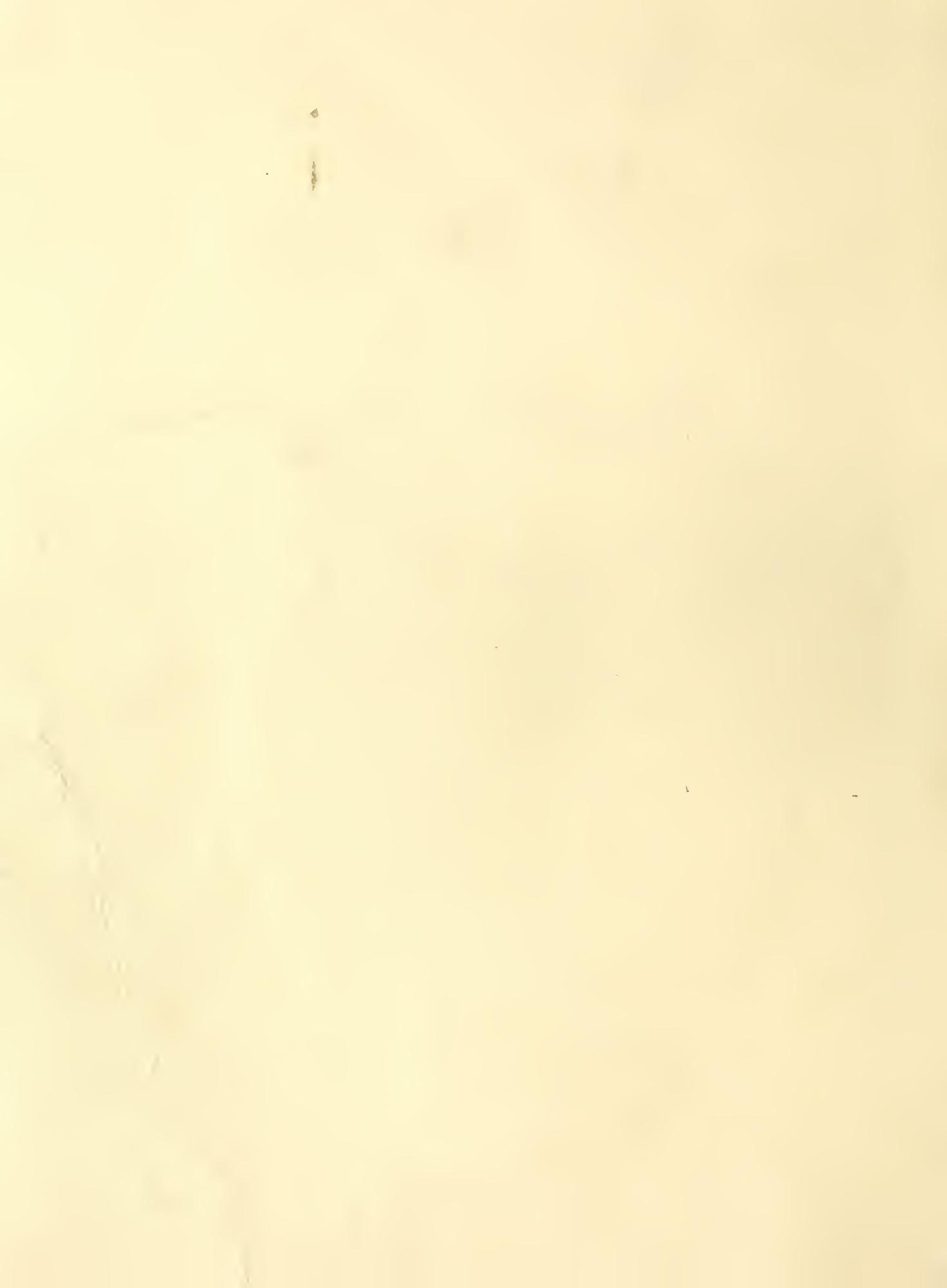

This will avoid delay which is very annoying. We cannot be expected to ship goods to those whose good standing is not known to us. For reference please name bankers, wholesale merchants or other well-known business men with whom you have had dealings—such information will be held in confidence.

