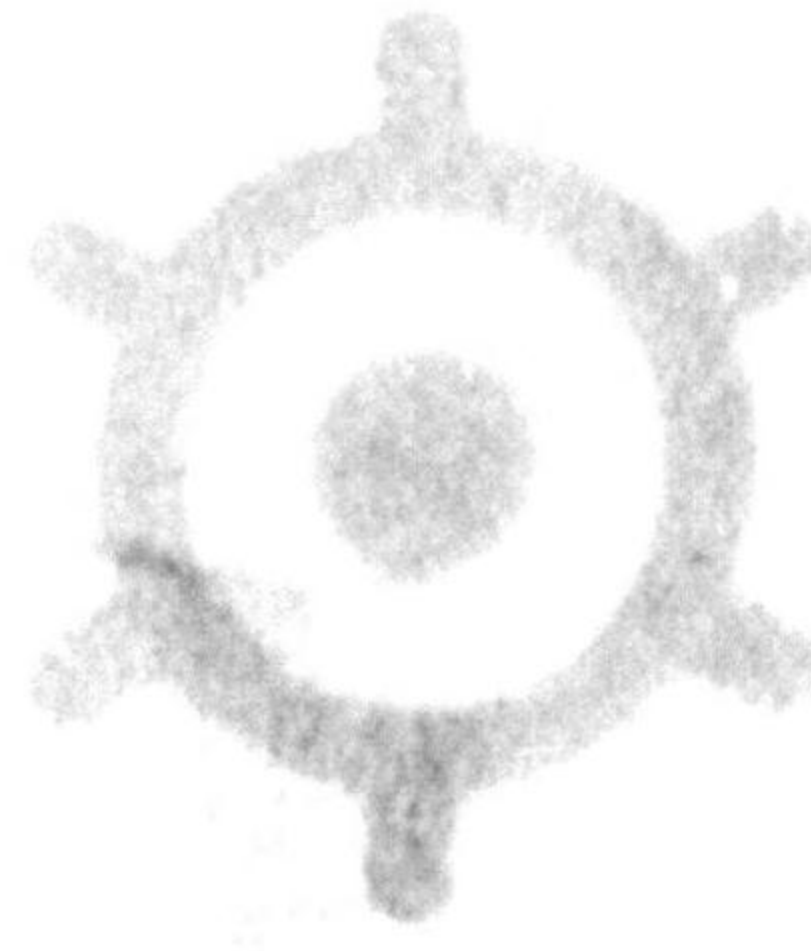

ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION

Chapter I General

Article 1 The name of the corporation is Ube Kagaku Kogyo K.K. and written in English as the Ube Chemical Industry Co. Ltd.

Article 2 The objects and purposes of the corporation shall be as follow:
1. Manufacture and sales of various kind of goods produced from bitter brine.
2. Manufacture and sales of crude magnesium carbonate and other chemical outputs.
3. Manufacture and sales of copper and light alloyes.
4. All other business pertaining to the above items.

Article 3 The corporation shall be able to invest in enterprises corresponding with or relating to the preceding business.

Article 4 The capital of the corporation shall be twelve million Yen. (¥12,000,000)

Article 5 The head office of the corporation shall be located in the city of Ube.

Article 6 The public notice of the corporation shall be shown on Kan-po or the Mainichi Sinbun published at Tokyo.

Chapter II Shares and Shareholder

Article 7 The capital of the corporation shall be divided into two hundred four thousand (240,000) shares with par value of fifty Yen (¥50) each.

Article 8 The share certificates of the corporation shall be consisted of five denomination, namely certificates of one share, ten (10) shares, fifty (50) shares, one hundred (100) shares, and one thousand (1,000) shares.

Article 9 Amount of shares of the corporation shall be covered by spot investment regulated in Art. 4|.

Article 10 The date, amount and manner of payment of shares, shall be decided by the discretion of the Board of Directors.

