

The Brig Mary Celeste Labeled in Boston.

The brig Mary Celeste, found deserted at sea and taken into Gibraltar, as before mentioned, has been libeled and a suit commenced in the United States District Court in this city, the libel alleging that the vessel had obtained American registry and the right to sail under American colors by fraud. It has recently been stated that there were strong suspicions that her desertion at sea was done to defraud the insurance companies. Nothing is known as to the fate of her crew, and the whole affair is involved in mystery.