Our Responsibility: While we always aim to have the best **SEEDS, BULBS AND PLANTS** which each season affords from reliable houses, we cannot and do not guarantee any of them to flower or produce a crop of flowers at the price given, or will we be responsible for the crop. We assume our customers to be acquainted with these conditions and if the stock is not accepted on such conditions it must be returned at once and any money paid will be refunded. Live plants and like perishable stock should be sent by express; we cannot assume any responsibility whatever for safe arrival when such plants are ordered by freight by the purchaser. The remedy for loss must lie between the buyer and the Railroad Company, but we will gladly render all the aid we can.

We prefer not to send goods C. O. D., but when wanted in that manner some money must accompany order. **PERISHABLE** stock, plants, etc., are **Positively NOT SENT C. O. D.**

LOW EXPRESS RATES ON PLANTS.

We ship plants by all express lines to any part of the country. Under the ruling of the leading express companies plants packed closed boxes or baskets are now being carried at the "GENERAL SPECIAL" rate, which means a reduction of 20 per cent. from the regular merchandise rate. Boxes weighing less than 100 pounds are charged at pound rates, but the minimum charge is 45c. For example, if the general rate is \$5.00 per 100 lbs., a box containing 25 lbs. will cost \$1.00, which is a saving of 25c.

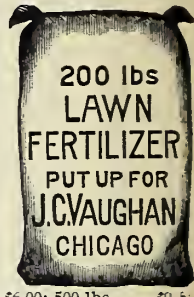

JAPAN LILIUM LONGIFLORUM.

REGULAR TYPE.

We are inclined to believe that the variations of types seen so often in benches of these plants forced under glass, come in part from too early digging in Japan, and possibly occasionally from some fault in growing with no doubt occasional real variation in types. Our Japan growers promise us careful inspection and say they will not dig the bulbs until well ripened. Keeping this in mind our prices below make this grade an attractive purchase.

MULTIFLORUM (Early.)

Our Japan grower does not claim that this type will produce more flowers per bulb, but they do so, all bulbs being well ripened. plants from these should flower ten days earlier and should show uniform growth, height, foliage and flowers. In fact, our growers promise us at least 80 per cent, true to type. Our customers have had generally better results from our stock of these than any other bulbs purchased elsewhere.

GIGANTEUM (Dark Stem.)

While this is supposed to be the latest of the three it has flowered this past season under careful test in the South Park Greenhouses, Chicago, rather earlier than either of the other two, though dug and shipped later from Japan—showing for a certainty that well ripened bulbs will flower earlier than those dug too soon and that those who crowd nature's work only lose time in the end. This type is very free flowering and true.

This splendid novelty while much like the common Calla has such definite points of added merit that it is, in our opinion, sure to take the place of the old variety. These improvements are—

FIRST—It will produce ½ more flowers than the ordinary Calla.

SECOND—The flowers while equally large are a little more round and are decidedly pure white. This improvement in color is plainly marked as they grow side by side in the field or greenhouse.

THIRD—The plant is from 8 to 10 inches shorter and stockier growth. Better for pots.

FINALLY—It is remarkably prolific, each root producing as offsets a number of small tubers each season. Of the various Callas introduced recently, Yellow, Dwarfs and others, none have proven of real value to the florist forcer of cut flowers, but in Vaughan's New Prolific we believe an advance has been made which will take the place of all other Callas for cut flower purposes.

