

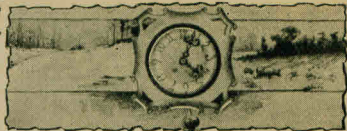

ECLIPSES, 1895.

Five Eclipses occur this year, two of the Moon and three of the Sun, as follows:

I. A Total Eclipse of the Moon, March 10, visible in North and South America, Europe and Western Asia.

II. A Partial Eclipse of the Sun, March 26, invisible in the United States.

III. A Partial Eclipse of the Sun, Aug. 20, invisible in America.

IV. A Total Eclipse of the Moon, Sept. 3 and 4, visible in America, Western Europe and Africa.

V. A Partial Eclipse of the Sun, Sept. 18, visible in Northern Australia, New Zealand and the Pacific Ocean.

MORNING AND EVENING STARS.

VENUS, morn., after Sept. 19; eve., until Sept. 18. MARS, morn., after Oct. 11; eve., until Oct. 11. JUPITER, morn., from July 10 to Oct. 12; eve., until July 10 and after Oct. 12. SATURN, morn., until Feb. 5 and after Nov. 2; eve., from Feb. 5 to Nov. 2.

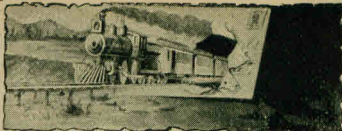

Money Order fees are: on orders not exceeding \$10, 8c.; \$15, 10 c.; \$30, 15 c.; \$40, 20 c.; \$50, 25 c.; \$60, 30 c.; \$70, 35 c.; \$80, 40 c.; \$100, 45 c.

FOREIGN.—To all parts of the Universal Postal Union (embracing nearly every civilized country), Letters, 5 c. per half oz., prepayment optional: if not prepaid, a fine is collected on delivery.

International Postal Card, 2 c. Newspapers, Books, Pamphlets, Photographs, &c., 1 c. for each 2 ozs. or fraction thereof. All matter, except Letters, must be prepaid. Letters and other packages may be registered on payment of a fee of 8 c.

International Money Order fees: not over \$10, 10 c.; \$20, 20 c.; \$30, 30 c.; \$40, 40 c.; \$50, 50 c.; \$60, 60 c.; \$70, 70 c.; \$80, 80 c.; \$90, 90 c.; \$100, \$1.

To the *Dominion of Canada, New Brunswick, Nova Scotia, &c.*, Letters, Postal Cards, Printed Matter, Samples, &c., must be prepaid same as U. S. rates. Samples and Merchandise, 1 c. per oz.; packages must not exceed 4 lbs. 6 ozs. in weight; prepayment compulsory.

To *Mexico*, Letters, Postal Cards and printed matter, same rates as in U. S. Samples, 1c. per oz.; Merchandise other than samples can only be sent by parcel post.
