TO : Commanding Officer, Kyushu Military Government Region, APC 929  
(Attn: Legal Section)

1. An inspecting officer from Military Government Section, I Corps, accompanied by members of the legal section of this headquarters, inspected the Kagoshima Prison on 3 December 1947. During the course of this inspection, it was noted that there were six (6) Japanese carbines (cal. 7.7) in custody of the warden. The question of whether or not this institution was authorized to retain shoulder weapons was discussed, but the question was left unsettled as there are no directives concerning this subject in the files of this headquarters.

2. Request your headquarters forward any information concerning this subject as soon as possible.

3. The above mentioned weapons are being retained by the warden of the prison until definite information is obtained.
