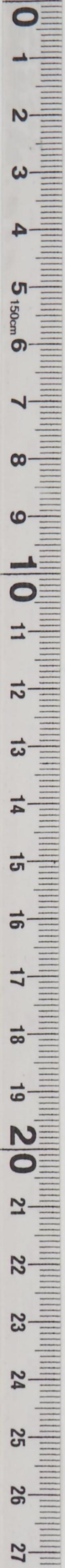

MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Proposed Establishment of Mexican Diplomatic Mission in Japan

1. By C/N to the C/S thru G-1, G-2, and G-4, subject as above, 31 December 1949, the Diplomatic Section requests approval of draft note to the Swedish Mission.
2. The Swedish Mission is in charge of Mexican interests in Japan.
3. Swedish Mission forwards Mexican request to establish a Diplomatic Mission in Japan.
4. Proposed DS note informs the Swedish Mission that SCAP would welcome a representative of the Mexican Government and that no logistic support or housing will be furnished by the Occupation to the Mexican Mission.
5. G-1, G-2 have concurred.
6. Recommend G-4 concurrence be shown in appropriate place on DS C/N, ref 1 above.
7. Within policy.
8. Completes action on G-4 Journal No 445.

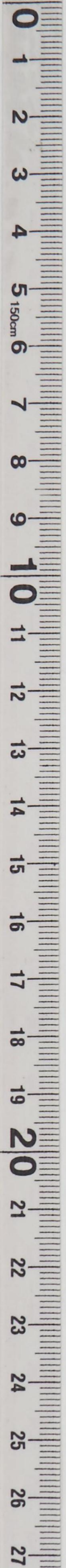

1. Inclosed herewith for approval is DS draft note (Tab A) in reply to the Swedish Diplomatic Mission's note of 22 Dec 49 (Tab B), which reports that the Mexican Government requests through its representative in Japan to be advised whether a Mexican career-official would be acceptable for accreditation to the Supreme Commander as the Mexican Diplomatic Representative in Japan.

2. Present DS draft note (Tab A) informs the Swedish Diplomatic Mission that the Supreme Commander would welcome the appointment of a representative of the Mexican Government. It requests that the name and other particulars concerning the representative and his staff be forwarded when available in order that arrangements may be made for entry into Japan. It also points out that no logistic support or housing will be furnished Mexican Mission in Japan by the Occupation.

3. DS recommends approval of draft note (Tab A) and requests return of this file for further action.

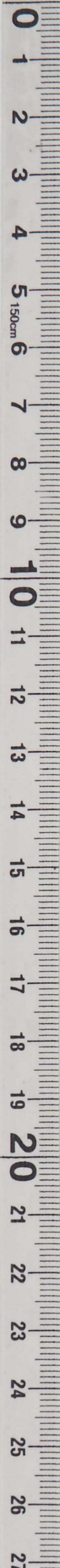

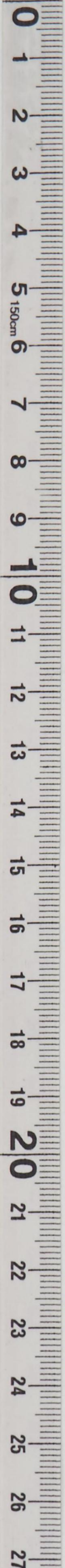
