

Shri Bhupinder Singh Hooda, Chief Minister, Haryana had written a letter to the Prime Minister on 23.10.2008 requesting for land in Delhi for INA Memorial and Netaji Subhash Bhavan. The Ministry of Urban Development has given the following comments:

2. Ministry of Urban Development, through Land & Development Office allots lands to Government organizations, local bodies, various institutions, etc., after due consideration of requests made to it for such purposes. Considering the limited availability of land and also the large number of requests being received for allotment of land, a Land Allotment Screening Committee has been constituted on 24th September 2003 for screening applications for allotment of land and making its recommendations to the Ministry for consideration. The Committee at its meeting held on 7.11.2006, inter-alia, considered the requirement of land for allotment to various political parties as per the policy and requests pending from various Government Departments /bodies /para-statals /local bodies and was of the opinion that it is not feasible to consider the requests of the NGO's as there is no scope for allotment of land to them in the near future. The matter relating to allotment of land to various NGOs in Delhi has been examined and since the land availability being limited, the requests for NGOs are not being acceded to. However, the organizations can apply to DDA or other bodies for consideration as per the procedure laid down by these agencies/bodies.

3. Ministry of Urban Development may be requested to send a reply to CM, Haryana, from an appropriate level, *under intimation to this office.*

2. Comments of M/o Urban Development were sought. The Ministry has stated that the Ministry, through Land & Development Office allots lands to Government organizations, local bodies, various institutions, etc., after due consideration of requests made to it for such purposes. Considering the limited availability of land and also the large number of requests being received for allotment of land, a Land Allotment Screening Committee was constituted in 2003 for screening applications for allotment of land and making its recommendations to the Ministry for consideration. The Committee at its meeting held on 7.11.2006, *inter-alia*, considered the matter and was of the opinion that it is not feasible to consider the requests of the NGO's as there is no scope for allotment of land to them in the near future. The requests for NGOs are not being acceded to. However, the organizations can apply to DDA or other bodies for consideration as per the procedure laid down by these agencies/bodies. Apart from this, there is a Cabinet decision of 16.8.2008 that Government shall not develop any Samadhi for the departed leaders.

Comments:

3. This was examined and M/o Urban Development was requested to send a reply to CM, Haryana, from an appropriate level, under intimation to this office. However, no reply has been received so far.

4. This is an old reference of the CM, Haryana. We had requested the M/o Urban Development to reply to the CM under intimation to this office. However, no copy has so far been received. The CM, Haryana has also not pursued this matter since 2008. It may not be worthwhile to reply to the Chief Minister at such a belated stage particularly when his request has not been acceded to. We may consider to drop this matter.

2. The Cabinet in its meeting on 16.8.2000 had considered the Note (copy enclosed) circulated by this Ministry and had, interalia, taken the following decisions:-

“(ii) Henceforth, Govt. shall not develop any Samadhi for the departed leaders.

(iii) The Trusts or Societies set up in memory of the departed leaders may set up such Memorials or Samadhis, but the expenses to be incurred in this regard both for acquisition of land and for development and maintenance of the Samadhi/Memorial shall be the responsibility of the concerned Trusts or Societies. However, Govt. may consider to sanction one time grants-in-aid to such trusts/societies on case to case basis as per guidelines to be framed in this regard.”

3. In view of above, no new Memorial/Samadhi of a departed leader can be built unless otherwise decided by the Cabinet.

A. CONVERSION OF BUNGALOWS IN LBZ AREA INTO MEMORIALS

1. Only 105 Type VIII and 89 Type VII residential Bungalows are available in the General Pool in the Lutyen Bungalow Zone for allotment to Union Ministers, Chairmen and Members of various High Powered Commissions, Constitutional and Statutory bodies, Secretaries to Government and other high ranking officers, and former Presidents, Vice Presidents and Prime Ministers of India. Bungalows from the same General Pool have also been allotted to national parties for their offices, organisations like Press Club of India, Foreign Correspondents Association of South Asia, United Nations Military Observers Group for India & Pakistan etc, and personalities like Mir Qasim, Begum Sajeda Sultan etc. Many Members of Parliament who were former Ministers are also occupying the bungalows from the General Pool. A few bungalows have also

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been allotted to Trusts for setting up Memorials for the departed leaders. All these have created an acute shortage of such type of accommodation, with the result that many of the dignitaries who are otherwise entitled could not be provided with the appropriate type of bungalows.

2. Since there is a total ban on construction of new bungalows in the Lutyen Bungalows Zone, the problem can not be solved by construction of additional bungalows in this area. Vacant land in the vicinity of central Delhi are also not available where such bungalows can be constructed. Therefore the solution to the problem has to be found in the better management of the existing bungalows. In this context, during informal discussion in the Cabinet Committee on Accommodation, a suggestion was mooted that in view of the acute shortage of the bungalows Government should consider to impose a ban on further conversion of bungalows into Memorials for departed leaders.