Article 11 In case a shareholder neglects payment of shares, he shall pay interest Four (4) Sen per day per one Hundred Yen (¥100) to the corporation for a period, from the next day to the date when the term of payment of shares expires, till the day when he has paid in full.

Article 12

A shareholder, a registered pledgee, a legal representative of a shareholder shall notify the corporation of his name and address and furnish to the corporation an imprint of his seal in the form prescribed by the corporation, shall notify the corporation of any change in his name, address or seal.

But in the case of change in his name and seal, he shall notify the corporation under joint signature of two (2) guarantors or more, consented by the corporation.

A shareholder or registered pledgee or a legal representative of a shareholder who lives in the foreign country, shall notify the corporation of his provisional address of proxy living in Japan, and he shall also do so in case he change his proxy or his provisional address.

A shareholder, a registered pledgee or its legal representatives, shall furnish the document, affixed his seal on it, which previously notified to the corporation.

Article 13

The corporation has no responsibility of the result arising from, in case a shareholder, a registered pledgee or its legal representative who has neglect the preceding article.

Article 14

A person who has become a shareholder of a share by transfer and who wishes to have his name recorded in the register of shareholders as well as on the share certificate shall file application, duly signed and seals to be affixed by both transferer and acquirer, to that effect with the corporation in the manner and form prescribed by the corporation, submitting the share certificate duly signed and the seal to be affixed by the acquirer to the corporation, and the signature and seal on the application are not required by the indorsee in case the transferer has indorsed the share certificate.

A person who has become a shareholder of a share by the causes of a change of name, succession, request and other reason, and who wishes to have his name recorded in the register of shareholders as well as on the share certificate, shall file application, duly signed and his seal to be affixed by him, to that effect with the corporation, in the manner and form prescribed by the corporation, submitting the instrument confirming the cause of acquirement and the share certificate, duly signed and his seal to be affixed by him, to the corporation.

A person who wishes to have his name in the register of the shareholders as well as on the share certificate because of creating right of pledge and repledge of transfer, shall file application, duly signed and seals to be affixed by both parties, with the corporation, submitting the share certificate to the corporation, and in case he wishes to erase his name from the register of the shareholders as well as on the share certificate, he shall apply in the above manner and form.

The manner and form mentioned in the above items, shall be apply in the case of both displaying and excluding trust property in the register of the shareholder as well as on the share certificate.

Article 15

A shareholder desiring the reissue a share certificate of different denominations, or to reissue a certificate because of mutilation of a certificate, shall file application in the manner and form prescribed by the corporation, submitting the share certificate to the corporation, and in case it is difficulty to discern whether the certificate is real or not, shall be apply the prescription mentioned in Article 16.

Article 16

A shareholder who has lost his share certificate wishes to apply for a reissue of such lost certificate to the corporation, he shall file application duly signed and his seal to be affixed by him, in the manner and form prescribed by the corporation, after public summons, submitting the exemplification of the decision on loss of the right or its certified copy to the corporation.

Article 17

An applicant shall pay Five (5) Yen per share certificate as a fee for reissuance of a certificate, and Two (2) Yen per share certificate as a fee registration of a change name, registration of the name of a person creating right of pledge, or repledge, or transfer and its exclusion, and registration, for display of trust property or exclusion of it.

Article 18

The formalities for the registration of any share transfer, on the Books of the corporation as well as on the share certificate, shall be prohibited for a period, from the next day to the end of every settlement term, till the day when the ordinary general meeting of shareholders comes to an end, and for a period, from the day when the extraordinary general meeting of shareholders is convened, till the day when its meeting comes to end.

The formalities for the registration of any share transfer, on the Books of the corporation as well as on the share certificate shall be prohibited in case of need.

The prohibition shall be executed upon previous public notice.

The formalities for the registration of the name of person creating right of pledge or omitting it, or the display of trust property or exclusion of it, shall be prohibited for a period, during the time of prohibition of the registration of the transfer.

