ on Francisco 04  
 Rene FRIGA Lomban that [redacted] is a possible Communist.

f. One card on [redacted] aka Hector from an AMWOO-1 report  
 dated June 1962 describes him as Provincial Coordinator of the MRR  
 working in the H. Upman Cigar factory and residing on Justicia St.,  
 Luyano, Havana.