3. The following bungalows in the Lutyen Bungalow Zone have already been converted into Memorials :

- (i) Bungalow No.1, Teen Murti House : Dedicated in the name of Shri Jawaharlal Nehru.
- (ii) Bungalow No.1, Safdarjang Road : Dedicated in the name of Smt. Indira Gandhi.
- (iii) Bungalow No.1, Akbar Road : Dedicated in the name of Smt. Indira Gandhi.
- (iv) Bungalow No.1, Motilal Nehru Place : Dedicated in the name of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri.

Decisions for converting the above mentioned bungalows into Memorials for departed national leaders have been taken on a case to case basis keeping in view the need to

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perpetuate their memories and the contribution made by them to the nation, since there are no specific guidelines regarding conversion of bungalows into memorials.

4. As per decision taken by the Cabinet on 20.3.1982, 1, Bungalow No.1, Teen Murti House has been placed at the disposal of Nehru Memorial Museum and Library Society on lease basis on recovery of a token licence fee of Re. 1/- per annum for a period of 20 years. Subsequently, while considering the issue of construction of Nehru Planetarium by the Jawaharlal Nehru Memorial Fund in Teen Murti House Complex, the Cabinet decided on 17.6.1993 that

- (i) the ownership of the buildings housing the Memorials of the departed national leaders will not be transferred to any institution and shall vest with the Central Govt. and
- (ii) maintenance of these buildings will be undertaken by the CPWD as deposit work on behalf of societies/trusts constituted in the name of the departed national leaders.

5. Cabinet in its meeting dated 17.11.1984 decided to convert bungalow No. 1, Safdarjang Road into Memorial of Indira Gandhi and in a similar decision taken on 1.6.1985, bungalow no 1, Akbar Road was also converted into a Memorial of Indira Gandhi. However, formal allotment of these bungalows in the name of Indira Gandhi Memorial Trust was not made till 1.2.2000 when Cabinet decided to place these two bungalows at the disposal of the said Trust for a period of 25 years with effect from

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1.6.1985 on payment of token licence fee of Re. 1/- per annum on the following terms

and conditions :-

- (i) the ownership of the buildings will not be transferred to any institution and shall vest with the Central Govt.;
- (ii) maintenance of the said bungalows will be undertaken by the CPWD as deposit works and funds shall be provided by the Trust;
- (iii) after the expiry of the period of allotment, the licence will be renewed on mutually agreed terms and conditions subject to the approval of the competent authority. However, if it is observed that there is a violation of the licence terms and conditions, the land and building will revert to the Govt., and affairs of the institutions will be administered by the Govt. through the concerned administrative Ministries;
- (iv) no portion of the building will be used by any person for residential purposes;
- (v) the trust would faithfully endeavour to implement schemes as may be considered appropriate by the Govt. for the proper development of the Memorial and optimum utilisation of the premises for related literary and cultural pursuits.

6. Cabinet in a similar decision taken in the same meeting decided to place the bungalow no. 1, Motilal Nehru Place at the disposal of Lal Bahadur Shastri Memorial

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Trust on similar terms and conditions as stated in the pre-para for a period of 25 years from the date of death of Smt. Lalita Shastri on 13.4.1993.

7. It may also be pertinent here to mention that the following bungalows have also been allotted/proposed to be allotted to the widows of former Presidents, Prime Ministers and other leaders for retention during their lifetime :

- (i) Bungalow no. 12, Tughlak Road, allotted to Smt. Gayatri Devi widow of late Shri Charan Singh;
- (ii) Bungalow no. 10, Janpath, allotted to Smt Sonia Gandhi, widow of late Shri Rajiv Gandhi (She is now eligible for allotment of the bungalow in her capacity as leader of Opposition);
- (iii) Bungalow no. 19, Akbar Road, allotted to Begum Abida Ahmed, widow of late S ri Fakruddin Ali Ahmed;
- (iv) Bungalow no. 4, Circular Road, proposed to be allotted to Smt. Pradhan Kour; widow of late Giani Zail Singh;
- (v) Bungalow no. 6, K M Marg, allotted to Smt. Indrani Devi widow of late Shri Jagjivan Ram;
- (vi) Bungalow no. AB-15, Tilak Marg, allotted to Smt. Kameswari Devi, widow of late Shri L.N.Mishra;

8. In addition, bungalow no. 12, Willingdon Crescent, is under the occupation of Sanjay Gandhi Memorial Trust since 7.5.1987. The Trust had submitted an application for formal allotment of the bungalow in their favour for setting up a Memorial of Sanjay

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Gandhi which was rejected by the Ministry and an order of eviction was also passed, but the Trust has obtained a stay order from the court to continue their occupation of the bungalow. There is a likelihood that similar demands for setting up such Memorials may also be made by similar Trusts set up to perpetuate the memory of leaders who had once stayed in the bungalows. It is therefore felt, as never before, that instead of considering such requests on a case to case basis in an ad hoc manner, the Government should lay down policy guidelines for conversion of bungalows into Memorials.