Chapter III General meeting of shareholders

Article 19

The general meeting of shareholders shall be held at the location of the head office of the corporation, or at the every ward in Tokyo.

Article 20

The ordinary general meeting of shareholders of the corporation shall be held respectively in the month of May and November of each and every year, and extraordinary general meeting at such times as may be necessary.

Article 21 The date, location and the objects of the general meeting of shareholder shall be notify to the shareholders at least Two (2) weeks before the date of meeting.

Article 22 Every shareholders shall have one vote for each share.

Article 23 At every meeting of shareholders every shareholder shall be entitled to vote in person or his proxy, provided such proxy holder shall be a shareholder of the corporation and present to the corporation an instrument in writing, subscribed by him or his duly authorized attorney.

Article 24 The President of the corporation shall preside the general meeting of shareholder, and the chief managing Director shall become the chairman in his absence, and one of the Directors shall become the chairman in their absence.

Article 25 At all meeting of shareholders, all resolutions shall be made by pluraluty vote of shareholders present, except any other restriction as prescribed by law, and in case eye and noes vote are same in number, such resolution shall be made by the volition of the chairman.

Article 26 The chairman of the general meeting of shareholders shall exercise his right of voting as a shareholders.

Article 27 The adjournment, the continuation and change of the place of the general meeting of shareholders, shall be made by resolution of it.

Article 28 The proceedings at the meetings of shareholders shall be recorded in the Minute-Book of Shareholders Meeting preserved by the corporation, and shall be duly signed and affixed seals by the chairman, directors, inspectors and shareholder one or more present.

Chapter IV Directors and Inspectors

Article 29 The Directors of the corporation shall not be more than Five (5) in number and the Inspector shall not be more than Two (2) in number.

Article 30 The term of office of Directors shall terminate with the ending of the sixth ordinary general meeting of shareholders following the assumption of their duties, and that of Inspectors shall be so with the ending of the fourth, but if the period of the election different, the term of office of a Director or an Inspector, who have been elected at the least period, shall terminate at the expiration, of the first present Directors or Inspectors term of office.

Article 31 Any vacancy of a Director or an Inspector shall be filled by a by-election at the general meeting of shareholders, provided that in case the legal fixed number is not want up, the by-election may be postponed.

The term of office of a Directors or an Inspectors, who have been elected by a by-election, shall terminate at the expiration of the former Directors of Inspectors term of office.

Article 32 The Director shall organize the Board of Directors, and shall make resolutions on the important matters of the corporation.

Article 33 The Board of Directors shall be convened by the President, or the chief managing Director.
At the Board of Directors, all resolutions, shall be made by plurality vote of Directors present, and every Director shall be entitled to vote in person or by his proxy provide such proxy holder shall be the other Directors and present to the Board of Directors an instrument in writing, subscribed by him.

The resolution of the Board of Directors shall be made by the instrument in spite of above two items, when the plurality of Directors consented to do so.

Article 34 The resolution of the Board of Directors shall be decided by document with consent of a majority of Directors despite Art. 33.

Article 35 A President and a chief managing Director may be chosen by and from the Directors.
A President and a chief managing Director shall have his own respective own power to represent the corporation.

Article 36 The remuneration for Directors and Inspectors decided within on Eight Hundred Thousand Yen (¥800,000) per year.

Article 37 The corporation may appoint the councillor and the adviser.

Chapter V Accounting

Article 38 The term of the half-yearly settlement of the corporation shall be from April 1st to September 30th. (The First Half of Fiscal Year) and from October 1st to March 31st of the following year (The Second Half Fiscal Year) of every year.

Article 39 Net profit for the period shall be decided by the balance, deducted from total amount of profits to total amount of losses, and the corporation shall be dispose the net profit by the resolution of the general meeting of shareholders, which added the net profit brought to the period.

Chapter VI Supplementary Provision

Article 40 Organizational Expenses shall be less than one hundred two thousand Yen (¥120,000)




