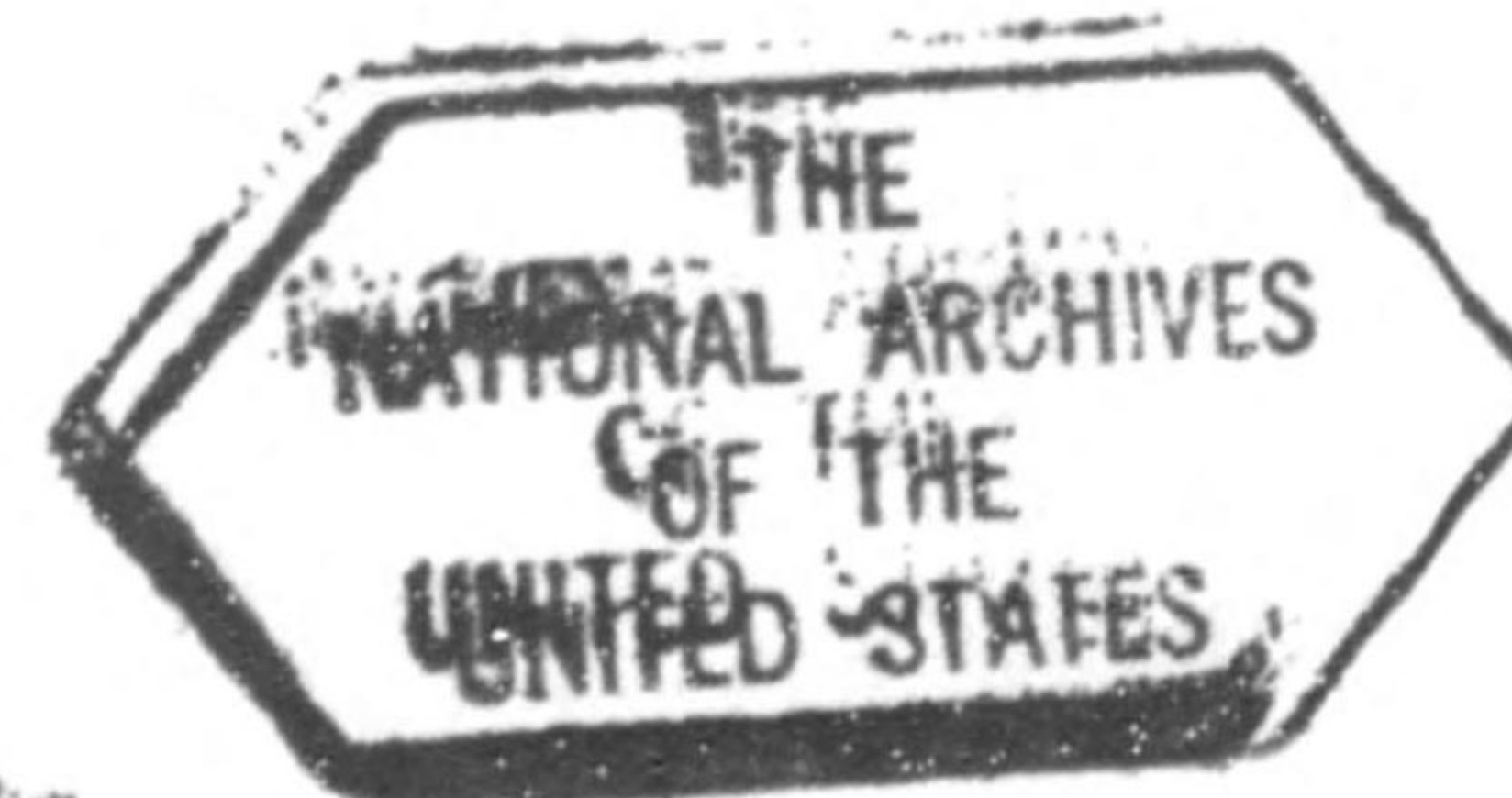

1. Reference is made to the Japanese Government list of names which GS furnished G-2 for review, in connection with the depurging of former Special Higher Police personnel, to ascertain whether the G-2 files contained derogatory information on any of the names concerned.

2. It is understood that the names referred to have already been screened by a Japanese Government Committee according to criteria as to whether any of these persons had been connected with instances of gross violation of human rights and whether any evidence existed pointing to the individual's participations from a supervisory or operational level in instances of such gross violations, and that hence the responsibility of screening rests with the Japanese government.

3. It is estimated that a check of G-2 files on the almost 4000 names can probably be completed by 24 September. Of the 300 names already screened by G-2, possible derogatory information is indicated on only nine (9). The names of these nine (9) persons appeared on suspected war criminal apprehension lists in the early part of the Occupation previous to either the War Crimes Trials or the Purge; however, there is no indication that any of these persons actually were apprehended, tried or sentenced. It is also to be noted that while the names on the list and the names appearing on the suspected war criminal apprehension lists are the same, information available is not sufficient for positive identification and therefore there is no assurance that the individuals are identical. If this information is considered of sufficient moment to require further investigation, it is suggested that Legal Section records be checked.