9. In this context it is pertinent to mention that the Delhi High Court has, on the basis of an article of Smt. Jaya Jaitley published in the Indian Express dated 1.6.1997, registered a PIL Writ Petition (Civil) No. 2560/97 and directed in its order dated 10.11.1998 that

".....on overall consideration of the matter we direct that no further allotment of the houses for the purpose of trust, memorials, and political parties shall be made by the Union of India without the leave of this Court."

10. In view of the position stated above, it is submitted for consideration that the Cabinet may consider to impose a total ban on the conversion of Govt. bungalows into Memorials etc in future, as a matter of conscious policy, not only to discourage the raising of such demands in future but also to reserve the bungalows for the use of the Govt. functionaries for whom these are meant.

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B. DEVELOPMENT OF NEW SAMADHIS OF NATIONAL LEADERS

11. The samadhi of the Father of the Nation Mahatma Gandhi was developed at the site of his cremation near river Yamuna, which was subsequently developed as Rajghat.

The Parliament enacted the Rajghat Samadhi Act 1951 for the management of the Rajghat spreading over a sprawling 45 acres of land. Subsequently, Samadhis of former Prime Ministers Pt. Jawaharlal Nehru, Lal Bahadur Shastri, Smt. Indira Gandhi, Rajiv Gandhi, Ch. Charan Singh and former Deputy Prime Minister Babu Jagjivan Ram have also been developed in the vicinity of the Rajghat. All these dignitaries, except Babu Jagjivan Ram were cremated at the site where their Samadhis have come up. Although Babu Jagjivan Ram was cremated in his native town Sasaram in Bihar, an urn containing his ashes was buried in Rajghat Samadhi area, where later on the Samata Sthal was developed with the approval of the Cabinet. Samadhi of Shri Mararji Desai has been developed at Ahmedabad where he was cremated.

12. Shri Sanjay Gandhi was cremated near Shantivana, the Samadhi of Pt. Nehru. His Samadhi, which forms part of Shantivana, was also raised at the State expenses. Similarly, Smt. Lalita Shastri, wife of late Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri was cremated within the Vijay Ghat Complex and her samadhi has been developed at the site at State expenses.

13. The capital expenditure incurred on the construction and development of various Samadhis in Delhi and in Siperumbudur are as under :

There is a likelihood that similar demands for setting up such Memorials may also be made by similar Trusts set up to perpetuate the memory of leaders who had once stayed in the bungalows. 9. In this context it is pertinent to mention that the Delhi High Court has, on the basis of an article of Smt. Jaya Jaitley published in the Indian Express dated 1.6.1997, registered a PIL Writ Petition (Civil) No. 2560/97 and directed in its order dated 10.11.1998 that

10. In view of the position stated above, it is submitted for consideration that the Cabinet may consider to impose a total ban on the conversion of Govt. bungalows into Memorials etc in future, as a matter of conscious policy, not only to discourage the raising of such demands in future but also to reserve the bungalows for the use of the Govt. functionaries for whom these are meant.

14. The available Government land along the bank of river Yamuna, where these Samadhis are situated has been shrinking steadily with the development of one Samadhi after another. Any attempt to take away any portion of land once allotted to a particular Samadhi, is likely to evoke strong protests from the family members and followers of the departed leader, as it indeed has in the past. When the samadhi of Ch. Charan Singh was developed the Rajghat Samadhi Committee protested that part of the area earmarked for the Rajghat had already been taken away in 1994 for the Shakti Sthal, the Samadhi of Smt. Indira Gandhi and therefore any further reduction in the area of Rajghat would amount to an insult to the Father of the Nation. Finally, it was decided to develop Kisan Ghat, the Samadhi of Ch. Charan Singh, without making any formal allocation of land.

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15. Requests to commemorate the memory of other departed national leaders are bound to be made by their followers and family members, unless a clear cut policy is evolved in this regard. Raising of such samadhis not only involves allocation of large chunks of valuable land in Delhi, which has already become scarce, this also requires large amount of funds for the development and maintenance of these Samadhis. Perhaps a time has come when the job of raising the Memorials and propagating the ideals of the departed national leaders, both past and future, could well be left to their followers, fans or family members or to the trusts or societies that might be set up specifically for any such purpose.

