

• Thunderstorms and heavy rain have been affecting the country over the past weeks, especially the northern, northeastern and northwestern states, causing floods and casualties. · Local media reported, as of 1 August at 7.00 UTC, that at least 205 people died, of which 94 in Gujarat State, 83 in Assam State and 28 in the states of Odisha and Rajasthan due to floods and lightning. Assam State Disaster Management Authority reported, as of 31 July, that 131 899 people have been displaced to relief camps and that the total crop area affected had reached 209 051 ha in Assam.

 Over the next 24 hours, thunderstorms and heavy to very heavy rain is forecast to affect the northern areas of the country, including the already affected state of Assam. The Indian Meteorological Department has issued an Orange Alert for heavy rain in the state of Uttarakhand.
