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

1. DA radio 34873, dated 19 July 51, requested controlled materials program requirements of copper, steel and aluminum for Japan by quarters for the period 1 July 51 to 31 December 52 (6 Quarters) for each separate military procurement program and Japanese civilian use.

2. The Department of Defense needs this information to appraise the U.S. supply position in relation to programmed uses of the Armed Forces and the Domestic economies of Occupied areas. The Department of Defense is claimant for Japan.

3. At a conference, ESS, 21 July, Army, Navy, Air Force, NPR and ESS/IND agreed that SCAP should base his requirements on consumption records of past 12 months plus existing programs, but excluding amounts which might be required for increased utilization of Japanese industrial potential.
