10. BRIEF SUMMARY OF SIGHTING One small, dark object, possibly a meteorite, was observed at 01:05 on 16 August 1976. The object was seen from the observation post at Gulmang, New Hampshire. It was estimated to be about 100-200 feet in diameter and was moving in a southerly direction. The object was seen for approximately 10-15 seconds before it disappeared. The observer was a civilian resident of the area.			11. COMMENTS Opinion of observer is that it was caused by meteorite. Size, shape, color, and lack of motion were consistent with this hypothesis. Photographs were negative for identification. It could be a very small satellite at time of sighting.