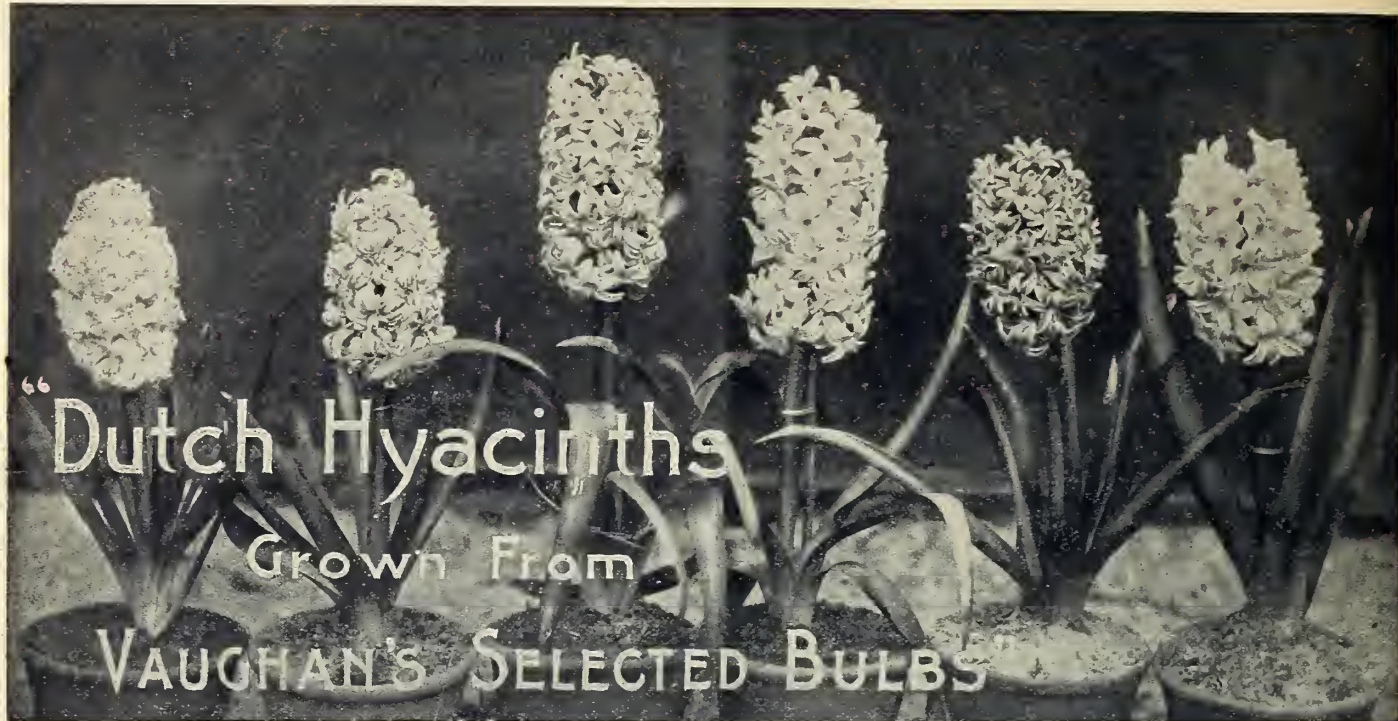

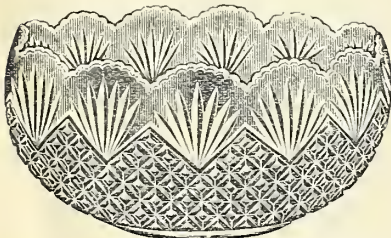

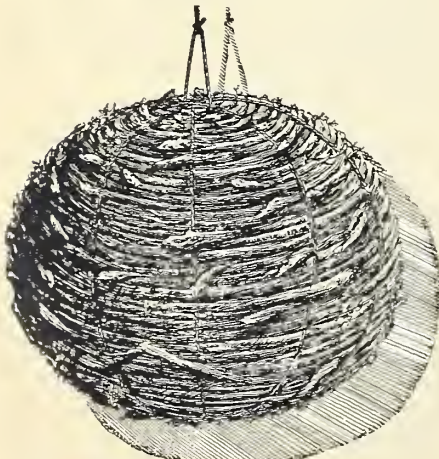
