Doc. 1155 INTERNATIONAL MILITARY TRIBUNAL FOR THE FAR EAST THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, et el VS ARAKI, Sadao, et al SWORN DEPOSITION Deponent: Yano lie sao Having first duly sworn on orth as on attached sheet and in accordance with the procedure followed in my country I hereby derose as follows:

Def. Doc. 1155 I am an ex-Lieutenant General of the Japanese Army, and now living at No. 55 2 Chome Magahanacho, Fukuoka. Since November 1944 I served as the Chief of Staff of the Third District Army under General Ushiroku's command, and stryed in Titiher until March 1945. I subsequently became commander of the 57th Division and went to "Sanshinfu". Upon my strivel there I received an order from the Awantung Army and was transferred flong with my division from Enchuria to Fukuoka for joining in the Pacific War. I was connected with the drawing up of the plan of operations of the Third District Army for the year 1945 while I was the Chief of Staff of that Army. The circumstances are stated as collows: Although I am not well acquainted with the plan of operations before 1945, I knew that the outline of the plan was to defend against possible attacks of the USSR, the line of the right bank of the /mour River in the north, and the line of Hairal and Great Hsingan mountains in the west. However, when I arrived there, I received a new instruction regarding new operation plans from the headquarters of the Ewantung Army. According to this, the Third District Army was to make gradual retreat after offering & slight resistance in the area of Songo and H Hairal, and was to make the final resistance on the line of Peian, Nonko, Jarantong and Hsingan. Following this instruction, the Third District Army arew up a concrete plen and when the plan was about to be reported to the Commender-in-Chief of the Kwantung Armu, I was transferred. At that time the Third District Army was composed of three divisions and one brigade. The divisions were the 57th, 107th and 119th, and only the 57th division was well seasoned, the others being newly organized inferior divisions. I became the commender of this well seasoned 57th Division. However, this division was also transferred to Japan proper for the Pacific war. ... newly organized division was substituted for it, thus rendering all aivisions of the Third District Army inferior in quality. After I arrived in Jepan proper, I was told that the herdquarters of the Third District Army was transferred from Titiher to Hukuden.
