1. Attached for your information is a copy of interrogation report on subject, a former Gestapo agent who became a double agent operating across the Spanish border in late 1945. Other traces on subject which you may still have in your files are [] This report is being forwarded you with particular reference to SOMMER's activities in Spain on behalf of the [] It is believed that a study of this document may be of some value in uncovering leads for discussion with [] (reference [])

2. [] report [] implied that SOMMER may still be operating for the [] of 21 June 1948 and KARL 1025 of 24 June 1948 seem to bear this out, the former stating that SOMMER is reported to have renewed his connection with the [] and the latter stating it is practically certain that he is again working for the []. Headquarters does not know whether the question of SOMMER could logically or securely be brought up with [] If you find that this could be done, it is suggested that you lead into a discussion by citing the Marseille newspaper article on SOMMER (basis of []) and recalling that he was a German agent arrested in Spain in late 1945. [] might be subtly persuaded to volunteer information regarding SOMMER's activities for the []

3. This office would like to amend the last sentence of paragraph 1 of [] to include studies which you might obtain locally in the Embassy. In this connection, it is suggested that you discuss with Mr. [] the possibility of his supplying studies on Spanish Republican activities in France for passage to []. It would be well to explain frankly your contact with [], since [] might conceivably be willing to supply such studies and briefs in return for whatever information is received of interest to him.

Es wurde weiter festgestellt, dass durch eine Kartellspanne diese Zusammenhänge erst verspätet entdeckt wurden.
2. Zunächst bestand der Verdacht, dass möglicherweise V-5304 eine vom Gegner auf die eigene Org. angesetzte Person sein könnte.
3. Auf Grund dieser Zusammenlage wurden nun durch 40 bei GV "G" und GV "L" entsprechende Ermittlungen angestellt.
4. Es ergab sich aus den Berichten der GV "G", dass diese alles eindeutig berichtet hatte und infolge dessen der Fehler in der Berichterstattung bei der GV "L" zu suchen sei.
5. GV "L" zum Bericht aufgefordert entgegen, dass weder eine persönliche noch schriftliche Pflanznahme zwischen CONNY (V-2951) und DEY stattgefunden habe.

person mentioned in [] who was described as an emissary of
Vincenz MUELLER, who had approached "CONNY", a sub-source of 2857, on MUELLER's
instructions, inviting "CONNY" to a personal chat in East Berlin. Zipper was
not aware of this, but agreed that POB's deductions were accurate. An
investigation conducted by Zipper's CE staff resulted in their informing us
that faulting reporting by 2857 was at the bottom of this flap. When first
questioned regarding V-6304's role in [], GVL denied that there
had been any written or oral contact between "CONNY" and V-6304. When
confronted with his earlier reports, 2857 reportedly made various excuses,
and finally admitted that he could ~~be~~ possibly have been the victim of a
"misunderstanding" and that his earlier reporting did not correspond to the
true facts. Zipper thereupon considered the incident closed, and informed
POB that they planned to drop V-2857.
