Entries in the Index are carried primarily under the names of the issuing agencies, with the most significant entries additionally carried in appropriate alphabetical position.

A cumulative codification guide, keyed to the Code of Federal Regulations, is also published monthly. The guide lists titles, parts, and sections, and indicates the nature of changes effected by Federal Register documents published to date in the calendar year.
