The saw no more of TEWFIQ until Wednesday, 11/27/63, when they met in an Arab cafe in Leman Street, much used by Arabs of various nationalities and classes. They exchanged a few words on that occasion, and TEWFIQ asked for HASSAN's home address, promising to visit him there shortly.

"The next day, Thursday, HASSAN was invited by an Egyptian acquaintance to visit the Egyptian ship "El Gisa", then lying in West India Dock; as they were leaving the ship later on, HASSAN saw TEWFIQ making his way towards it, and assumed that he was known to members of the crew (S)

'That evening, TEWFIQ visited HASSAN at the latter's home. During the course of conversation, TEWFIQ mentioned that he had recently been in New York, visiting a friend. Later, after he had been drinking heavily and while a program on President KENNEDY was being shown on television, he made offensive remarks about Americans in general and about Mr. KENNEDY in particular, producing a revolver from his pocket, he said, 'We have completed our work in America now we shall be returning to Egypt." HASSAN is in no doubt that this remark referred to the assassination.

By the end of the evening TEWFIQ was fairly drunk and insisted on staying the night. As HASSAN and his wife were frightened by his manner, they complied with his demand, and a bed was made up in one of the rooms. TEWFIQ left early the next morning and HASSAN has not seen him since. Two letters and a photo were found in the flat by HASSAN, evidently left behind by TEWFIQ; the letters, in Arabic, contain nothing of interest, while the photo, showing TEWFIQ talking to a young girl, is, according to HASSAN, a reasonably good likeness.

"The police have made inquiries and they state that TEWFIQ is known to his Egyptian and other Arab acquaintances as TEWFIQ SHAWKIXEL HADIDI and was understood to be or to have been a Captain in the Egyptian Army and to be now working as an Intelligence Officer. According to further information, so far unverified, he was in the U.S. a short while ago. He is also believed to have a brother, ALI SHAWKI EL-HADIDI, who may be an official at the UAR Embassy in Vienna.
