THE OFFICE WITH THE NAME OF CARDIGAN.

Capl. Hughes, master of the County of Cardigan, at Liverpool, reports leaving Fraser River, B.C., December 15th, says the Liverpool Journal of Commerce on April 12th, passing Cape Horn February 17th, and the equator March 25th; also reports experienced heavy southerly gales after leaving for several days, also had very heavy gale off Cape Horn; lost some sails, and washed the port lifeboat and several movable things about the deck overboard.
