Reparations-Designated Equipment.

Application as enclosed herewith has been submitted to the Minister of International Trade & Industry from President of the Fujikoshi Steel Industry Co., Ltd. for the additional use of reparations-designated equipment and increase in production at its Yamamuro Factory being located at 888 Nakagawara, Toyama-shi, in accordance with SCAPIN No. 1355.

We shall be appreciated so much if you will kindly approve the temporary use of the above.  
The following information are given for your reference.

1. In the application dated Oct. 15, 1949 which was submitted to the Minister of International Trade & Industry from Yamamuro Factory of the Fujikoshi Steel Industry Co., Ltd. the additional use of reparations-designated equipment and increase in production were proposed.

The Ministry of International Trade & Industry has acknowledged the importance which the production of bearings on the part of the Fujikoshi Steel Industry Co., Ltd. might contribute towards the rehabilitation of Japanese economy, and fulfilled without delay necessary procedures to SCAP for its approval.

2. The factory has already obtained approval for the conversion of its production activities into bicycle parts, electric machines and tools and auto-tricycle effective July 21, 1946, into pliers and cycle-dynamos effective Aug. 21, 1948 and into bearing-turners, plug-gauges and plummer-blocks effective July 22, 1949.

In this connection, it is desired to obtain approval for the temporary use of 59 machines of the reparations-designated equipment on the condition that emphasis will be placed not on the increase of output, but on the rationalization of production as well as the betterment of standards of finished goods, as a temporary measure, pending official approval from SCAP.



3. Out of 59 machines of the reparations-designated equipment being proposed for additional use, 19 had once been under operation on a basis of past approval, but they have been suspended from operation since July 23, 1949 when the program of production was revised.

Thus, the factory is to include them in the present application again.

Such being the case, we take the liberty of soliciting you to approve the temporary use of the equipment with your special kindness at an early date.

Concerning the application for supplementary use of designated reparation facilities made to you on 15 Oct. 1949 by Fujikoshi Kozai Kogyo K.K., we desire to have your permit as early as possible, asking to take note over the following circumstances.

1. As the Fujikoshi Kozai Kogyo K.K. has been given a permit on 22 July 1949 by Economic and Scientific Section, the Supreme Commander for the Allied Power, to produce 150,000 pcs. of rough turning bearing, 500 sets of plug gauge and 5,000 sets of plummer block, the company has been faced more demand for them, especially rough turning of bearing, because of the subsequent change in the Japanese industrial circles. Therefore, we request you to give us your permit for supplementary use of 59 designated reparation machines and for further production of 50,000 pcs. rough turning of bearing (200,000 pcs. in all) in order to rationalize and increase production and to improve the standard of machinery.
2. The purpose of this application for supplementary use is to rationalize production, and accordingly there is no need to increase worker.
3. This plant is closely linked with its central factory and has an excellent skill in making bearing which is tantamount to the central factory.



4. The purpose of this application for supplementary use of 59 designated reparation machines is for rationalization and increase of production and for improvement of the standard of machine. In these days of Japan, it is very difficult to purchase new machine because of prevailing money tight situation.

## 9. Scale of Proposed change in Physical Facilities.

For the purpose of promoting additionally the productive capacity of this plant, we wish to pick up some more machines of high efficiency among the equipments now being left idle in the plant, and put them in use as soon as possible.

The reasons are as follows:

- 1) There are no special equipment to be available at present except those which need, if they are to be put in use, the change of their location in the plant.
- 2) There are many apparatus or tools authorized to be used in this plant, and they are hinted that they are to be changed in their standard dimension in accordance with the present selling market followed by the establishment of the new commercial exchange rate between Yen and Dollar, and the late devaluation of Pound sterling as well.
- 3) There are some difficulties to be met to finished the productive plan in hand by the sole operation of the existing authorized machines for rationalization of productive processing and increased productive quantity as well.
- 4) And some difficulties are also found in enforcing the transportation or shift of the machines from the other plant or purchasing of new machines in view of the present tightened financial fund.

As the change of operation plan is difficult to form at present from the economical point of view, we hereby beg to apply for the use of the existing designated reparation equipments by the time of its removal, and after removal of the said equipment we expect to operate production in succession by transference of equipments from our Toyama Plant.
