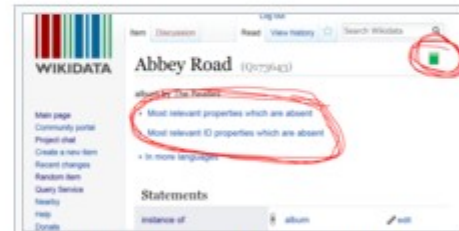

Recoin ("Relative Completeness Indicator") is a script that extends Wikidata entity pages with information about the *relative completeness* of the information. Relative completeness refers to the extent of information found on an item in comparison with other similar items.

The indicator aggregates the extent of information into a colored progress bar, showing 5 possible color-coded levels of completeness that range from *very detailed information* to *very basic information*.

Recoin is intended to both help authors to know where to potentially focus their attention, and to make data consumers aware of the degree of information found in a specific article.

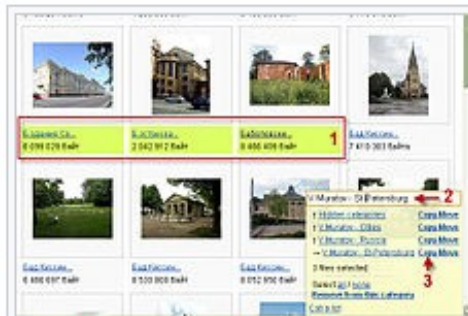
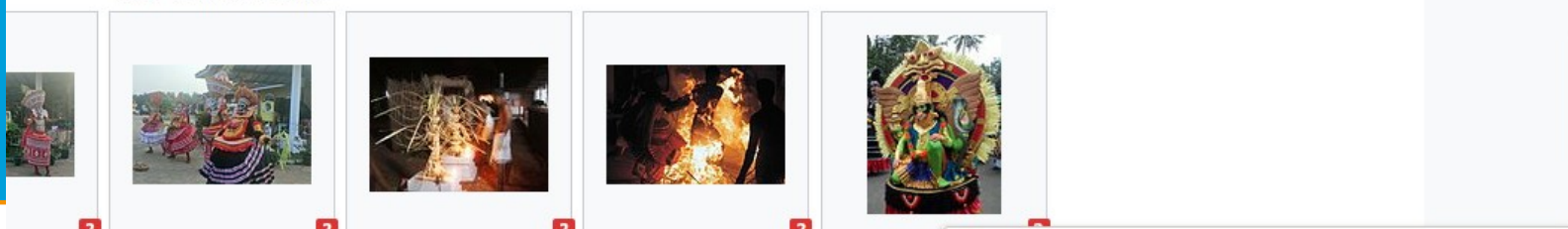


Figure 1: Cat-a-lot steps:

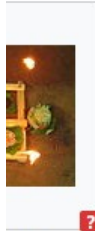

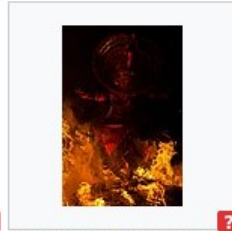

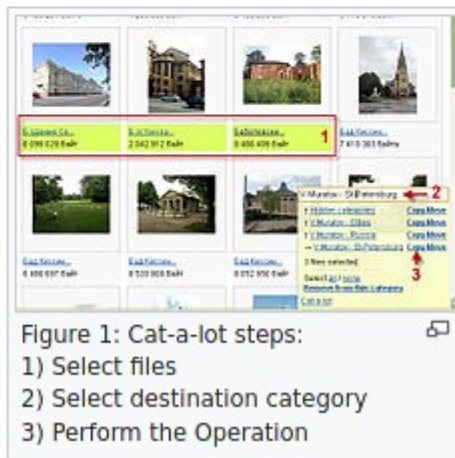

The light station was established in 1854 and discontinued in 1933. It was listed on the [National Register of Historic Places](#) as **Pumpkin Island Light Station** on February 1, 1988.^[1] The island and former light station are privately owned.

Description and history

Pumpkin Island is roughly 3 acres (1.2 ha) in size and is located off the northern tip of Little Deer Island on the east side of [Penobscot Bay](#). The channel to the east of the island, Eggemoggin Reach, connects Penobscot Bay to Blue Hill Bay further east. The island was chosen (in preference to a site on the mainland to the north) in 1852 to be the site of the station marking the northwestern end of the channel.

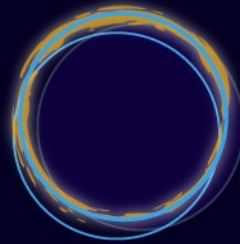