16. In view of the position stated above, it is submitted for consideration that the Cabinet may consider to impose a ban on the development of Samadhis of National Leaders at the expenses of the State exchequer in future. If at all such Samadhis are to be developed, the Trusts or Societies set up by the family members or the followers of the departed leaders may do so at their own expenses with the approval of competent authority.

C. ANNIVERSARIES/FUNCTIONS OF NATIONAL LEADERS AT THEIR SAMADHIES.

17. Holding of State functions at the Samadhis to commemorate the birth and death anniversaries of the departed leaders is another question which needs to be addressed. Every year, this Ministry organises functions on the birth and death anniversaries of Pt. Jawaharlal Nehru, Lal Bahadur Shastri, Smt. Indira Gandhi, Ch. Charan Singh and Shri Rajiv Gandhi. These functions are attended by the President, Vice President, Prime

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Minister, a large number of other VIPs, friends and relatives of late leaders etc.

Substantial expenditure is incurred mainly on the following items:-

- (i) Barricading and provision of view cutters etc. on account of security requirements in connection with the visits of the VVIPs;
- (ii) Floral decoration and seating arrangements;
- (iii) Stand by arrangements for ensuring uninterrupted electric supply for security checks and public address system;
- (iv) Printing and distribution of invitation cards and parking labels as per security requirements;
- (v) Arrangements for bhajans and recitals by reputed singers and musicians and their travel, accommodation, fees etc;
- (vi) Transportation, refreshment and dress for the school children attending such function;
- (vii) Recording of bhajans/songs, background music etc.

18. Expenditure incurred for the maintenance of the Samadhis as also for holding the commemorative functions at the Samadhi functions during the last 5 years has been as under:-

This excludes the expenses incurred for the maintenance of the Samadhi of Mahatma Gandhi which are placed at the disposal of the Rajghat Samadhi Committee. This also excludes the expense incurred by the security agencies for the arrangement.

19. Due to changing security perceptions and political scenario, the expenditure keeps on increasing from year to year. In some functions, on the express wishes of the family, top grade artists are invited, who normally charge a fee of Re. 1 lakh or even more for performing just for 50 minutes.

20. In no other country, there is such a tradition or practice to commemorate the birth and death anniversaries of a large number of national leaders at the expense of public exchequer on such a large scale. In view of the ever increasing number of Samadhi functions and the consequential financial burden on the national exchequer, it needs to be considered as to how the number of functions and expenditure thereon could be curtailed

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or at least contained in future. Some of the suggestions which can be considered in this regard are as under:-

- (i) Functions on the anniversaries of Mahatma Gandhi may be organised by the Rajghat Samadhi Committee as at present at the expenses of the State but the functions on anniversaries of all other leaders may be organised by the trusts /societies concerned at their own expense;
- (ii) CPWD shall be responsible for the maintenance of the samadhis already developed by them;
- (iii) Both the development of new Samadhis and their maintenance shall be the responsibility of the trusts/societies concerned .

21. It is further suggested that even if we want to hold functions in respect of former Presidents /Prime Ministers, arrangements for functions should be simplified and only local artists may be invited to perform instead of inviting eminent artists from outside Delhi. Likewise, the practice of inviting school children/holding inter-faith prayers may also be discontinued, except on the birth/death anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi.

CONCLUSION

22. Therefore the following resolutions are submitted for the consideration and approval of the Cabinet :-

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- (i) A total ban shall be imposed on the conversion of Govt. bungalows into Memorials of the departed leaders;
- (ii) Henceforth, Govt. shall not develop any Samadhi for the departed leaders;
- (iii) The Trusts or Societies set up in memory of the departed leaders may set up such Memorials or Samadhis, but the expenses to be incurred in this regard both for acquisition of land and for development and maintenance of the Samadhi/ Memorial shall be the responsibility of the concerned Trusts or Societies. However, Govt, may consider to sanction one time grants-in-aid to such trusts/societies on case to case basis as per guidelines to be framed in this regard;
- (iv) CPWD shall continue to maintain the Samadhis of the national leaders already developed;
- (v) The organisation of the birth and death anniversary functions of Mahatma Gandhi shall continue to be the responsibility of Rajghat Samadhi Committee, for which necessary funds shall be provided by the Govt. as per the past practice;
- (vi) The birth and death anniversary functions of all other national leaders shall be organised by the family members of the departed leaders or the by the trust/ societies set up in their memories and no financial grants shall be sanctioned for their purpose.

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23. Ministries of Home Affairs and Finance were consulted, but no comments have been received from them even after the expiry of stipulated period of 15 days.

24. This note has the approval of the Minister for Urban Development.
