SUBJECT: Information of General Application Pertaining to Directive Number SCAPIN 2123, file AG 000.77 ( 18 Sep 50 ) CCS, this Headquarters, dated 18 Sep 50, subject: Provisions of Broadcasting Facilities

1. With reference to subject memorandum, the following is published for the information of all concerned.

2. The purpose of the subject directive is to authorize the Japanese Government and the Broadcasting Corporation of Japan to make available broadcasting facilities of the Broadcasting Corporation of Japan for foreign language broadcasting.

3. The directive will expedite arrangements for use of these broadcasting facilities.

4. The subject directive provides that all expenses in connection with such foreign language broadcasting will be paid for by the U.S. Government after contracts have been negotiated and entered into with the Japan Logistical Command.
